WHO Country Representative Pakistan, Dr Palitha Mahipala conducted support supervisory visit to Sindh province from 11th to 13th August 2021. On 13th August 2021, the WR launched a health education campaign at the EPI Office in Sindh Province focusing on wearing of mask, hand hygiene and social distancing a key component in COVID 19 prevention. The launching ceremony was graced by Provincial Health Minister Sindh, Dr Azra Pechuho and the Project Director EPI, Sindh. During the launch, WR handed over 13,000 streamers and 100,000 masks to the Health Department. This was in addition to the IPC supplies donated to Jinnah International Airport, Karachi.

The Hon. Provincial Health Minister thanked the WR for launching the Health Education Campaign and donation, that he noted will help in prevention of COVID infections.
