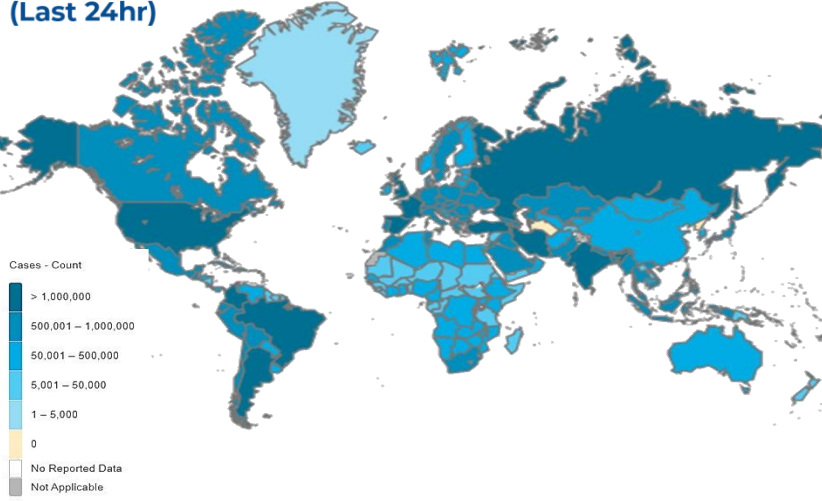
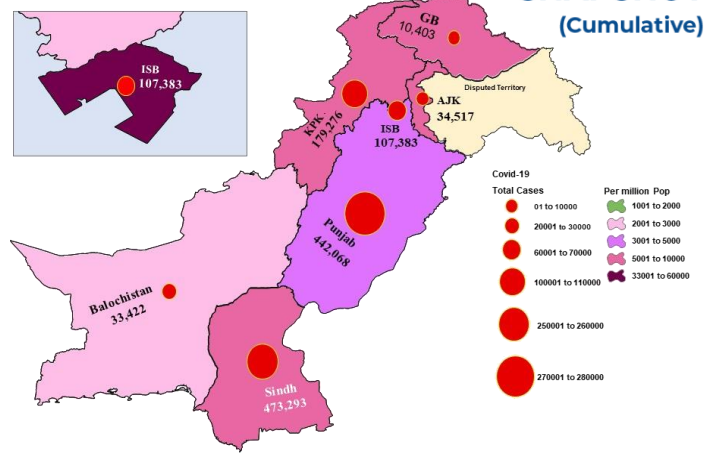

PAKISTAN COVID-19 SNAPSHOT (Cumulative)

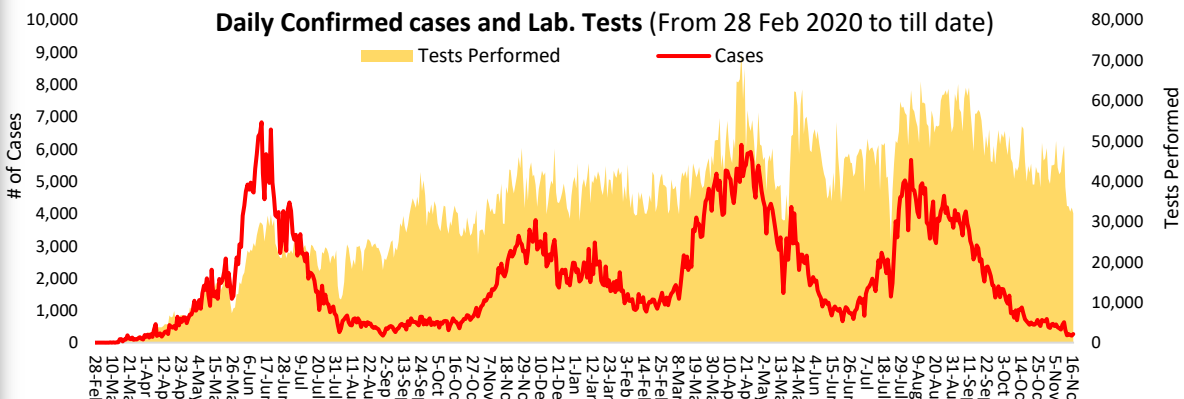
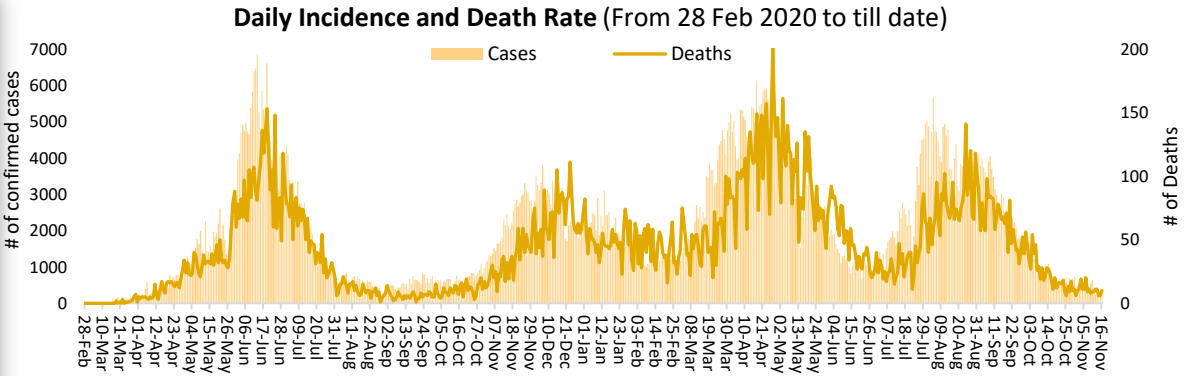

On 16th November 2021, the Ministry of National Health Services, Regulations, and coordination in collaboration with WHO Pakistan held a stakeholder consultative meeting on the development of a unified patient safety standards that Integrates WHO patient safety and Provincial Health Care Commission (HCC) Standards at Serena Hotel Islamabad. The Deputy Director Program, MoNHSR&C Dr Sabeen Afzal, Technical officer WHO Pakistan, Dr Ali Shirazi, Technical Officer Patient Safety WHO HQ Dr Irina Papieva and Regional Advisor Quality & Patient Safety EMRO Dr Mondher Letaief participated in the meeting. Other participants included policymakers from provincial health departments and healthcare commission. In his remarks, Dr Ali Shirazi emphasized on the need to enhance patient safety and quality standards at both hospital and PHC levels. Dr Sabeen Afzal appreciated WHO for promoting patient safety during health care delivery.
