

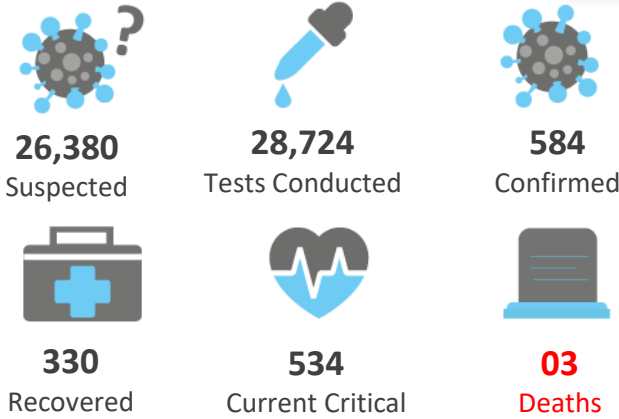

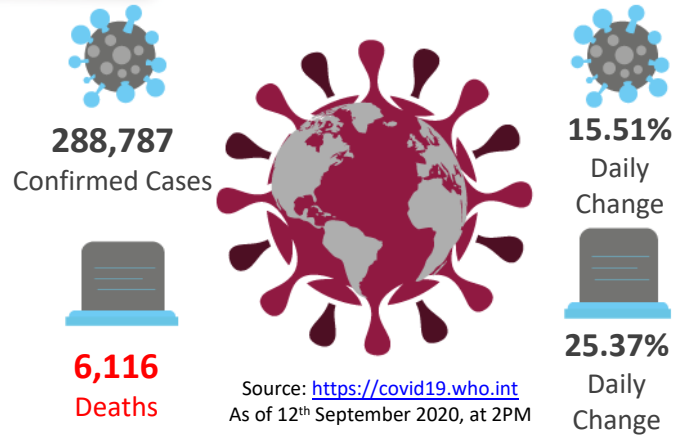

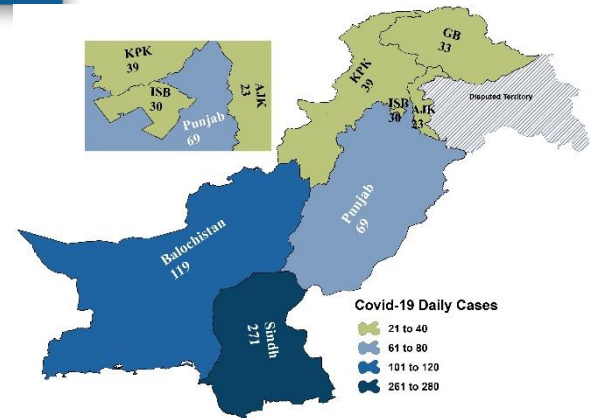

Executive Summary

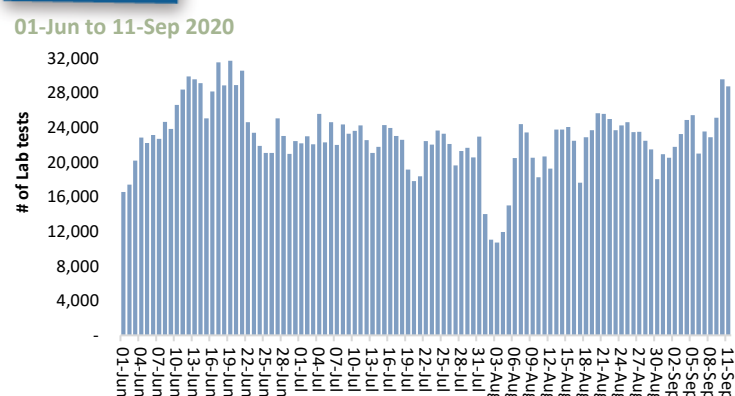
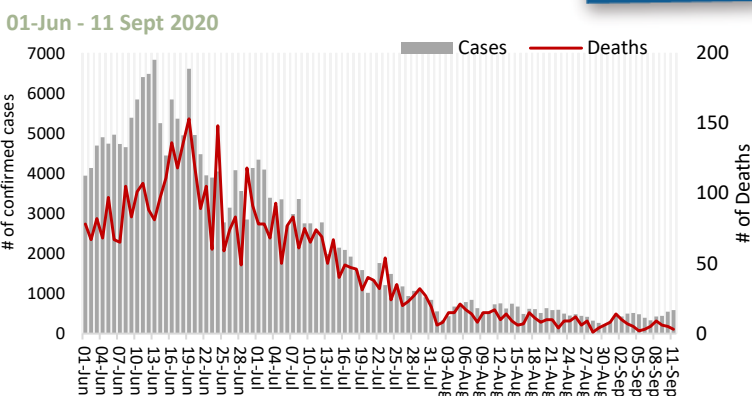
Daily Incidence by Province

Pakistan reported **584** new cases of COVID-19 on **11 September 2020**. The total number of cases notified since the beginning of the outbreak is **300,955** with **6,373** deaths (**CFR: 2.11%**). Out of the total **6,046** currently active cases, **1,012** cases are hospitalized, out of which **534 (52.76%)** are in critical condition. **5,034** COVID-19 positive cases are at designated isolation facilities or in-home isolation. A total of **288,536 (95.87%)** have recovered and discharged.

