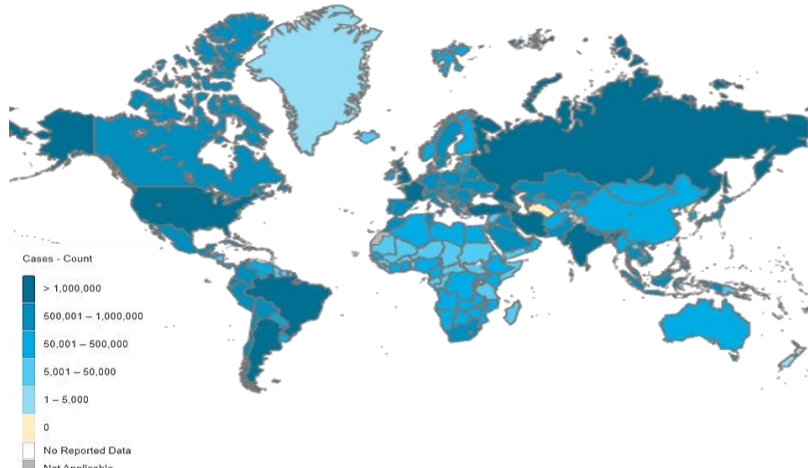

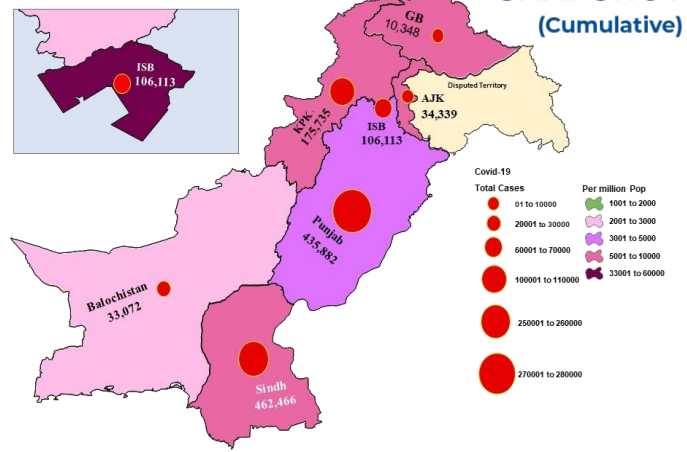

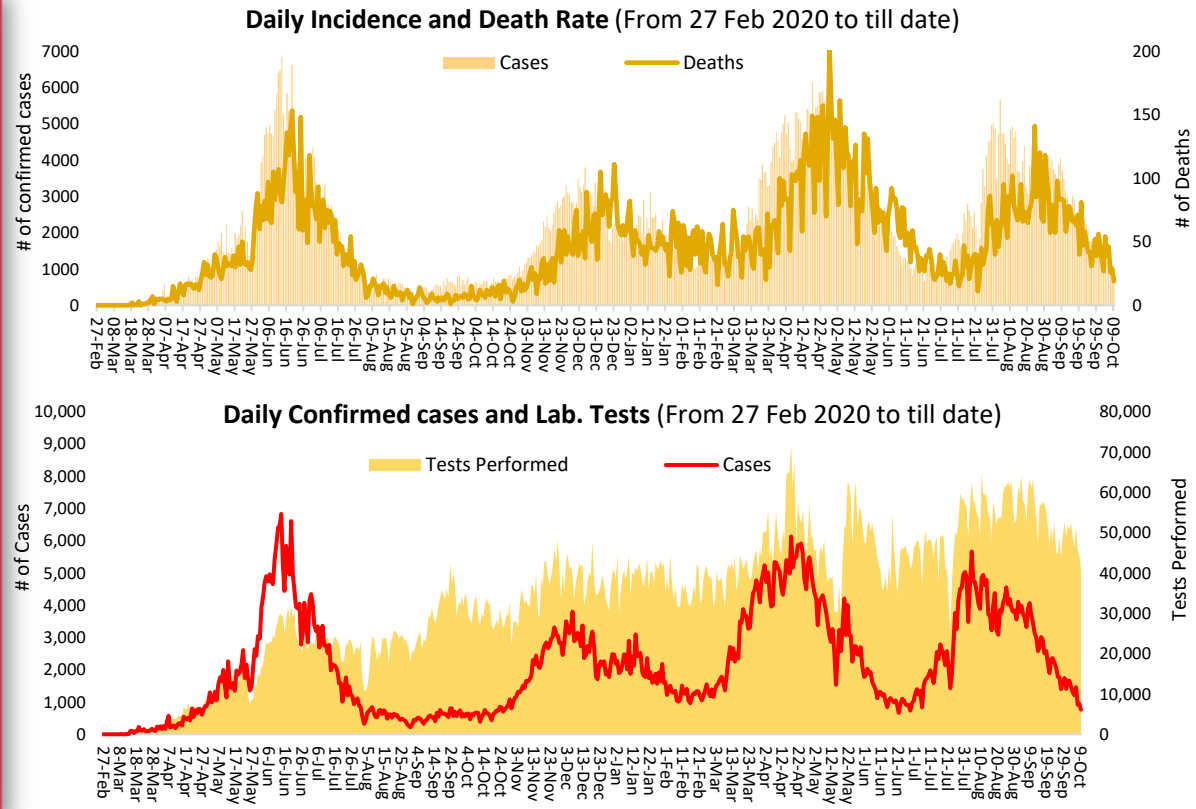

On 6th October 2021, WHO Country Representative in Pakistan, Dr Palitha Mahipala along with Director General Punjab Emergency Service Department (PESD) Dr Rizwan Naseer inaugurated the 10th National Rescue Challenge (NRC) at Emergency Services Academy Lahore Pakistan.

In his remarks, Dr Palitha stated that Rescuers are the real heroes of the Nation. They provide emergency services without discrimination to over 9.8 million victims of accidents, emergencies, and disasters and over 26 thousand victims of COVID- 19 when nobody was ready to go near these patients.
