

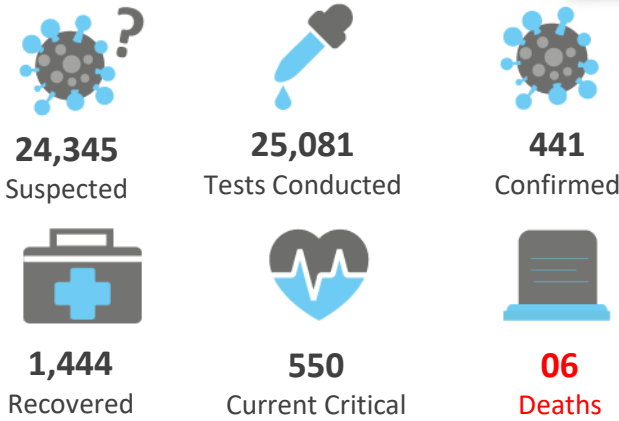

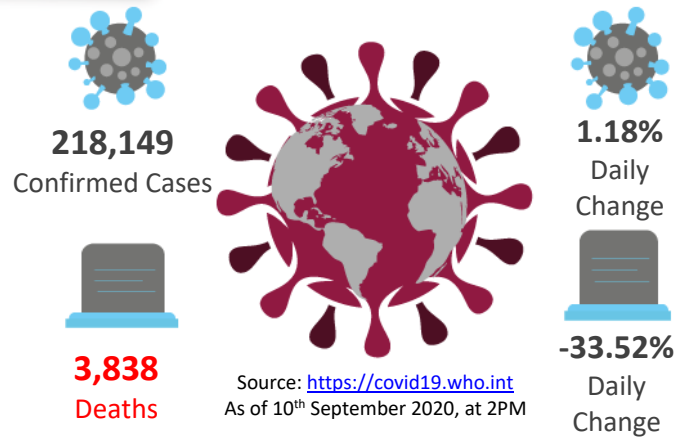

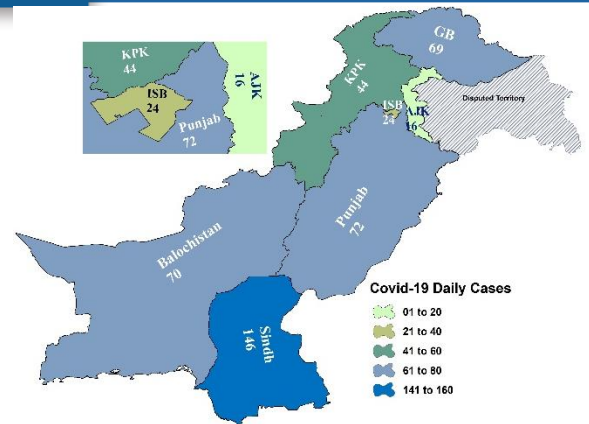

Executive Summary

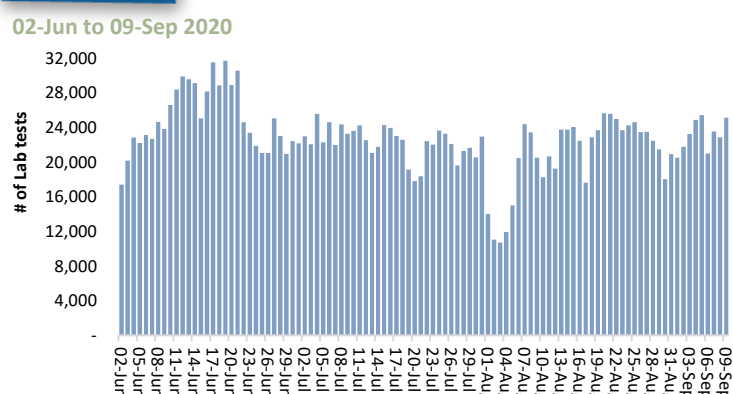
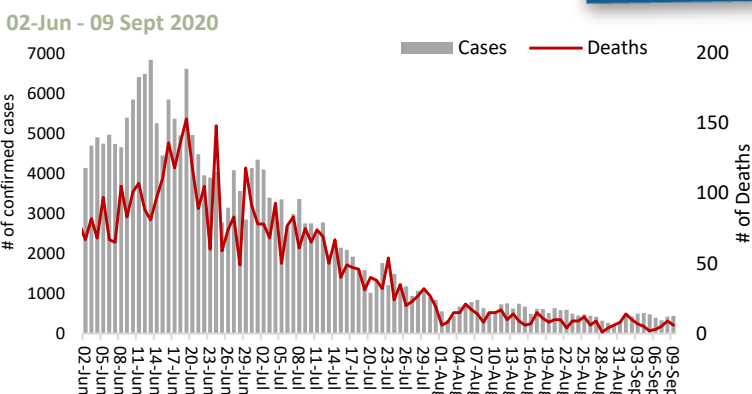
Daily Incidence by Province

Pakistan reported **441** new cases of COVID-19 on **9 September 2020**. The total number of cases notified since the beginning of the outbreak is **299,855** with **6,365** deaths (**CFR: 2.12%**). Out of the total **5,540** currently active cases, **1,029** cases are hospitalized, out of which **550 (53.44%)** are in critical condition. **4,511** COVID-19 positive cases are at designated isolation facilities or in-home isolation. A total of **287,950 (96.02%)** have recovered and discharged.

