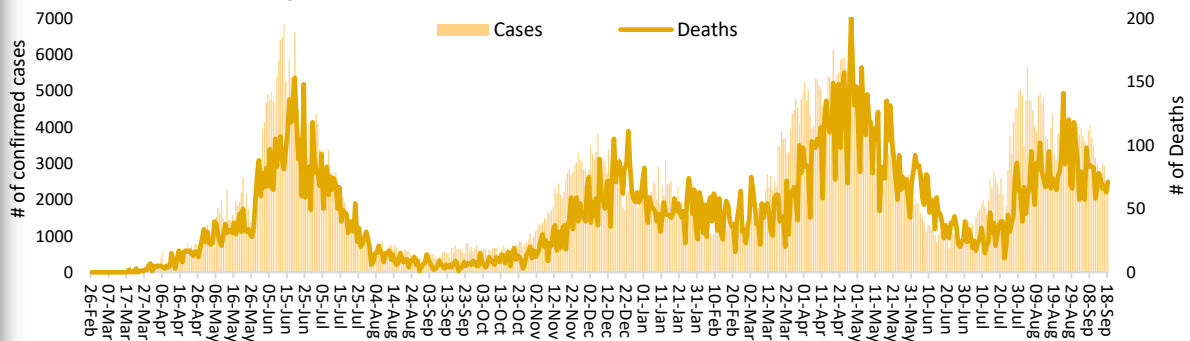

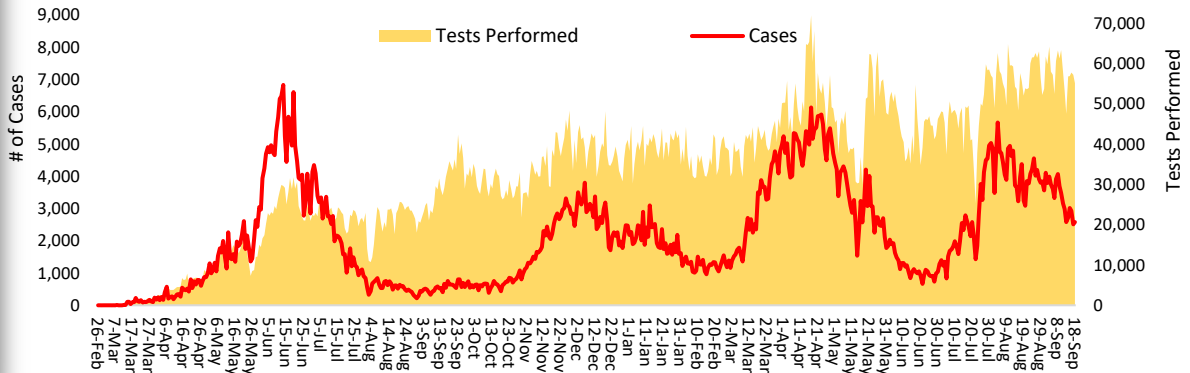

On 16th September 2021, Ministry of National Health Services Regulations and Coordination in collaboration with World Health Organization Pakistan commemorated the World Patient Safety Day under the theme "Safe Maternal and Newborn Care". One of the activities was the Illumination of Pakistan Monument in Islamabad and Provinces. The WR accompanied by technical officers from WHO Country Office visited the monument site in Islamabad. A pre-recorded message of Dr Palitha was displayed on the monument for public awareness. The messages emphasized on the need for commitment to bridge the gap in maternal and neonatal mortality to achieve the Sustainable Development Goal 3 targets and Universal Health Coverage in Pakistan. WHO Pakistan pledged continuous technical and financial support to the government in the promotion of patient safety in health facilities.
