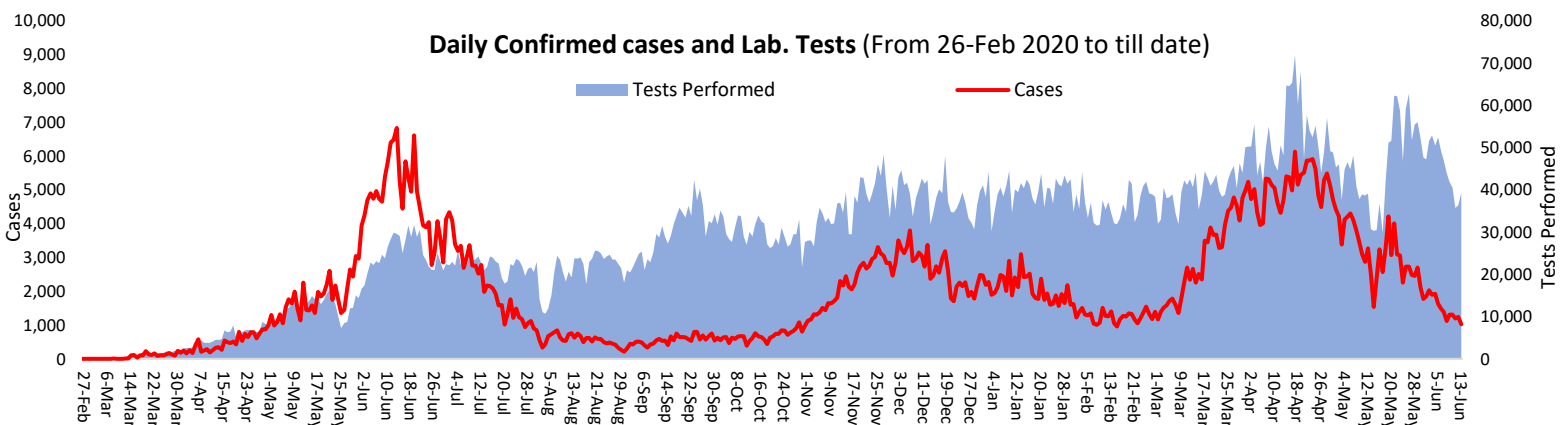
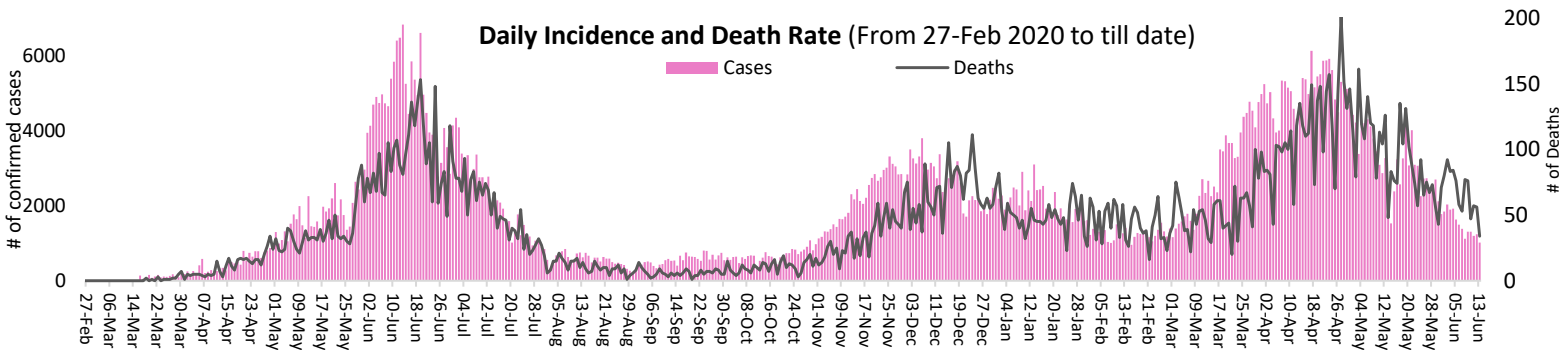

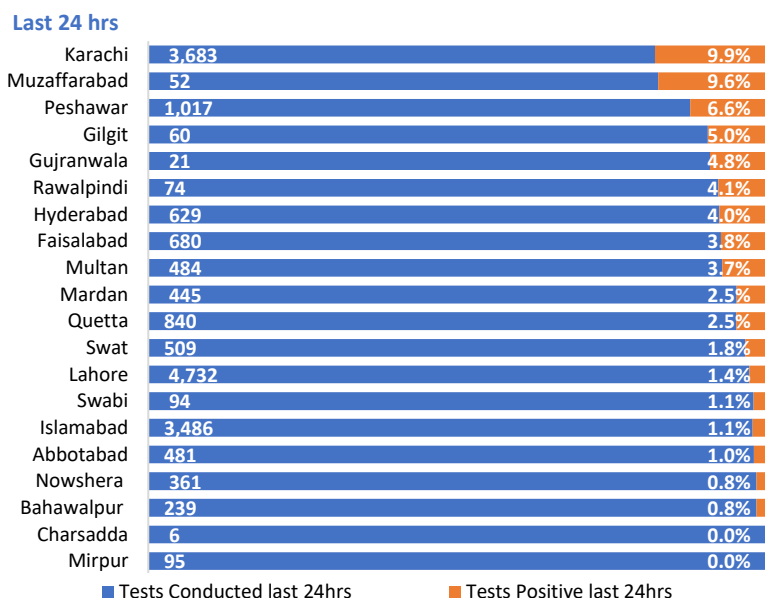
Meeting and Coordination



The World Health Organization, Pakistan is supporting the training of health care providers on family planning and community engagement at the National Rural Support Program Office, Kech District, Balochistan province. The four-day training that commenced on the 14th June 2021 was officiated by the Divisional Director Health, Dr Akhtar Ali. The Chief Epidemiologist and Provincial Coordinator Universal Health Coverage, Dr Ahmed Baloch attended the opening ceremony.

Over 180 participants; Medical Officers, Medical Technicians, Vaccinators, Lady Health visitors, Lady health workers and Dispensers from 30 Basic Health Units are attending the training. The Divisional Director in his opening remarks, appreciated WHO support towards this training that is envisaged to enhance reproductive health knowledge and skills of the health workers.