Daily Lab Tests conducted

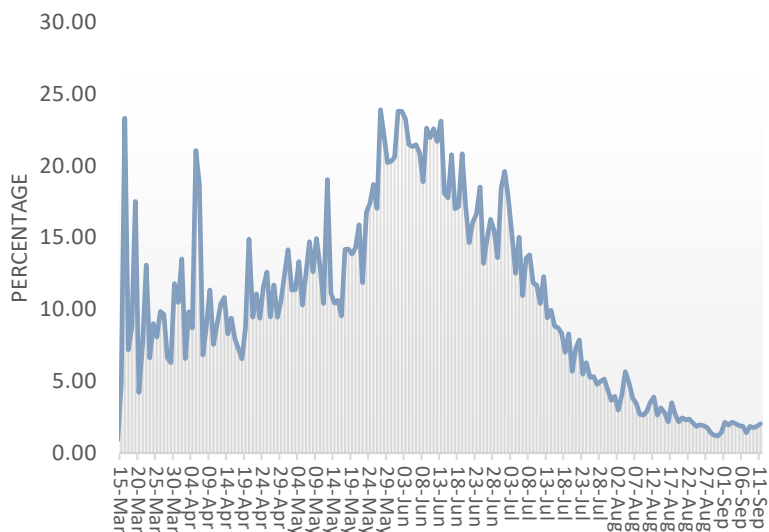

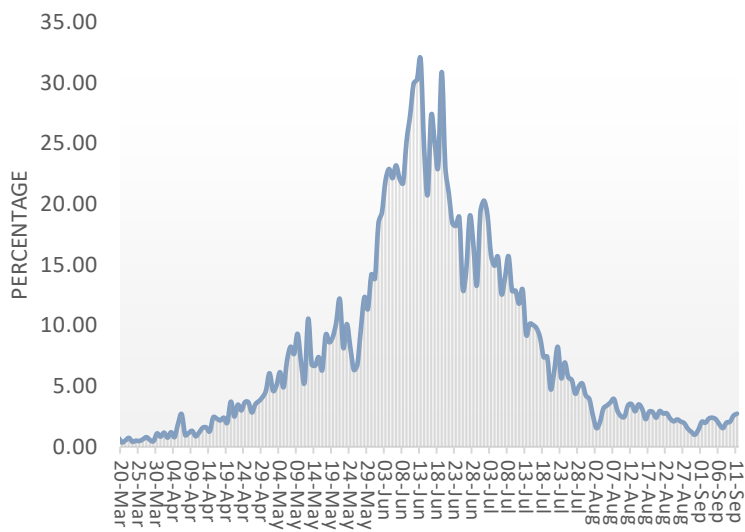

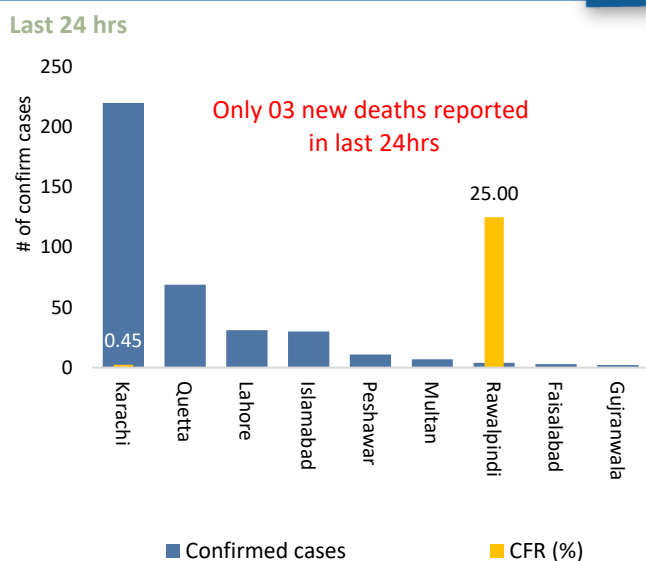
Daily COVID-19 Positivity Rate



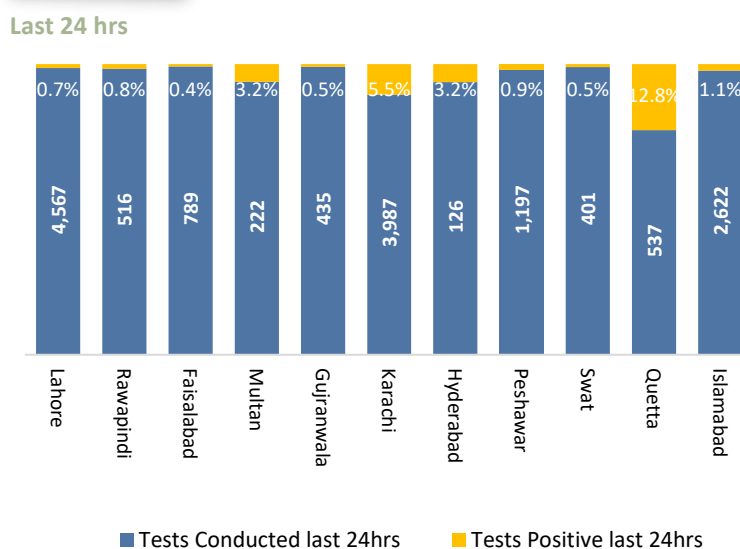
Daily COVID-19 Attack rate Per million population

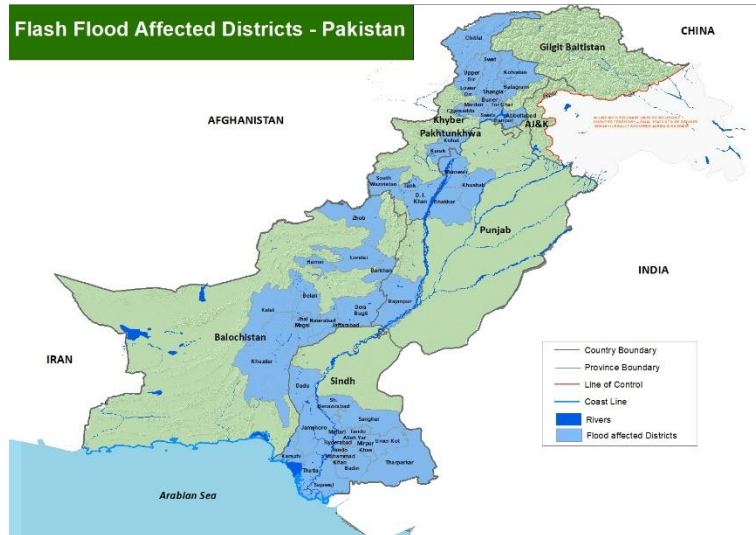
FLOOD SITUATION

Saturday,
12th September 2020

According to National Disaster Management Authority (NDMA) no new incidence of heavy rains and floods was reported in any part of the country during 9th to 11th September 2020.

