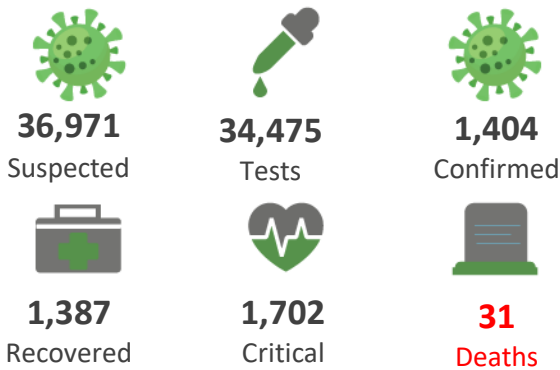


TOTAL CASES & CASES PER MILLION POP.



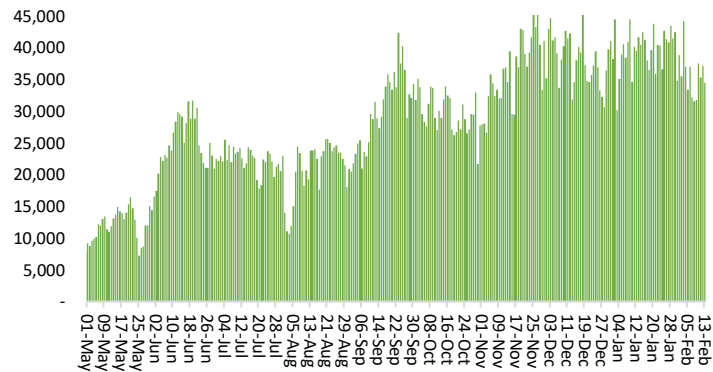
Pakistan reported **1,404** new cases of COVID-19 on **13th February 2021**. The total number of cases notified since the beginning of the outbreak is **563,029** with **12,307** deaths (**CFR: 2.19%**). Out of the total **25,635** currently active cases **2,125** cases are hospitalized.

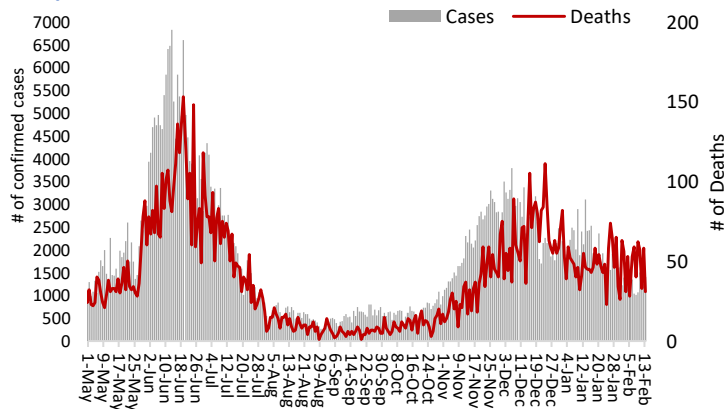
LAB TEST (PCR + RA) CONDUCTED BY DATE

01-Mar 2020 - 13-Feb 2021

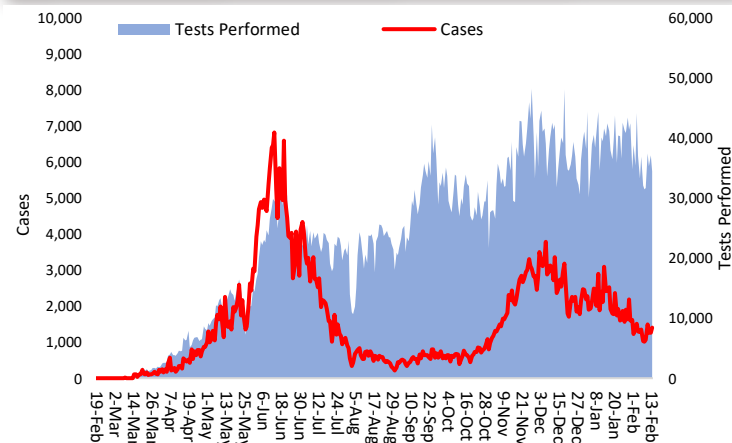


INCIDENCE & DEATHS BY DATE

MEETINGS & COORDINATION

On 11th February 2021, The President's Office in collaboration with World Health Organization organized the second session on "Dialogue of Persons with Disabilities with the President of Pakistan towards Disability inclusive society" at Governor House Peshawar. The President of Pakistan, H.E Dr Arif Alvi chaired the session. The session was attended by the Governor KPK, Shah Farman, Special Assistant to the Prime Minister on Health, Dr Faisal Sultan, Provincial Ministers, Secretaries, DGs, Dr Maryam Mallick Technical Advisor on Disabilities and Rehabilitation, WHO and Representatives of Organizations of Persons with Disabilities in KPK. While addressing the interactive session, the President stressed the need of taking effective measures to address needs of Persons with Disabilities (PWDs) and encourage their mainstreaming as the active members of the society. He also underlined the need of improving accessibility, to have robust data and one window operating registration of PWDs in the province. National Vocational and Technical Training Commission (NAVTTTC) was directed to provide marketable skills to persons with disabilities by designing special training modules for them.
