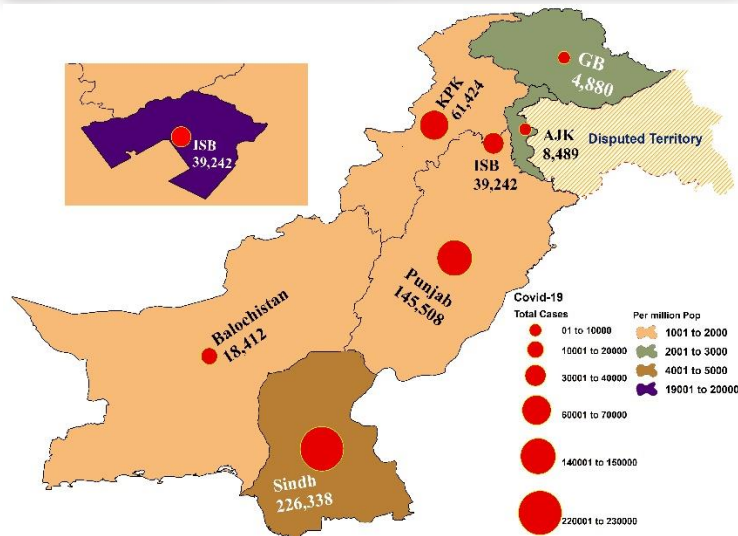


INCIDENCE & DEATHS BY DATE

15-Aug 2020 - 10-Jan 2021



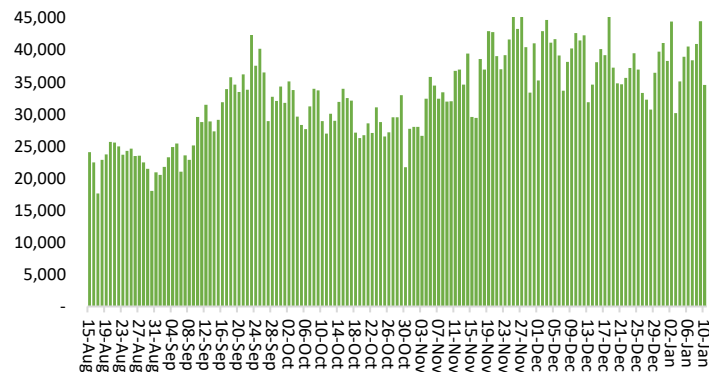
TOTAL CASES & CASES PER MILLION POP.



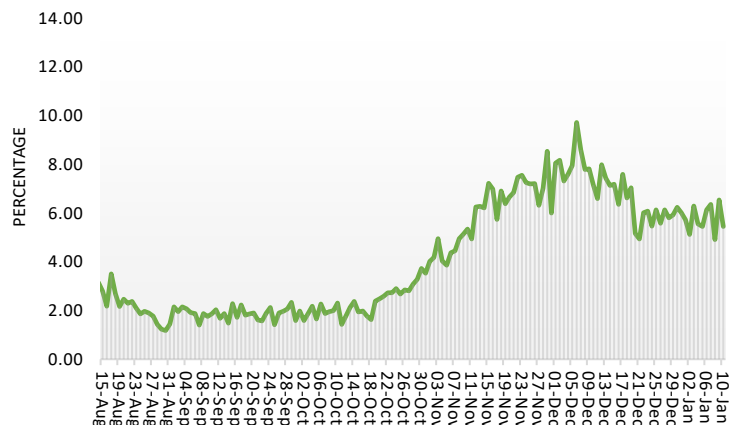
Pakistan reported **1,877** new cases of COVID-19 on **10 January 2021**. The total number of cases notified since the beginning of the outbreak is **504,293** with **10,676** deaths (**CFR: 2.12%**). Out of the total **35,246** currently active cases **2,812** cases are hospitalized.

MEETINGS & COORDINATION

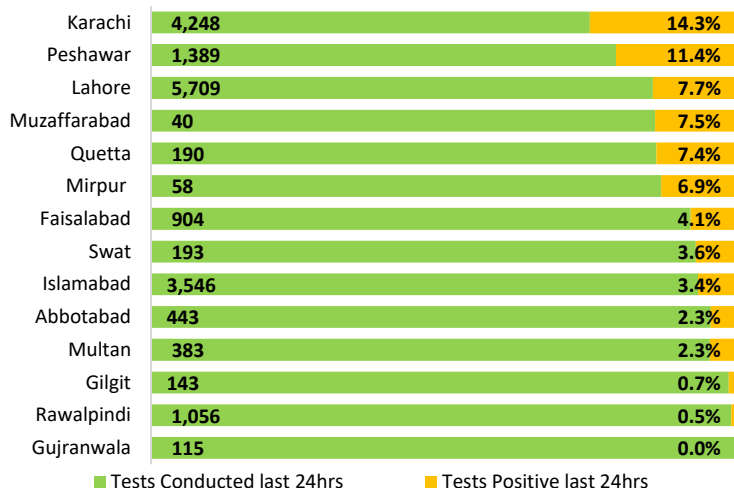
