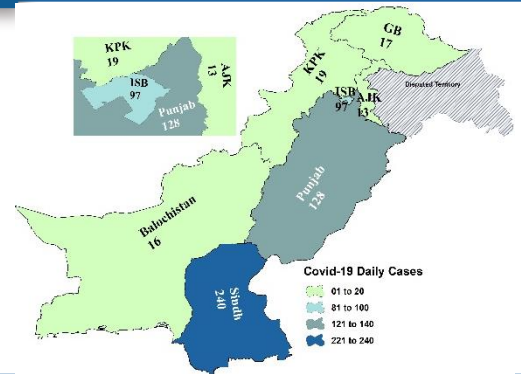

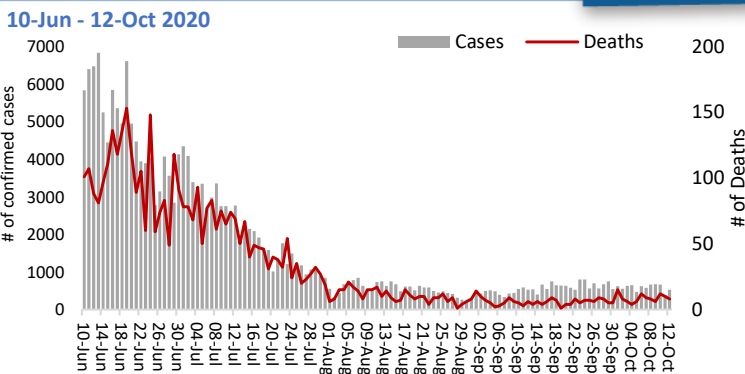
### Executive Summary

Pakistan reported **530** new cases of COVID-19 on **12 October 2020**. The total number of cases notified since the beginning of the outbreak is **319,848** with **6,588** deaths (**CFR: 2.06%**). Out of the total **8,651** currently active cases, **852** cases are hospitalized, out of which **516 (60.56%)** are in critical condition. **7,799** COVID-19 positive cases are at designated isolation facilities or in-home isolation. A total of **304,609 (95.23%)** have recovered and discharged.

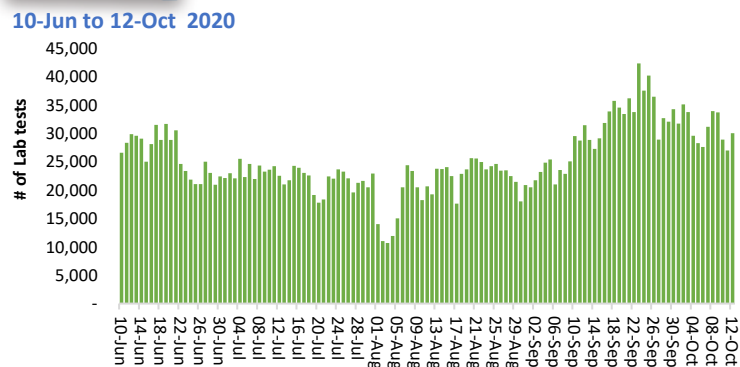
### Daily Incidence by Province



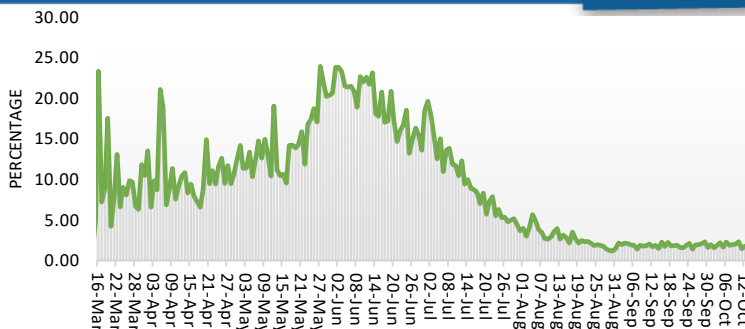
### Daily Incidence/Mortality



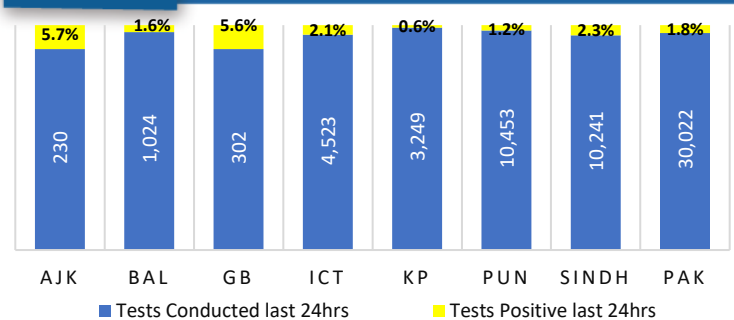
### Daily Lab Test conducted

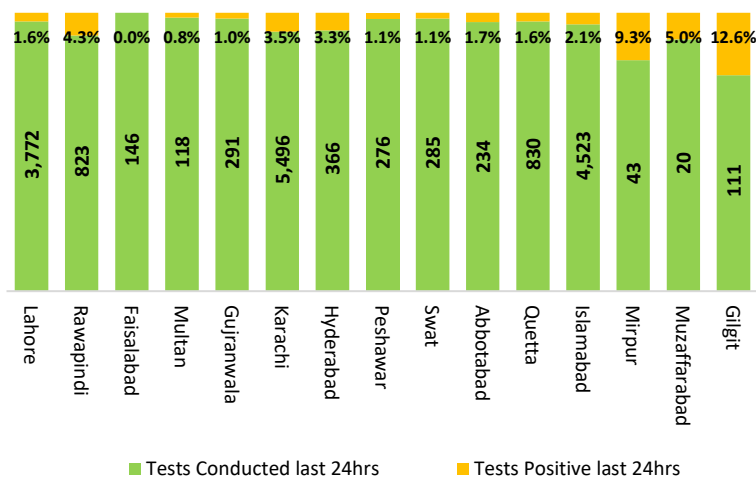
