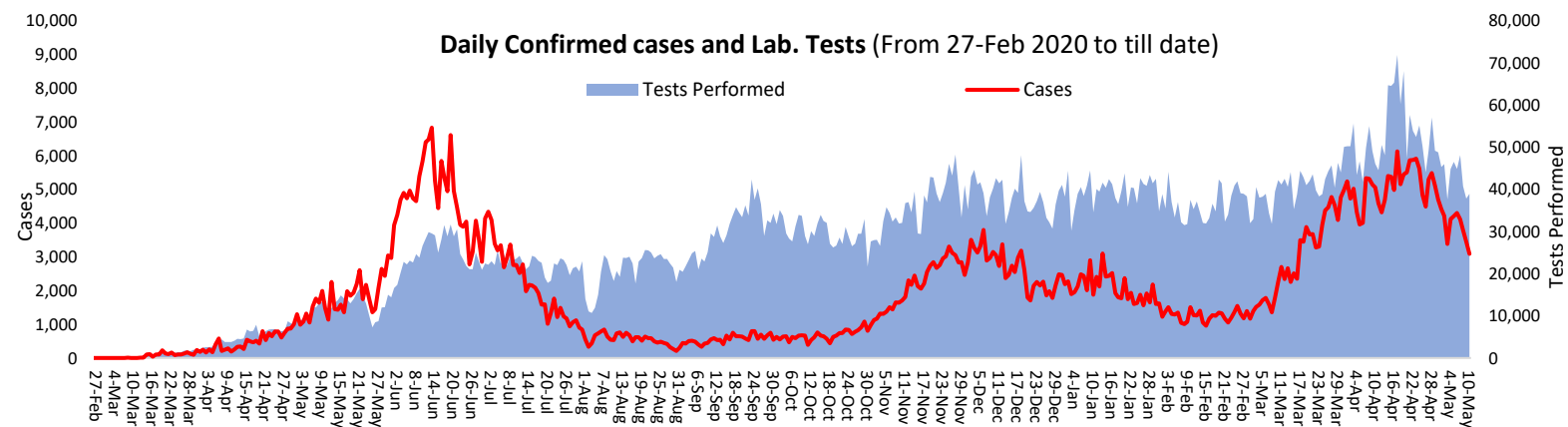

Meeting and Coordination

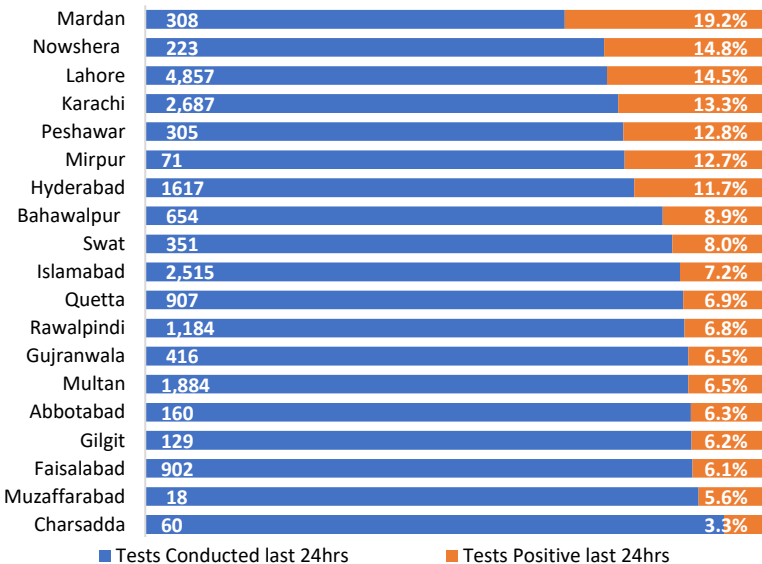


On 11th May 2021, A letter of intent signing ceremony between WHO Pakistan and National Institute of Health was held at WHO Country Office Pakistan; WHO Country Representative, Dr Palitha Mahipala and Executive Director NIH Maj General Prof Aamer Ikram, HI(M),SI (M), signed the document. This letter of intent is a formal commitment of support by WHO Pakistan to the National reference public health laboratory at National Institute of Health (NIH) and provincial laboratories for detection of the SARS-CoV2 variants of Interest (VOI) and Variants of Concern (VOC) by PCR detection and subsequent whole genome sequencing. This initiative will help in rapid identification of known and emerging SARS-CoV2 variants, tracking their geographical spread, as well as ensure real time sharing of sequence data on global databases.

Speaking on the occasion, Dr Palitha reiterated WHO's commitment for continued support and appreciated the efforts by NIH in identification of the variant strains. Maj Gen Aamer Ikram thanked the WR for his support and highlighted the efforts of NIH to lead a national consortium for genomic surveillance of SARS-CoV2 variants.
