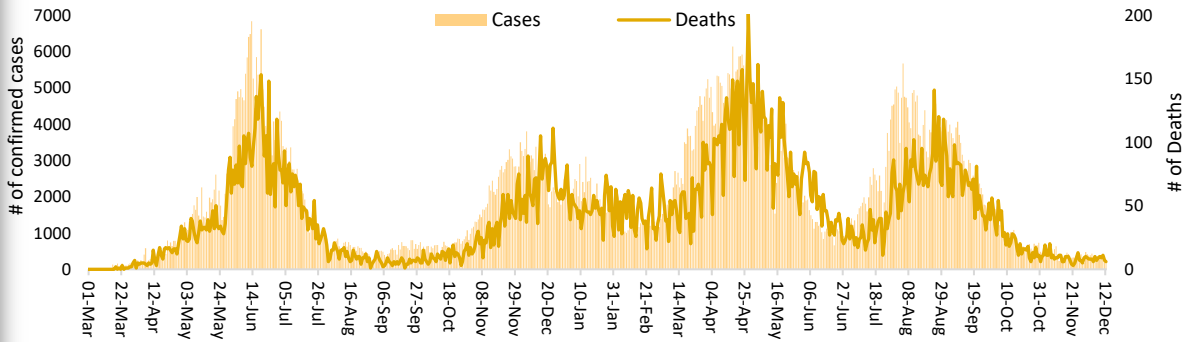

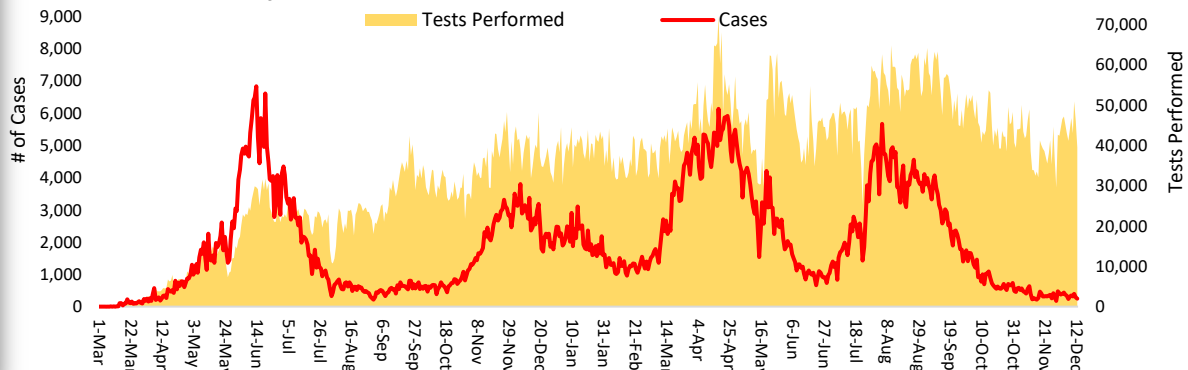

On 10th December 2021, the World Health Organization Country Representative Pakistan, Dr Palitha Mahipala chaired a health sector meeting at WHO country office, Islamabad. The meeting was attended by over 18 International and National Non-Governmental Organizations operating in Pakistan. Dr Palitha briefed partners on the current COVID-19 situation and response by the Government of Pakistan. He highlighted on the current refugee situation and urged the humanitarian community to be prepared for response if the need arises. WHE Team lead Dr Michael Lukwiya briefed the participants on current Dengue situation in the country and, Ms. Oleksandra from UNHCR presented Refugee Response Plan for 2021. The participants agreed on updating and maintaining the 5W matrix and holding regular monthly meeting. WHO Pakistan WR, Dr Palitha thanked the health partners for their active participation in the meeting. He requested them to continue supporting the Government of Pakistan.
