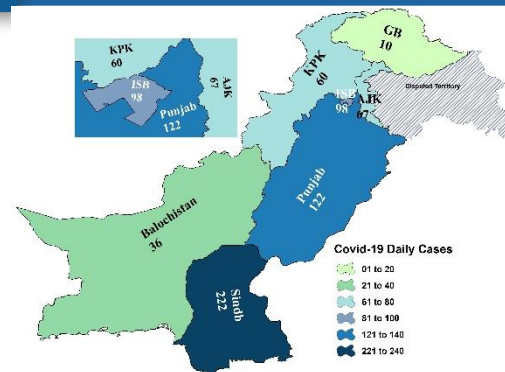

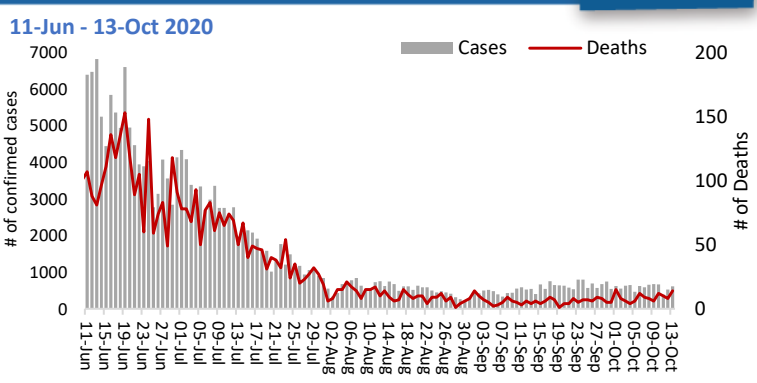
Executive Summary

Pakistan reported **615** new cases of COVID-19 on **13 October 2020**. The total number of cases notified since the beginning of the outbreak is **320,463** with **6,601** deaths (**CFR: 2.06%**). Out of the total **8,782** currently active cases, **853** cases are hospitalized, out of which **518 (60.72%)** are in critical condition. **7,929** COVID-19 positive cases are at designated isolation facilities or in-home isolation. A total of **305,080 (95.19%)** have recovered and discharged.

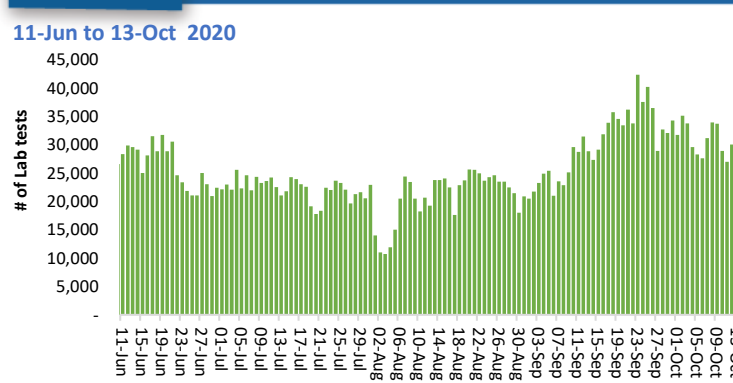
Daily Incidence by Province



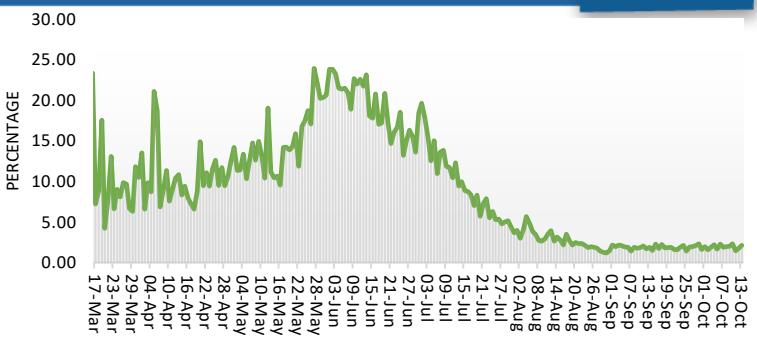
Daily Incidence/Mortality (11-Jun - 13-Oct 2020)



