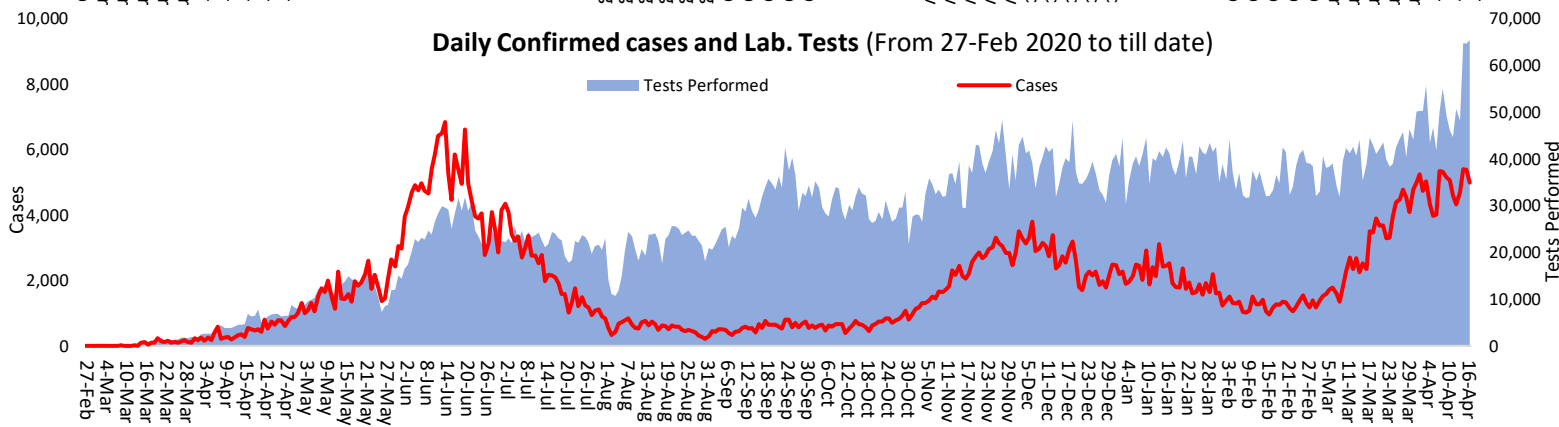

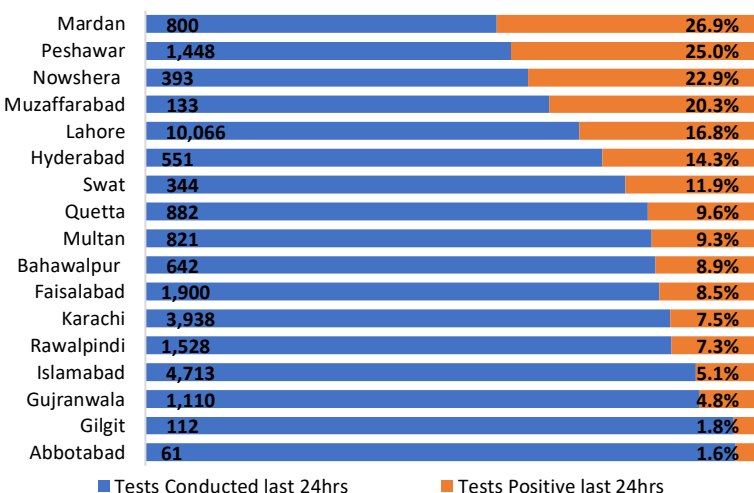


WHO Country Representative Pakistan, Dr Palitha Mahipala along with WHE team launched the fourth edition of WHO Pakistan quarterly newsletter. The newsletter highlights WHO's support to the government of Pakistan to suppress transmission, reduce exposure, counter mis-information and dis-information, protect the vulnerable population, reduce mortality and morbidity from all causes and accelerate equitable access to new COVID-19 tools including vaccines, diagnostics and therapeutics.

During the launch Dr Palitha stated that it is now over one year since the first case of COVID-19 was notified, currently we are in the middle of the third wave and there is an emergence of new variant which may negatively impact the ongoing vaccination. He called upon all partners to continue supporting the government to respond to the challenge.
