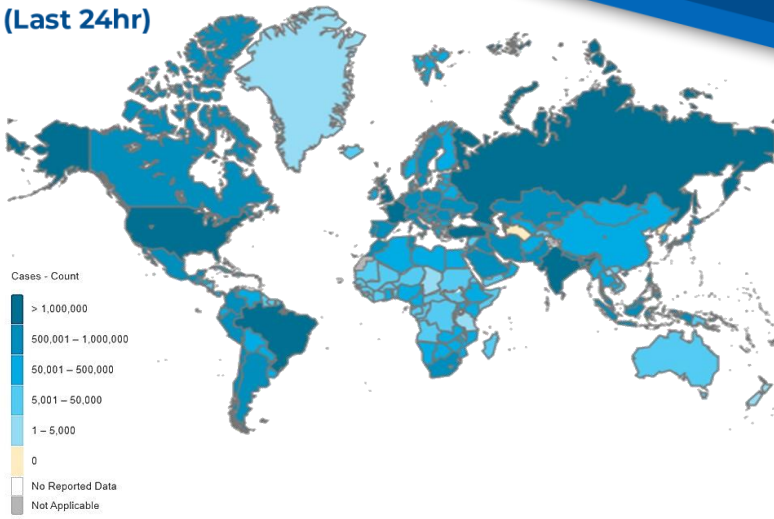


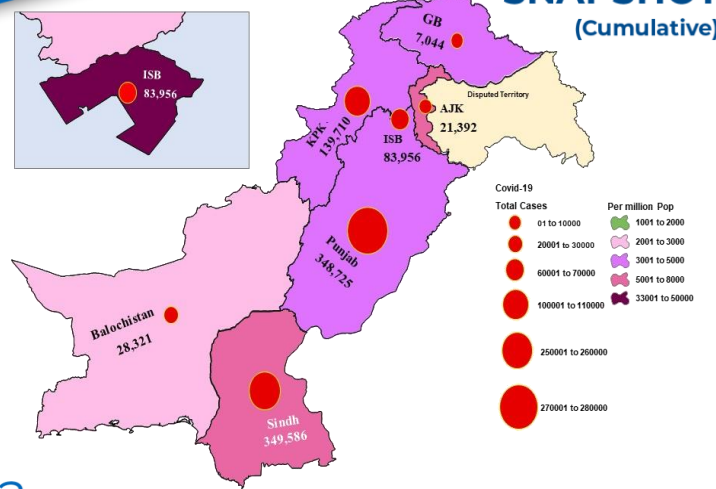

## PAKISTAN COVID-19 SNAPSHOT (Cumulative)

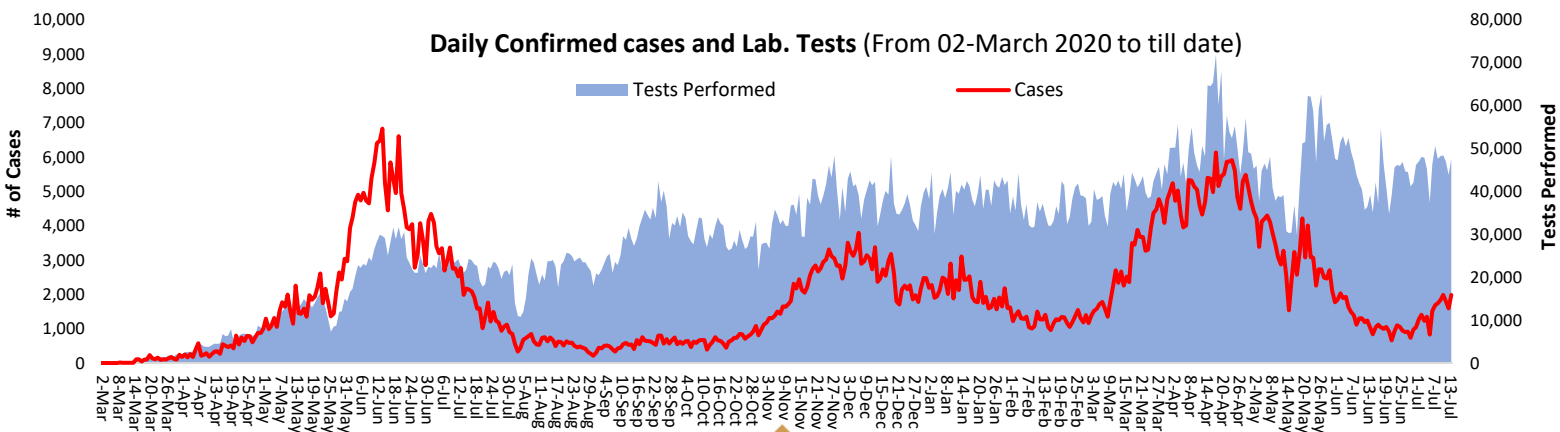
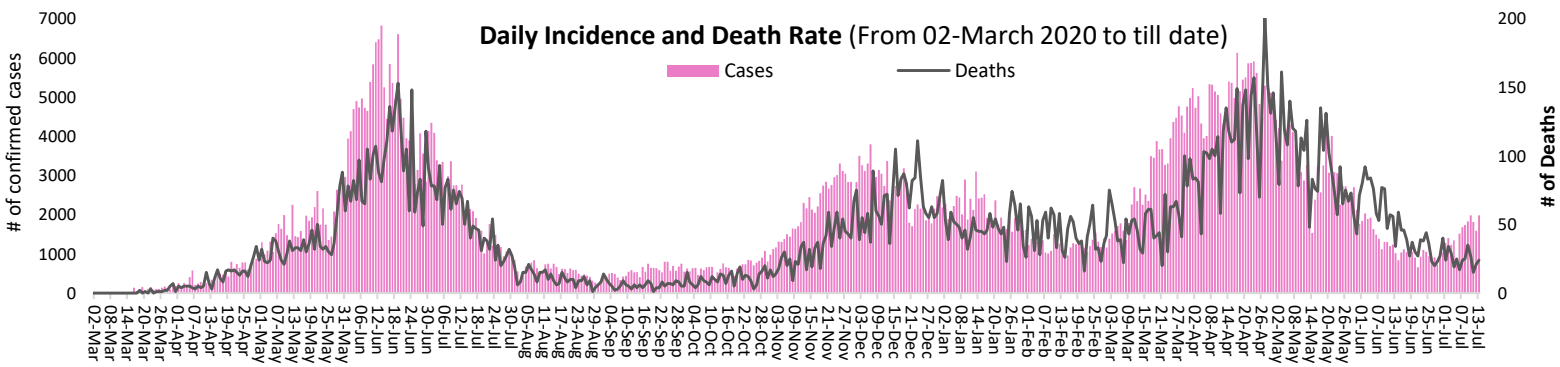

## Meeting and Coordination

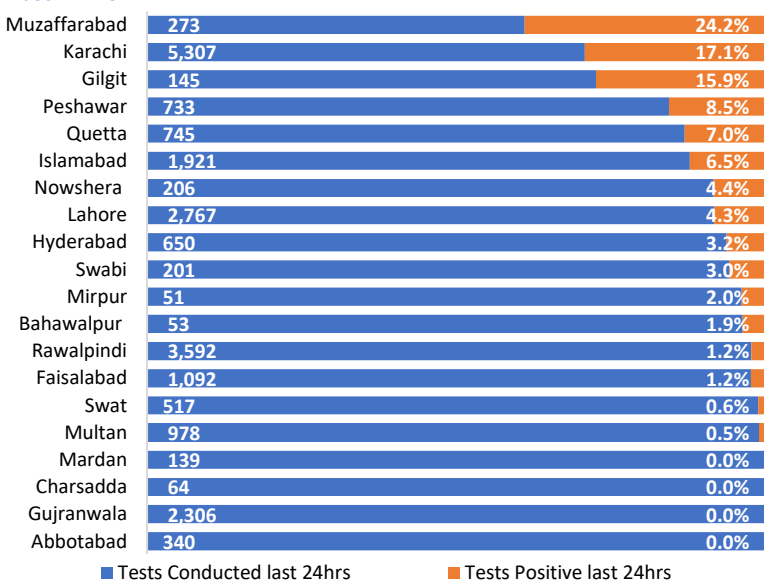


On 14<sup>th</sup> July 2021, WHO Country Representative Pakistan, Dr Palitha Mahipala paid a courtesy call to the Federal Minister for States and Frontier Regions, Hon. Sahibzada Muhammad Mehboob Sultan at his Office in Islamabad. The two officials discussed the COVID-19 situation globally and locally. Dr Palitha briefed the Minister on the contributions of WHO and partners to the response, the need to further strengthen case detection, contact tracing and enhanced surveillance at the point of entry in view of the circulating SARS CoV2 variants of concern (VoC) in the region. During the meeting, the WR presented to the Federal Minister WHO annual Report 2020, WHO quarterly Newsletter, and copies of Pakistan daily COVID-19 Situation reports for 2021.

The Hon. Federal Minister appreciated WHO for the technical and financial support to Pakistan. The two officials committed to continued close working relationship.
