

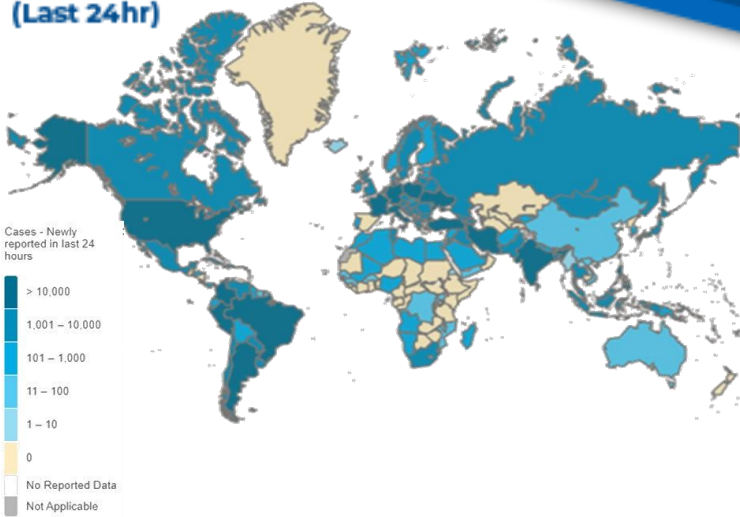

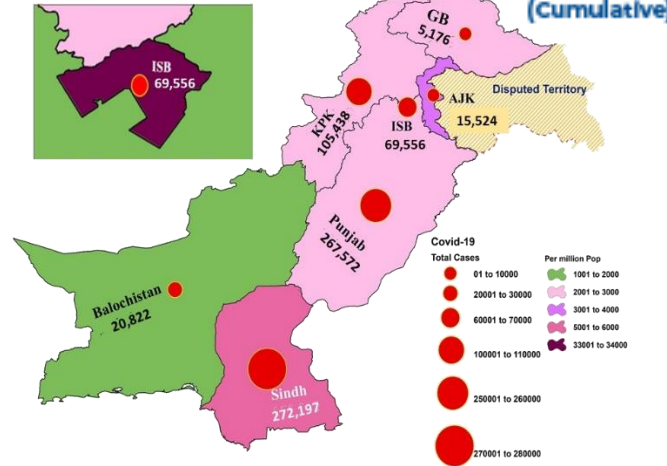

## PAKISTAN COVID-19 SNAPSHOT (Cumulative)

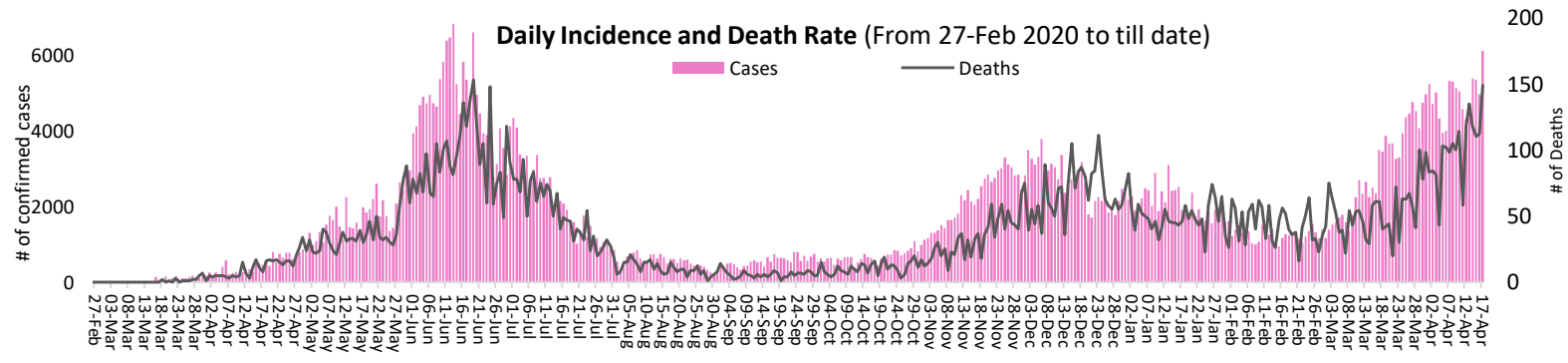

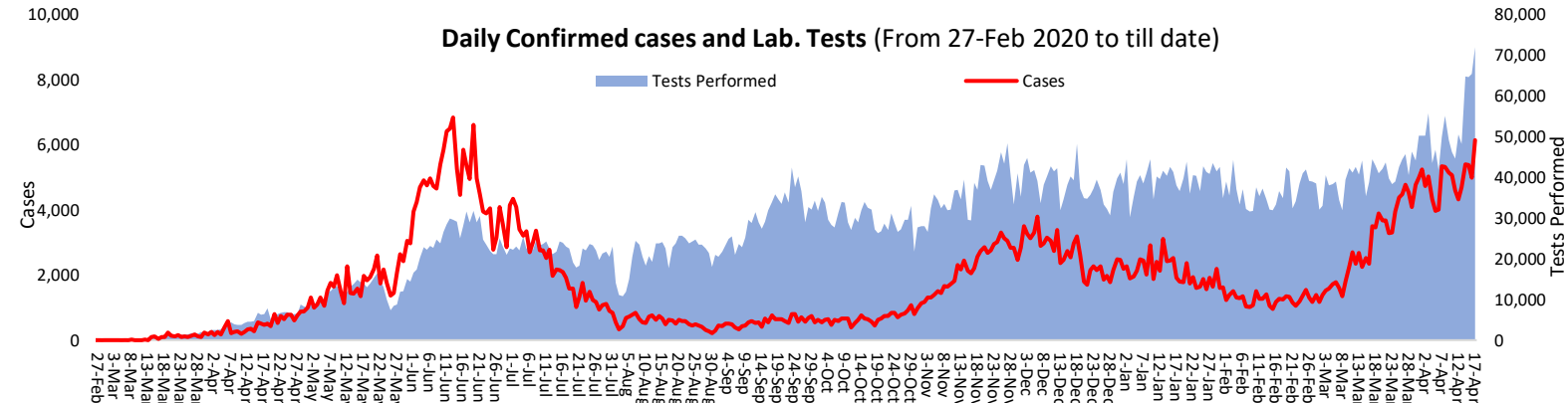

## Meeting and Coordination



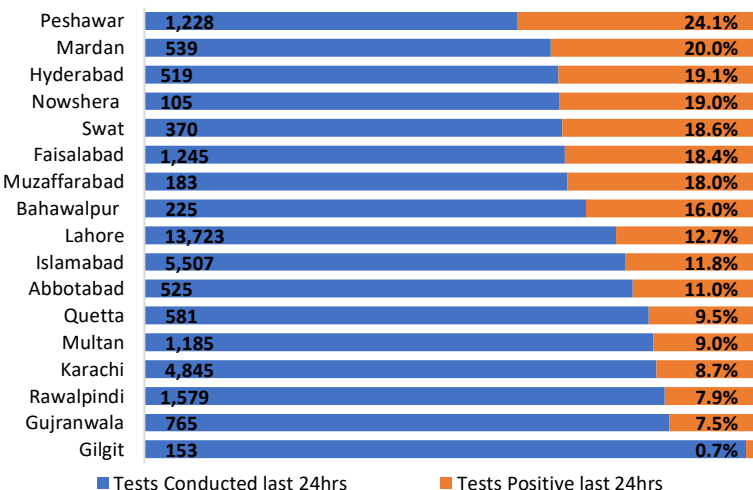
On 17<sup>th</sup> April 2021, WHO Country Representative Pakistan, Dr Palitha Mahipala, along with Director General Health Services Metropolitan Corporation Islamabad (MCI) Dr Hasan Orooj, and WHO EPI Team lead, Dr Osama Mere, visited Capital Development Authority Medical Centers at G-7/3 and G-9 Islamabad.

The purpose of the visit was to observe COVID 19 vaccination centers and how best WHO can support MCI for ensuring vaccination of all people of Islamabad. During the visit, Dr. Hasan Orooj addressed WHO delegation on COVID-19 infection pattern in Islamabad, the COVID-19 vaccination and support required to further the improvement of vaccination facilities in MCI.

Dr Palitha appreciated the staff of the MCI vaccination center for their hard work and due diligence. He urged people for strict implementation of the COVID-19 standard operating procedures (SOPs). WR also expressed his willingness to support further strengthening the COVID-19 vaccination centers.
