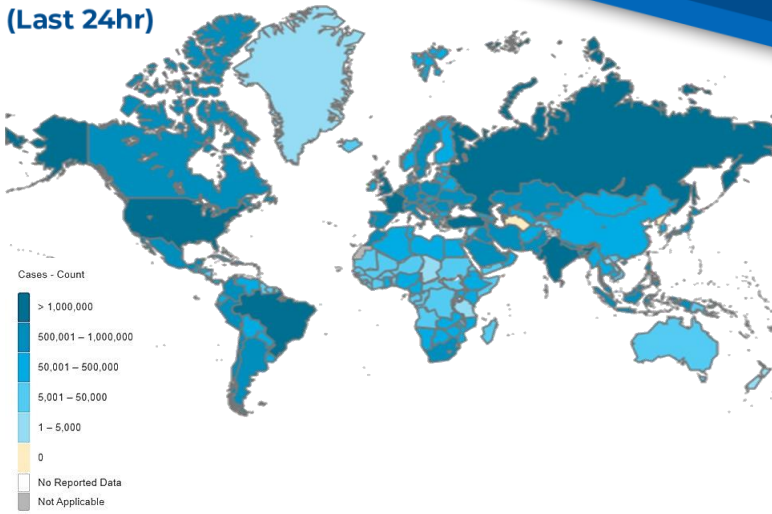


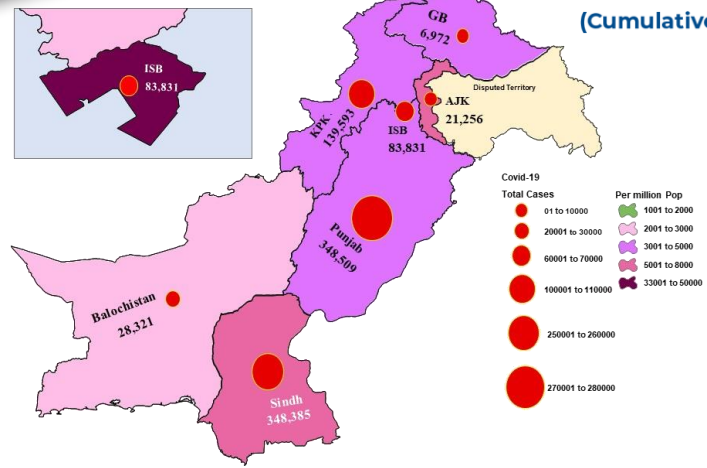

PAKISTAN COVID-19 SNAPSHOT (Cumulative)

