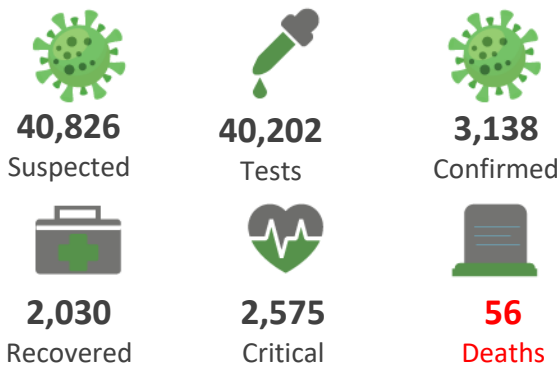


TOTAL CASES & CASES PER MILLION POP.



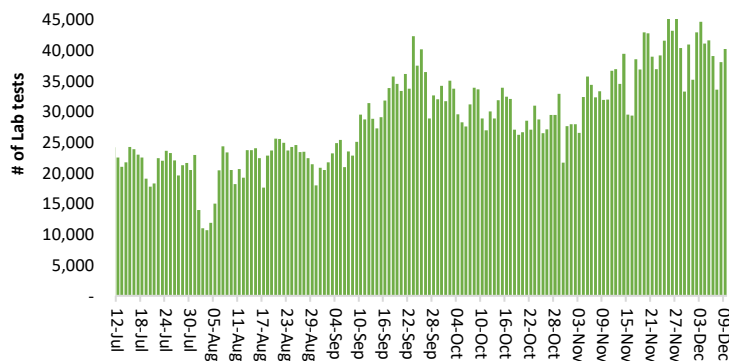
Pakistan reported **3,138** new cases of COVID-19 on **09 December 2020**. The total number of cases notified since the beginning of the outbreak is **429,280** with **8,603** deaths (**CFR: 2.00%**). Out of the total **46,376** currently active cases **3,170** cases are hospitalized.

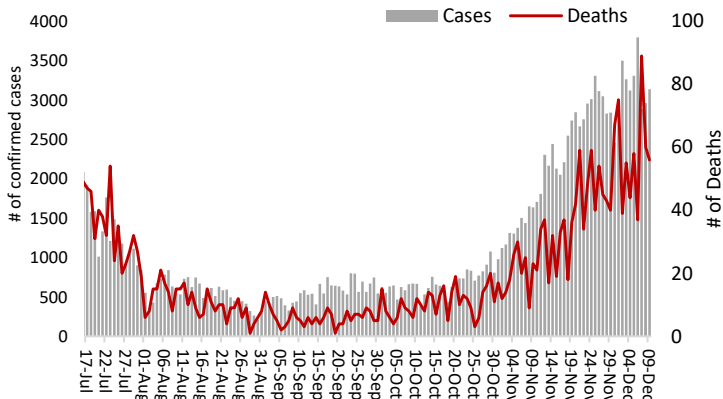

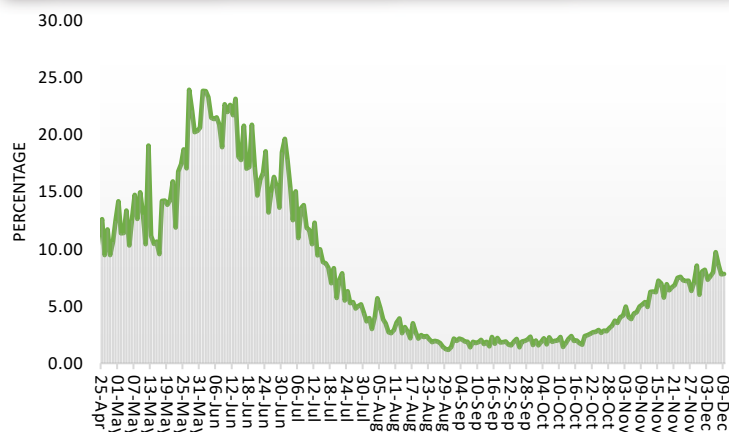


INCIDENCE & DEATHS BY DATE

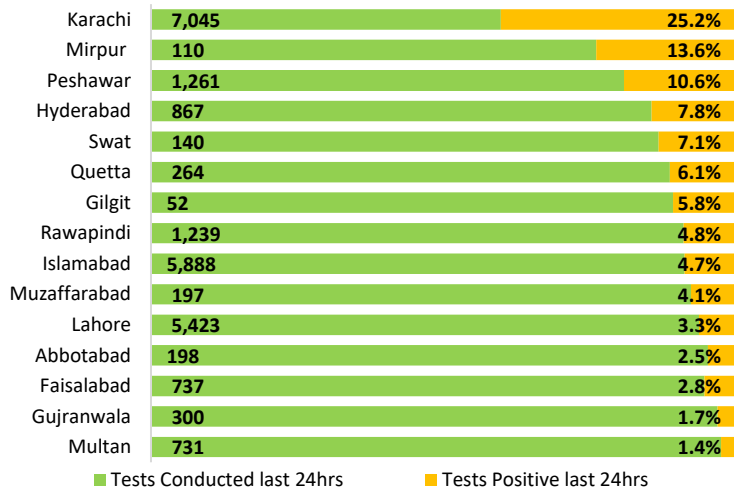
The Honorable Minister, Dr Azra expressed her gratitude to WHO Pakistan for their continued support to Pakistan.
