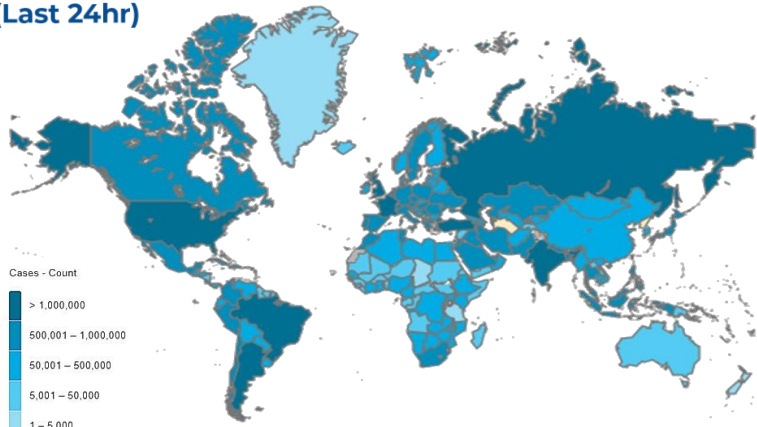
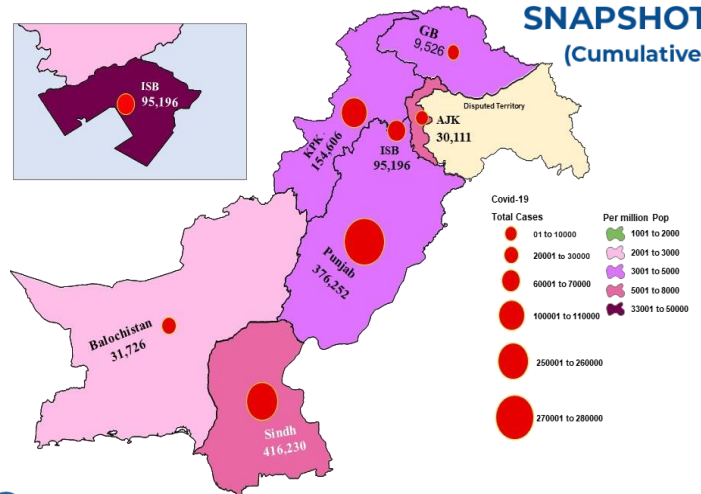

PAKISTAN COVID-19 SNAPSHOT (Cumulative)



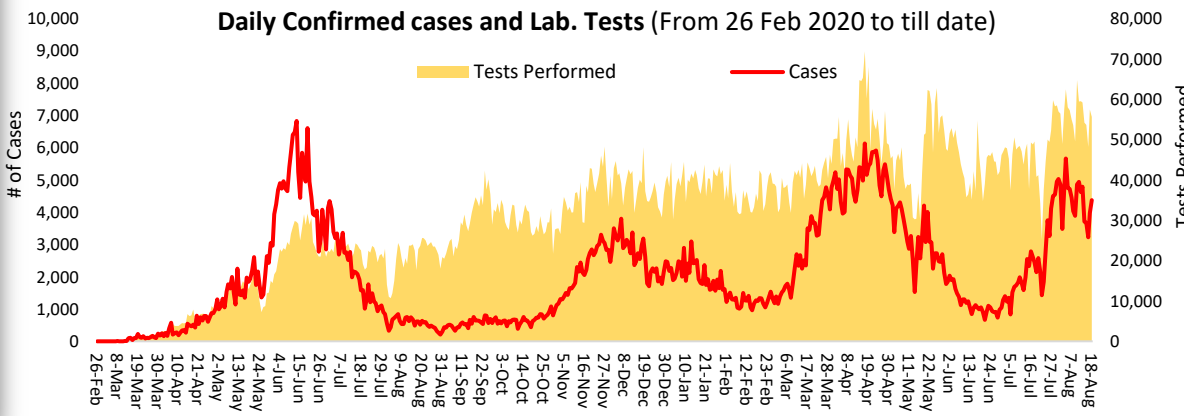
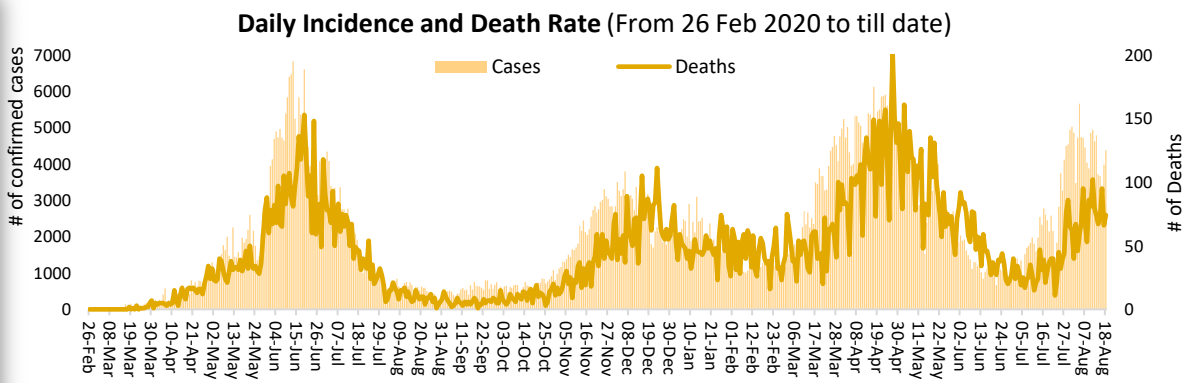

On 18th August 2021, WHO Country Representative Pakistan, Dr Palitha Mahipala met with United Nations Population Fund, (UNFPA) Acting representative Pakistan, Dr Bakhtior Kadirov at the WHO Country office Pakistan.

The two officials discussed: Service Availability and Readiness Assessment (SARA), health facility assessment tool and Gender Based Violence activities, Emergency obstetric care (EmOC), as well as future collaboration and joint activities in the country.

During the meeting, Dr Palitha gave a brief on the joint work by WHO and partners and the need for further collaboration to support the government to contain the COVID 19 Pandemic. Dr Bakhtior appreciated WHO technical support to the ongoing COVID 19 response. The two officials pledged to enhance collaboration and coordination to effectively support government programs.
