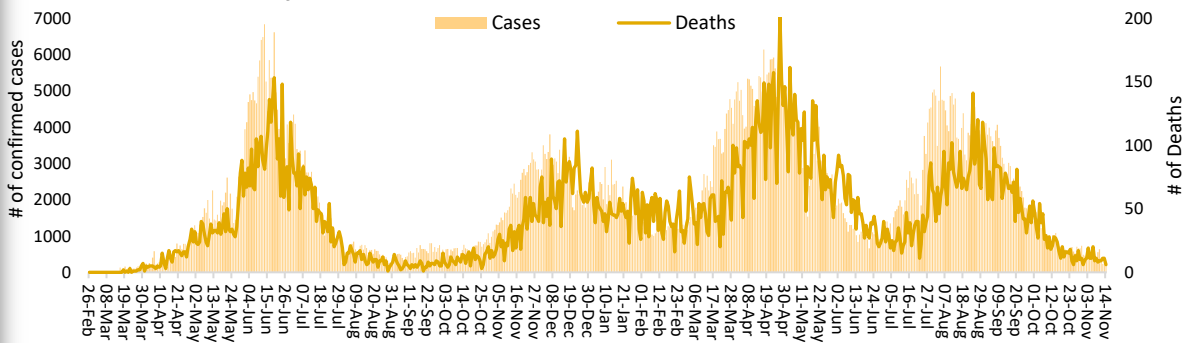

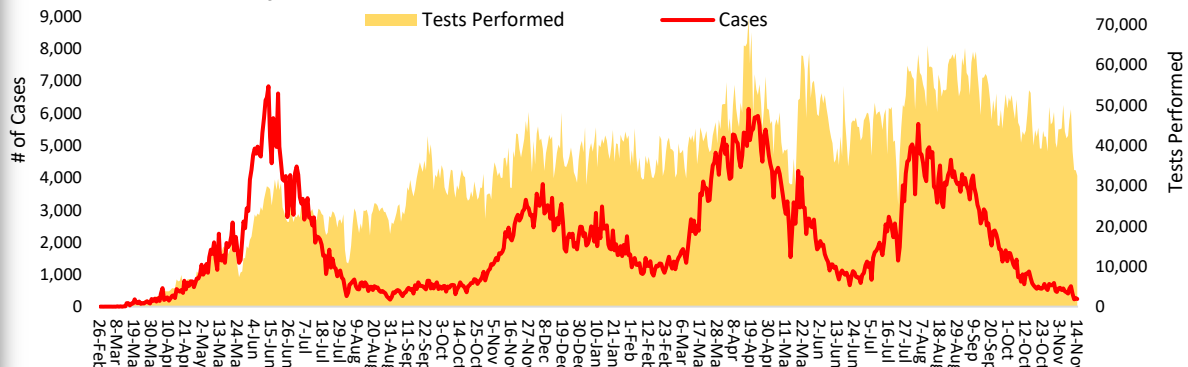

On 13th November 2021, WHO Country Representative Pakistan, Dr Palitha Mahipala visited the Rural Health Center (RHC) Tarlai, Islamabad to assess their readiness status for the Measles-Rubella (MR) campaign that is slated to take place countrywide from 15th to 27th November 2021. The WR was accompanied by the Technical Officer for Immunization, WHO/ EMRO, Dr Osama Mere and the EPI team from WHO country office. The WR and team were received at site by The District Health Officer Islamabad Capital Territory (ICT), Dr Zaeem Zia and District Health Management Team. Dr Zaeem briefed the WR on ICT's preparatory activities and the level of readiness for the MR campaign. Dr Palitha interacted with vaccinators, frontline healthcare workers and visited different sections of the RHC. He applauded the District Health Team and health workers for the team spirit exhibited in the preparation for the MR campaign.
