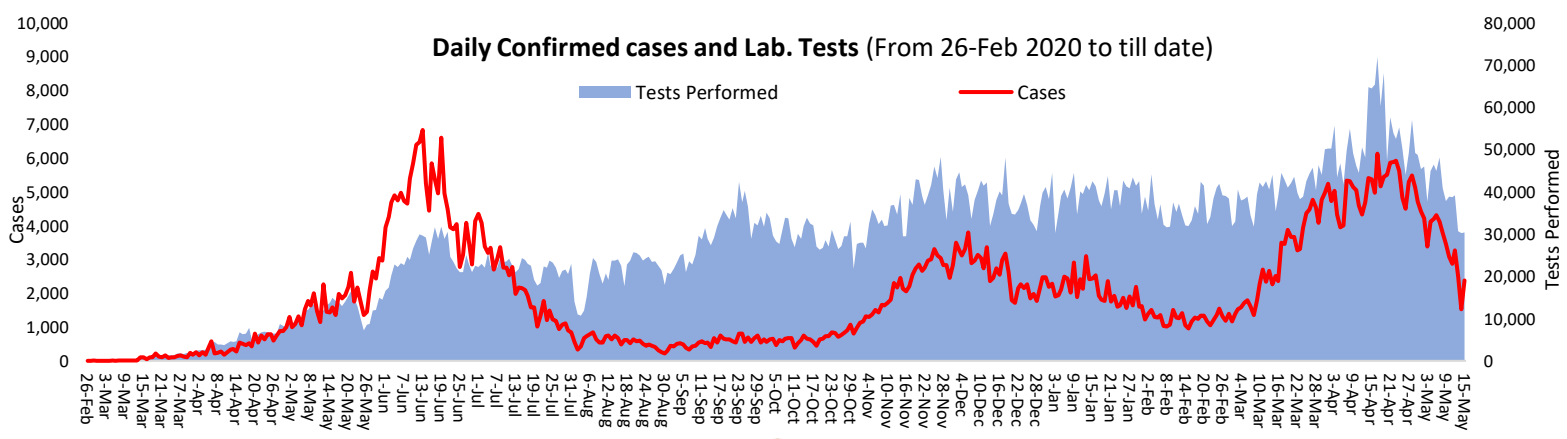

Meeting and Coordination



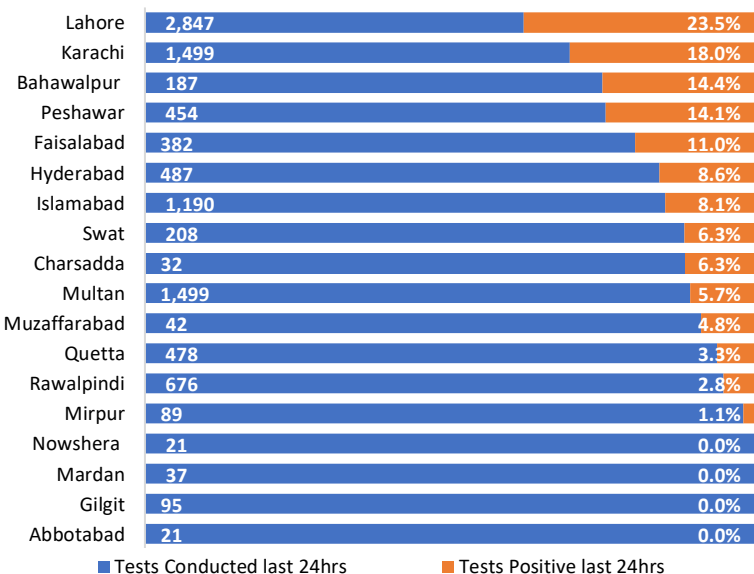
The Ministry of National Health Services Regulation & Coordination (MONHSR&C) with support from WHO Pakistan is in the process of reviewing PRRP 2020 and developing PRRP 2021. A preparatory meeting was convened by the WR Pakistan, Dr Palitha Mahipala on the 1st May 2021 to discuss the process. The meeting was attended by: Director Programs (II), MONHSR&C, Dr Samra Mazhar; Senior Scientific Officer (Epidemiology), National Institute of Health, Dr Mumtaz Ali Khan; Representative National Disaster Management Authority, Ms Tania Humayun and Director M&E, Federal EPI Program, Dr Kashif Hussain.

During the meeting, Dr Palitha briefed the delegates on; the national, Regional and Global COVID 19 situation and the response measures recommended by WHO. He further guided on the PRRP 2021 preparation.

Dr Samra briefed the meeting on PRRP 2020 implementation and funds utilization status. The meeting recommended the formation of technical working group under the MONHSR&C, covering the 10 response pillars. It is envisaged that PRRP 2021 will be launched in June 2021.