Daily Lab Tests conducted

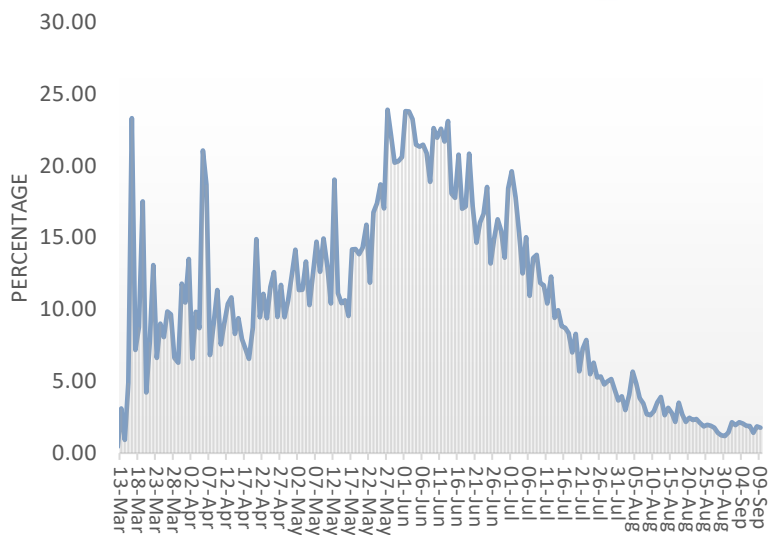

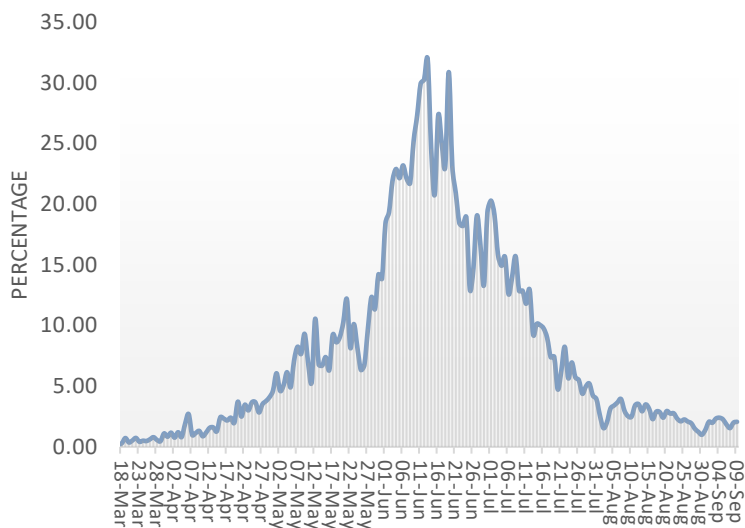

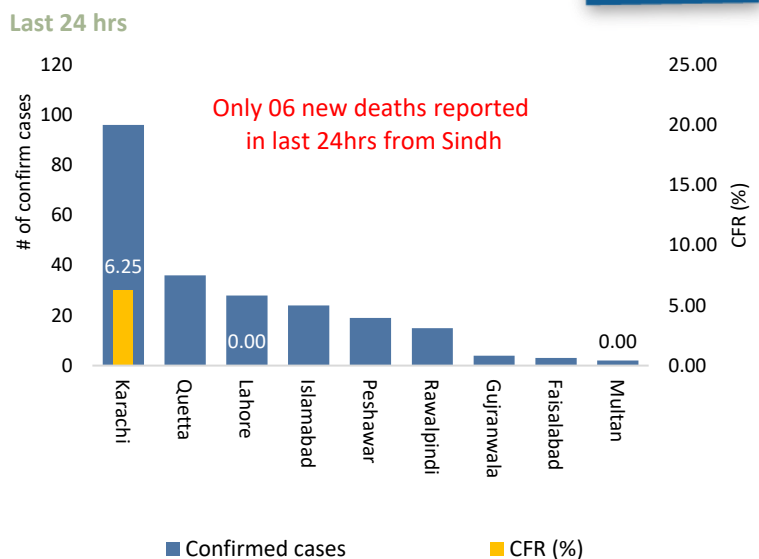
Daily COVID-19 Positivity Rate



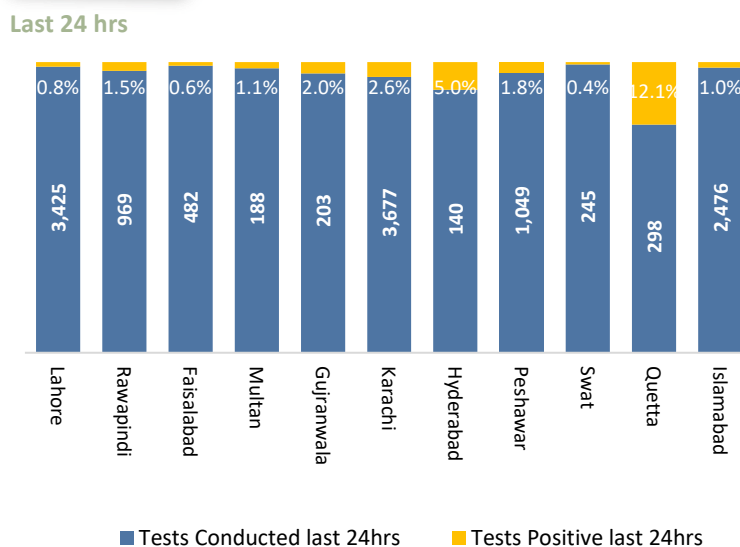
Daily COVID-19 Attack rate Per million population

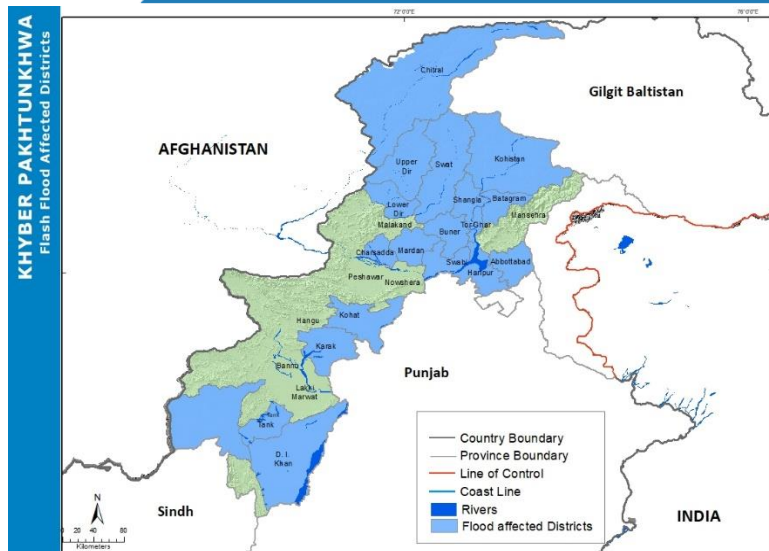
FLOOD SITUATION

Thursday,
10th September 2020

No new incidence of heavy rains and floods was reported in the province of Punjab, Balochistan, Sindh and AJK. However, in the district Abbottabad of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa province; according to the National Disaster Management