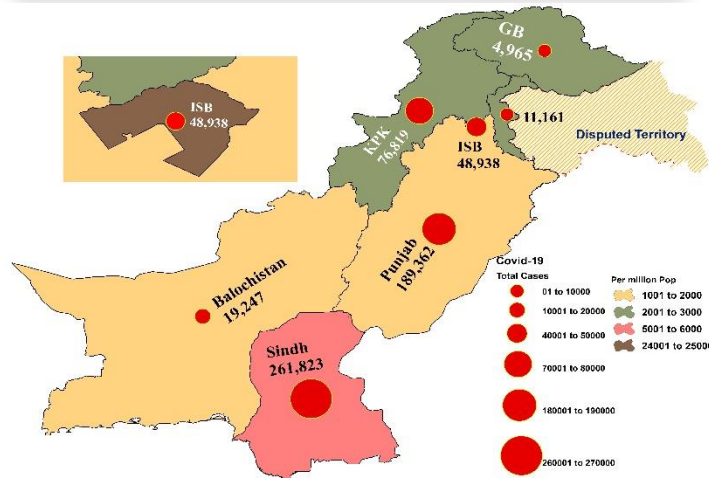

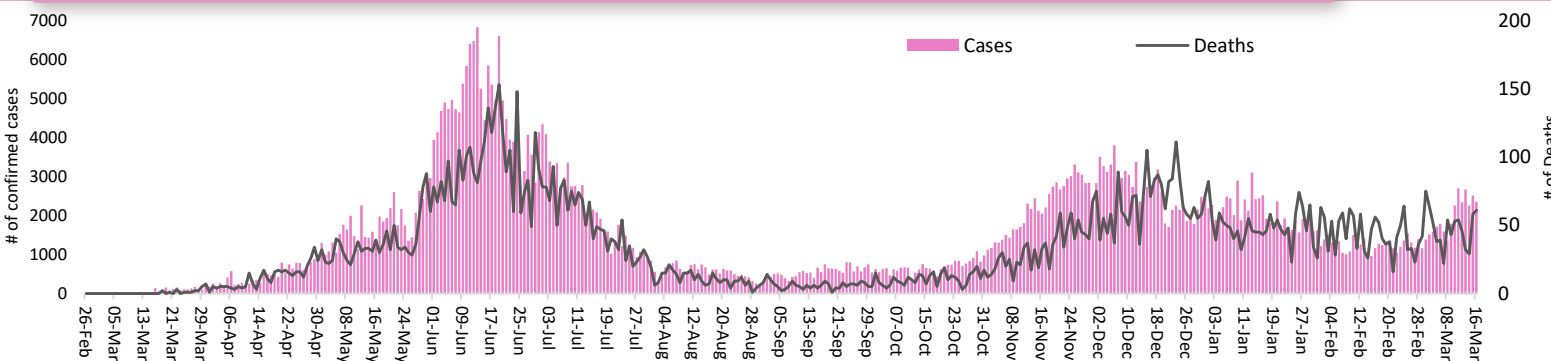

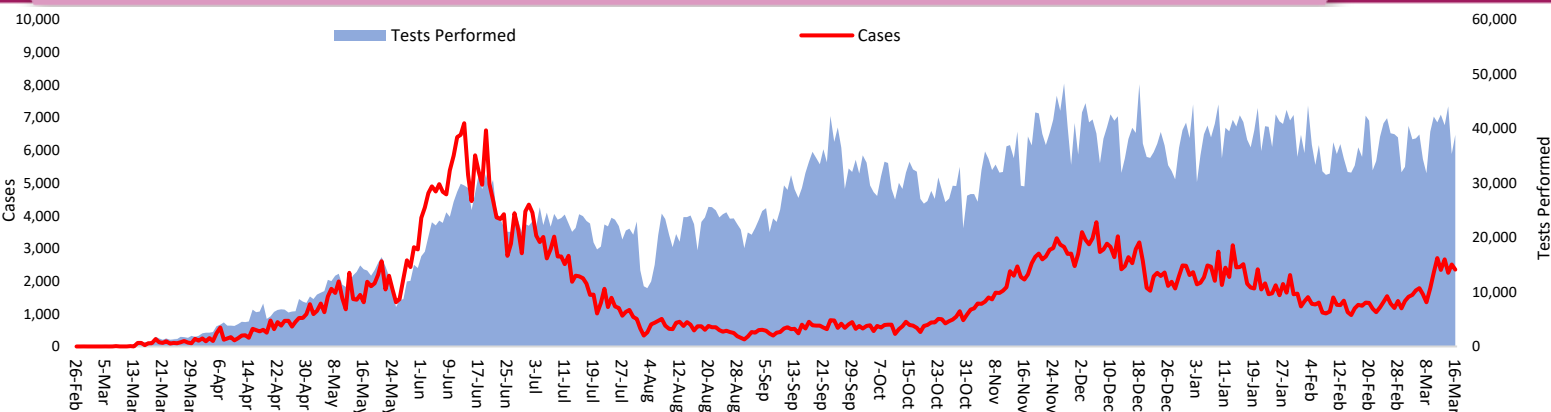

On 15<sup>th</sup> March 2021, WHO Country Representative Pakistan, Dr Palitha Mahipala participated in the ceremony to launch the 2020 maternal, newborn and child health report at Serena Hotel, Islamabad. The ceremony was graced by Parliamentary Secretary for Health, Dr Nosheen Hamid and Director General Health, Ministry of National Health Services Regulation and Coordination, Dr Rana Safdar. The report highlighted progress on key RMNCAH indicators especially the declining trends in fertility rate, maternal, neonatal and under-five mortality though at a slow pace. The report provides evidence for advocacy and accountability towards achievement of Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs).

During his speech, Dr Palitha appreciated the Government of Pakistan's commitment towards improving health of the people of Pakistan with a special focus on marginalized segments of society including women and children.