To date **312 deaths** as detailed; Male adults 135 (43%), Female adults 70 (23%) and children 107 (34%) have been recorded. In addition, **239 injuries** have been reported. Over **12,676** people who were stuck due to floods were evacuated to safer places by armed forces and district administration rescue teams. Over, **78,521 houses fully** and **139,102 partially** damaged since 15th June. See the table below for details. The government of Sindh has created **196** relief camps in different parts of province. Currently **23,629** persons are residing in these camps.

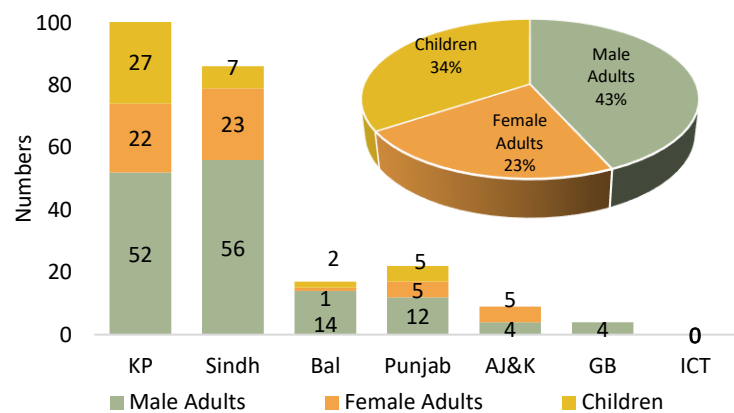

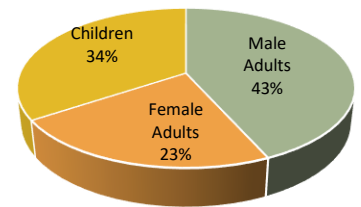
