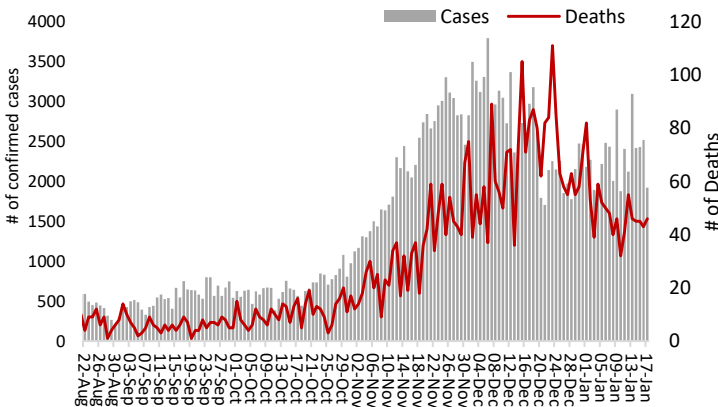

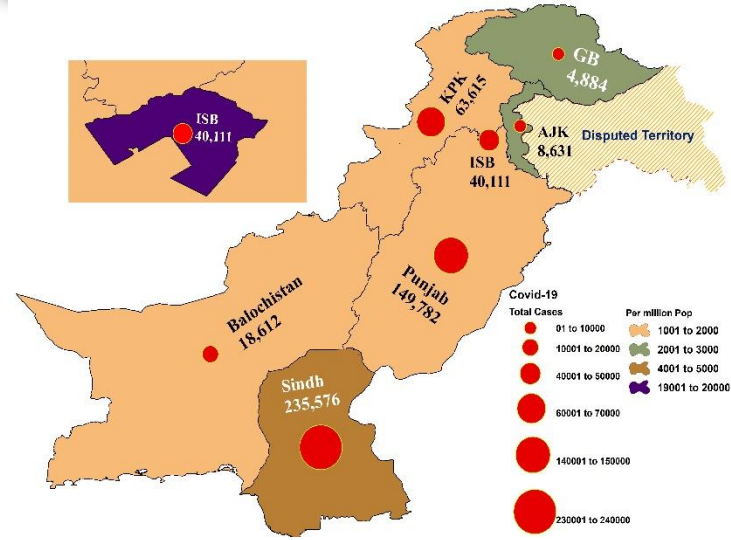


### INCIDENCE & DEATHS BY DATE

22-Aug 2020 - 17-Jan 2021



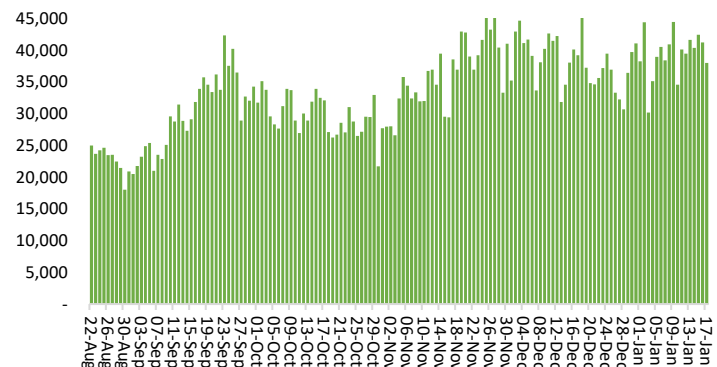
### TOTAL CASES & CASES PER MILLION POP.



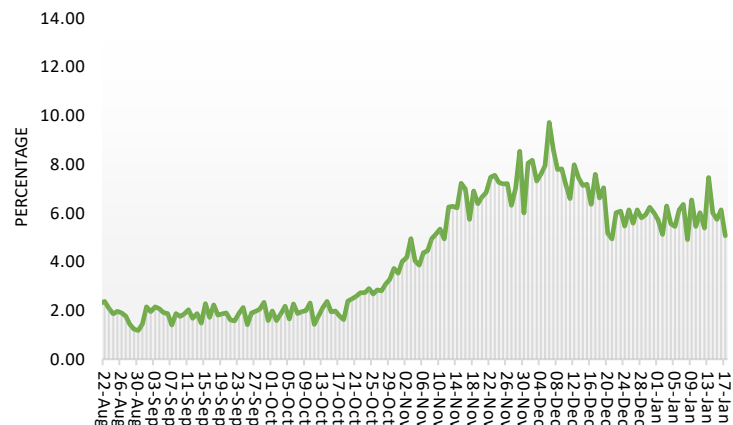
Pakistan reported **1,920** new cases of COVID-19 on **17 January 2021**. The total number of cases notified since the beginning of the outbreak is **521,211** with **10,997** deaths (**CFR: 2.11%**). Out of the total **34,986** currently active cases **2,849** cases are hospitalized.

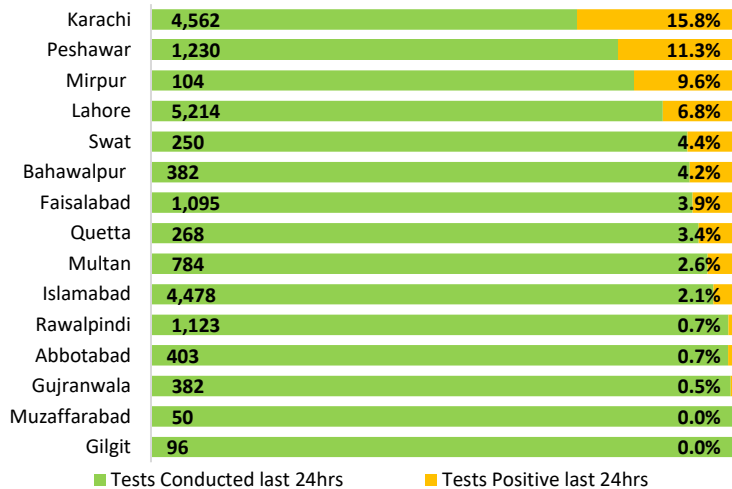
## MEETINGS & COORDINATION