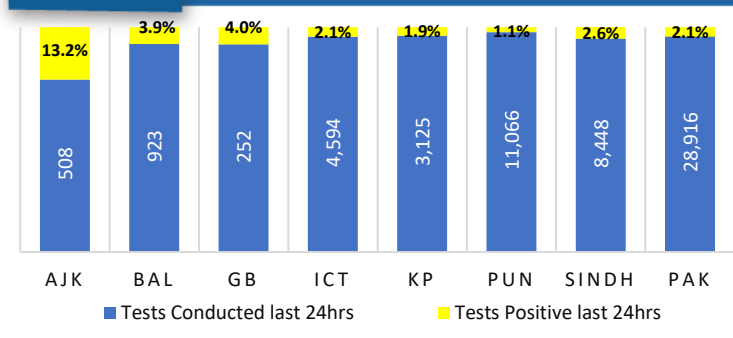
Daily Lab Test conducted (11-Jun to 13-Oct 2020)

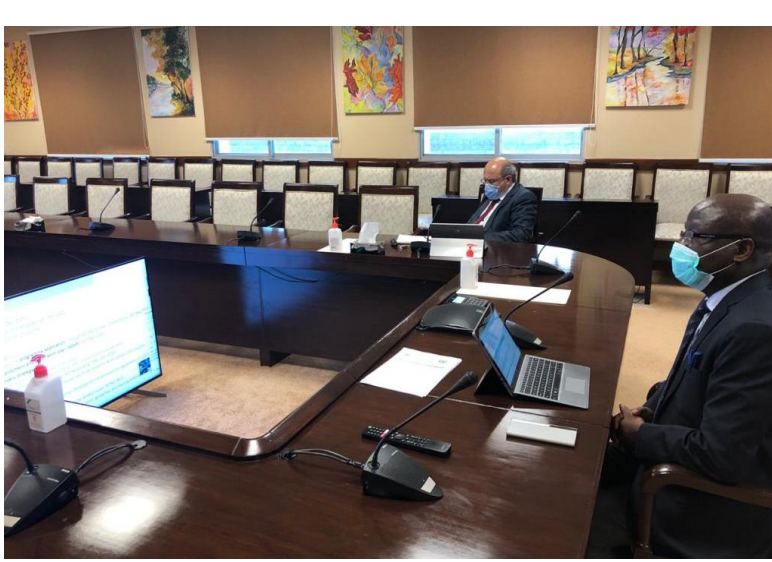

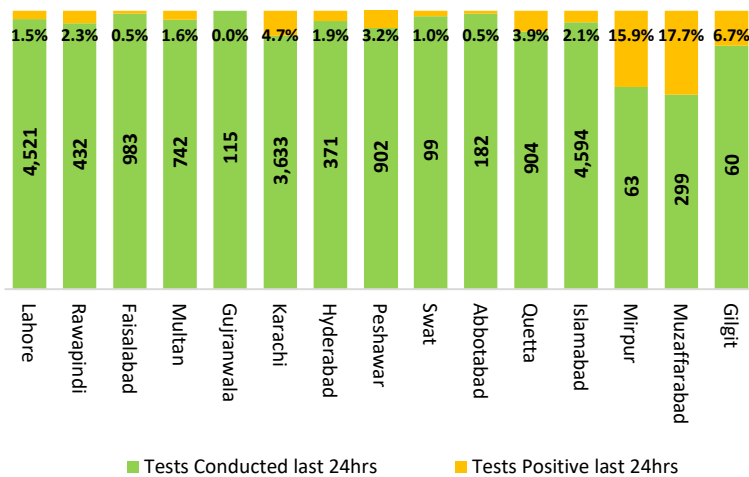