Authority (NDMA) **2 houses have been** partially damaged (from 8th to 9th September 2020) due to torrential rains.

To date over **301 deaths**, over **233** Injuries, over **12,676** people have been displaced as a result of heavy rains and floods in the country. Over, **78,469 houses fully** and **138,142 partially** damaged since 15th June.

In response the government of Sindh has created **196** relief camps in different parts of province. Currently **23,629** persons are residing in these camps. See the table below for details.

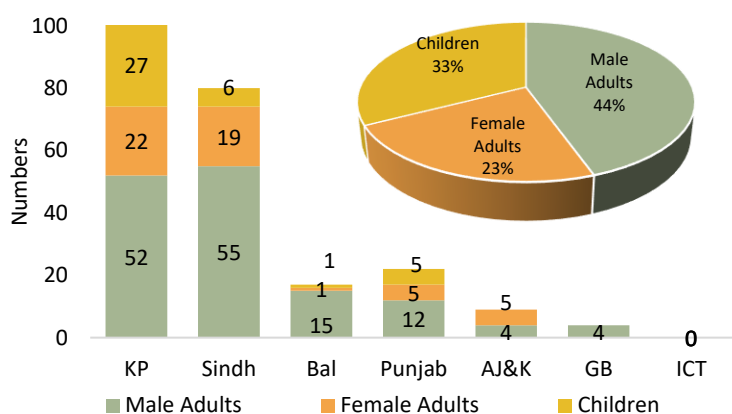

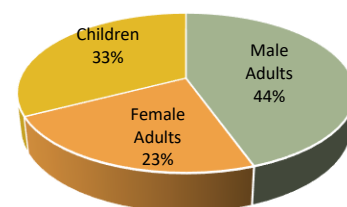