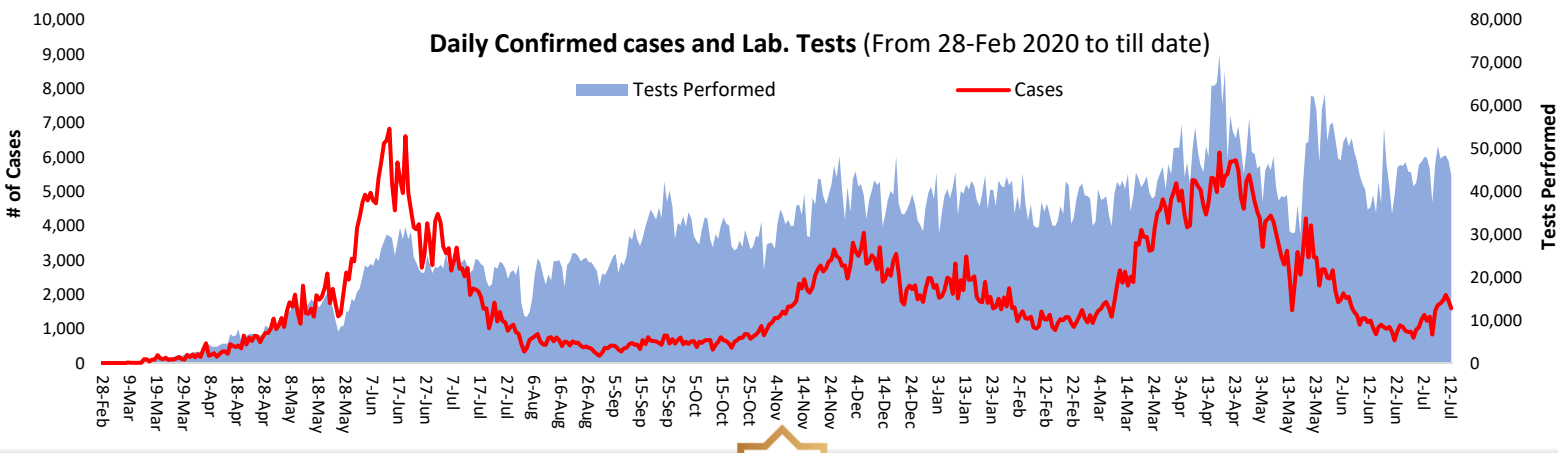
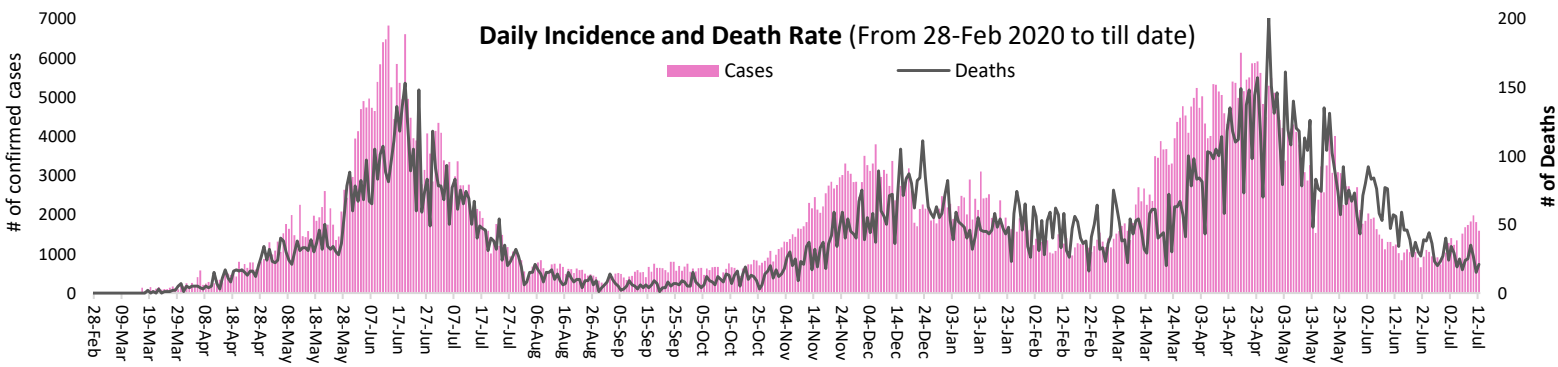

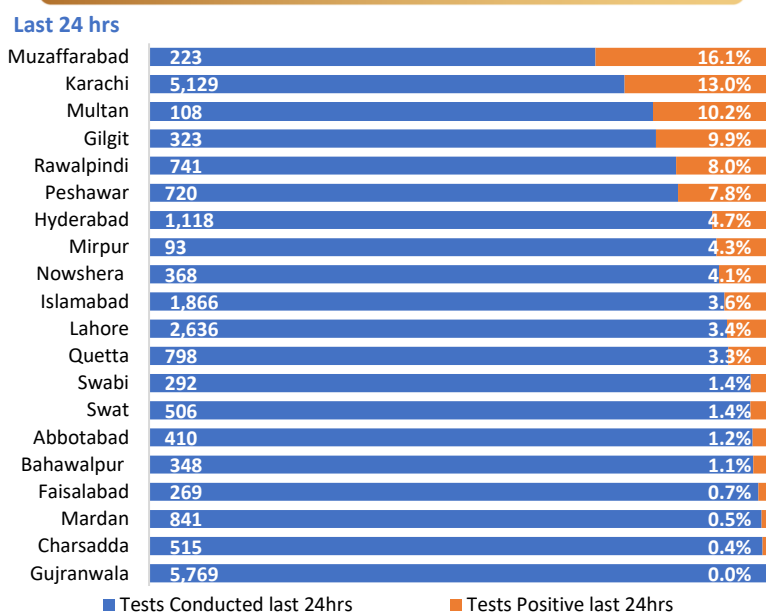

On 12th July 2021, WHO Country Representative Pakistan, Dr Palitha Mahipala and the Special Assistant to Prime Minister (SAPM) on Health, Dr Faisal Sultan, jointly launched the digital Web-based Monitoring and Reporting System for Sustainable Development Goal (SDG)-3 and other Health related goals at the MoNHSR&C headquarters, Islamabad. This system is open for public information and it is envisaged to promote information use and tracking of progress.

During his speech, Dr Palitha commended the Government of Pakistan for digitalization of SDG monitoring and pledged WHO support to innovative approaches in implementation of SDG-3 and other health related Goals in Pakistan. H.E Dr Faisal Sultan, reiterated the importance of real time data monitoring of SDGs and noted that this initiative will accelerate progress towards achievement of SDG 3 and other health related goals through timely provision of information on progress.
