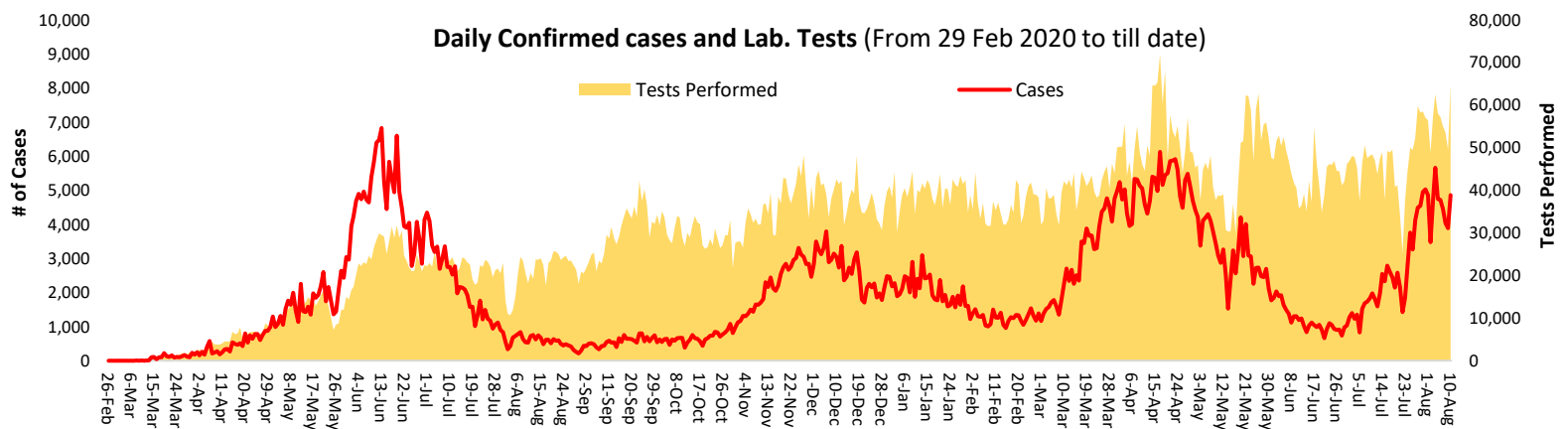
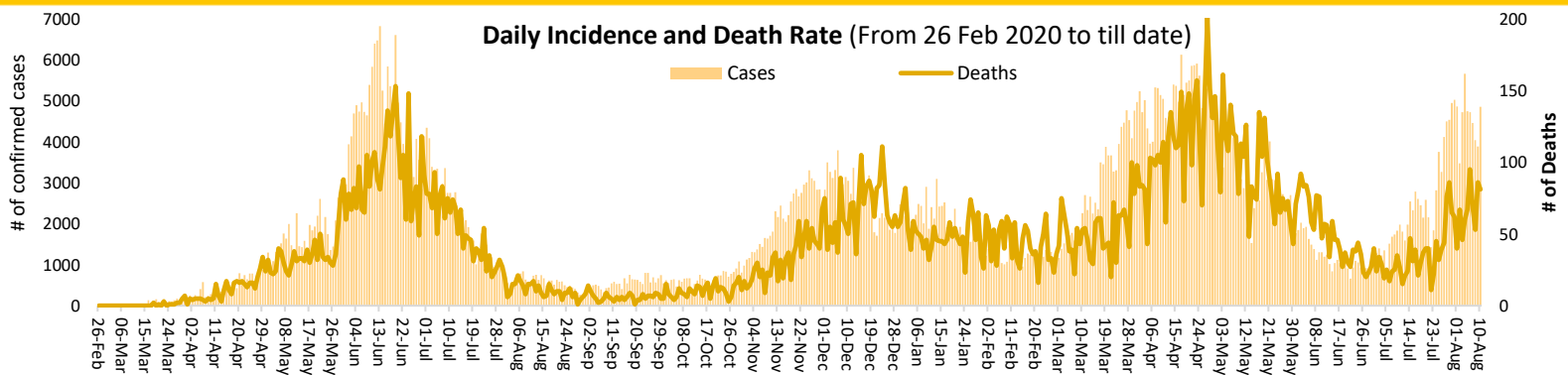

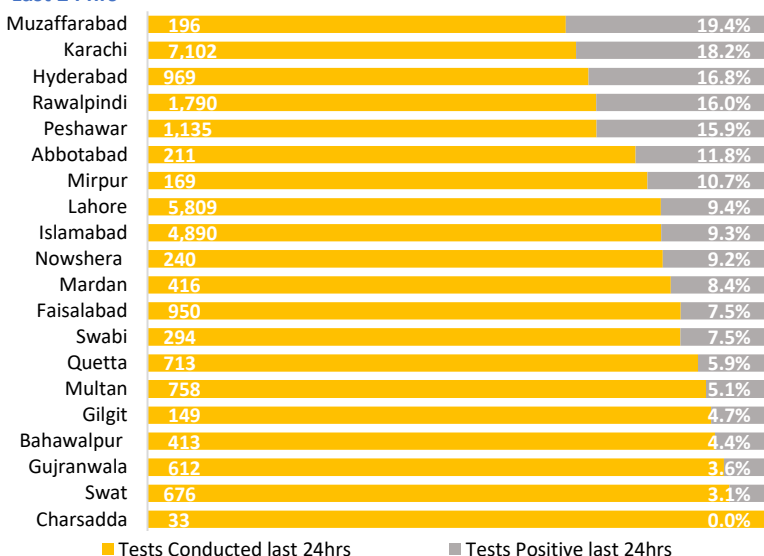


On 11th August 2021, WHO Country Representative Pakistan, Dr Palitha Mahipala handed over a Biological safety Cabinet and a PCR Chamber worth PKR 2.65 million, to the Executive Director National Institute of Health (NIH) Islamabad, Maj. Gen. Aamer Ikram. The handover ceremony took place at the WHO Country Office, Islamabad. The equipment will be installed at COVID-19 molecular laboratory, GDA Hospital, Gwadar and its operationalization is expected to enhance the laboratory testing capacity in Balochistan province.

During the handover ceremony, Dr Palitha highlighted the close coordination between WHO Pakistan and NIH that has resulted in the strengthening of laboratory testing capacity and genomic surveillance for SARS-CoV2 variants. The Executive Director NIH appreciated WHO for the technical and logistical assistance to the government of Pakistan in the COVID-19 response.
