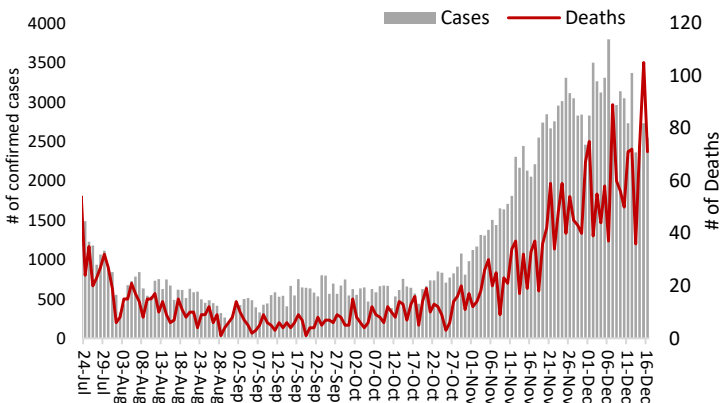

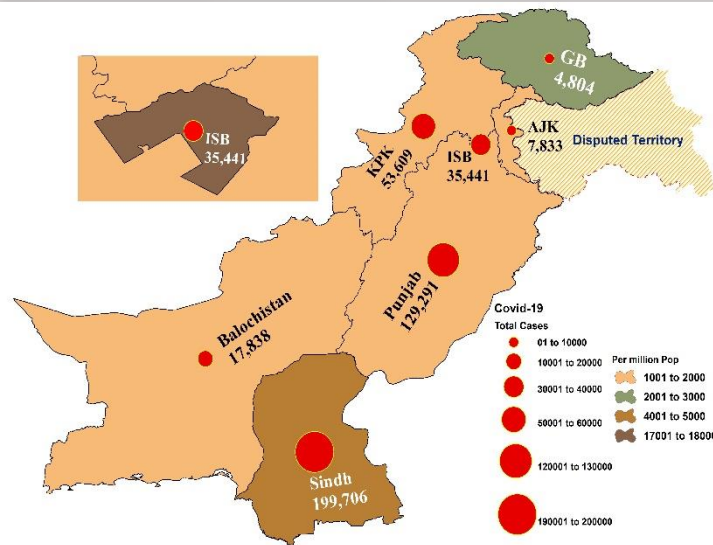


INCIDENCE & DEATHS BY DATE

24-Jul - 16-Dec 2020



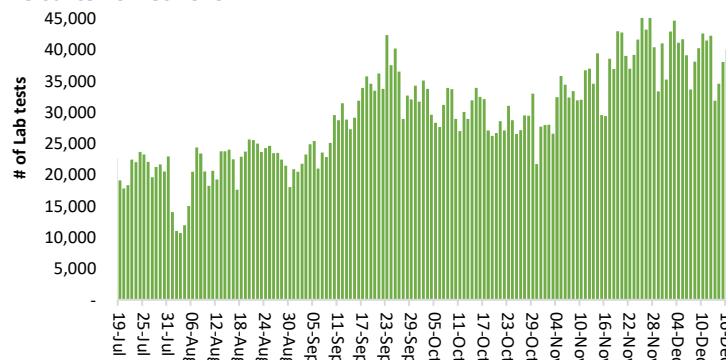
TOTAL CASES & CASES PER MILLION POP.



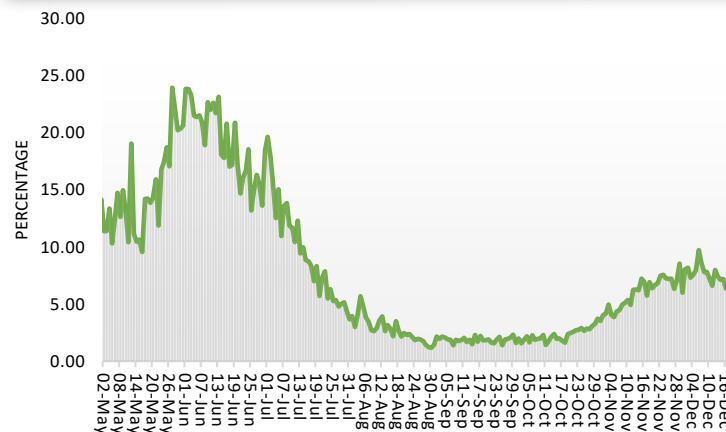
Pakistan reported **2,545** new cases of COVID-19 on **16 December 2020**. The total number of cases notified since the beginning of the outbreak is **448,522** with **9,080** deaths (**CFR: 2.02%**). Out of the total **42,851** currently active cases **3,050** cases are hospitalized.

MEETINGS & COORDINATION

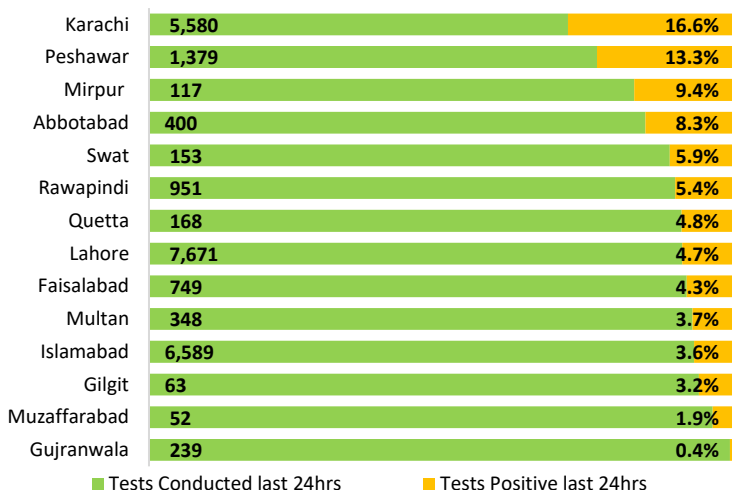
