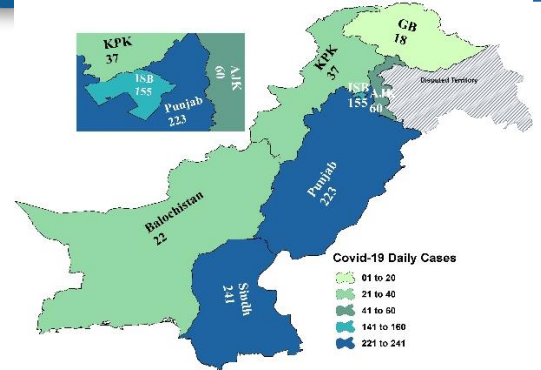

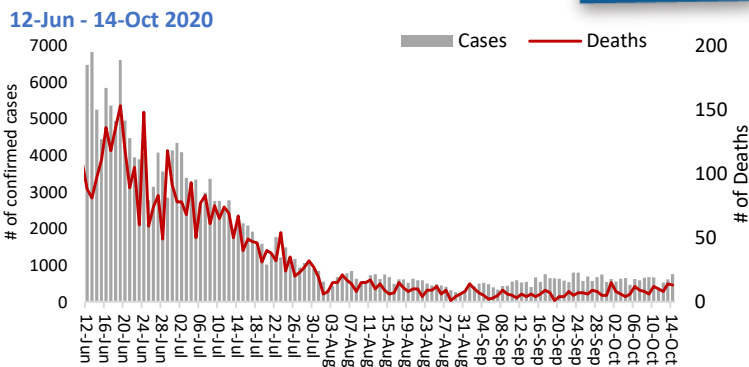
Executive Summary

Pakistan reported **756** new cases of COVID-19 on **14 October 2020**. The total number of cases notified since the beginning of the outbreak is **321,218** with **6,614** deaths (**CFR: 2.06%**). Out of the total **9,209** currently active cases, **796** cases are hospitalized, out of which **533 (66.96%)** are in critical condition. **8,413** COVID-19 positive cases are at designated isolation facilities or in-home isolation. A total of **305,395 (95.07%)** have recovered and discharged.

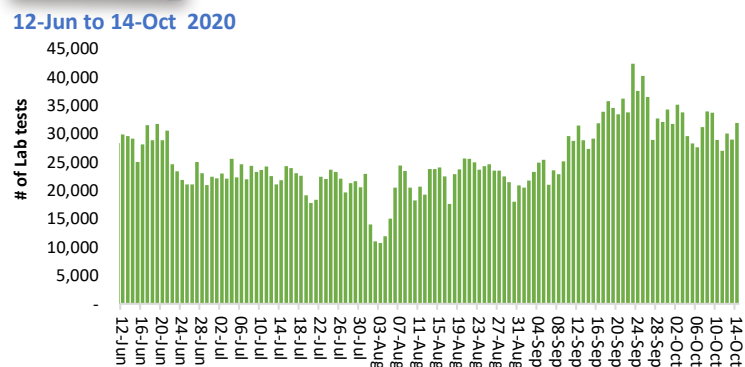
Daily Incidence by Province



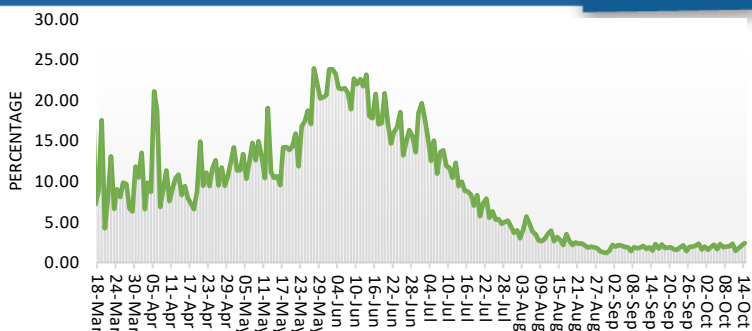
Daily Incidence/Mortality



Daily Lab Tests conducted

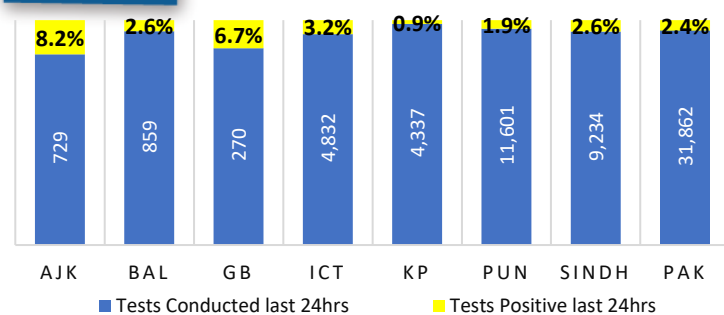


Daily COVID-19 Positivity Rate

A team of WHO experts arrived in the country to conduct a qualitative analysis of the COVID-19 response to identify strengths, areas for improvement and provide technical assistance in strategic planning in the short, mid and longer-term in the areas of laboratory diagnosis, surveillance and service continuity in order to optimize the WHO contribution to a stronger, more resilient health system in Pakistan.

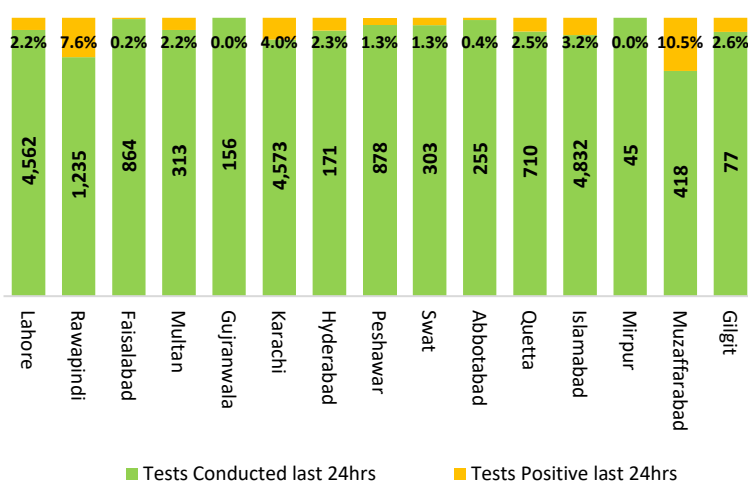
Dr Palitha briefed the mission on the current COVID-19 situation, the Government of Pakistan response and WHO contributions for the Pandemic control efforts in the country.
