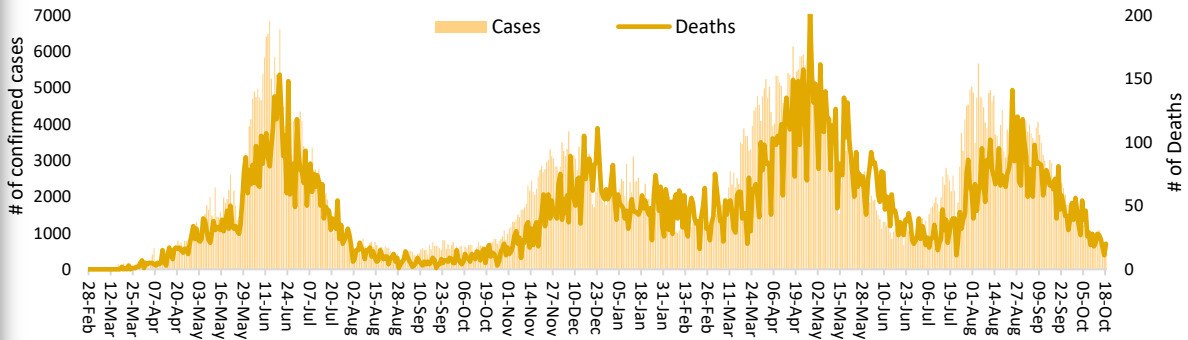

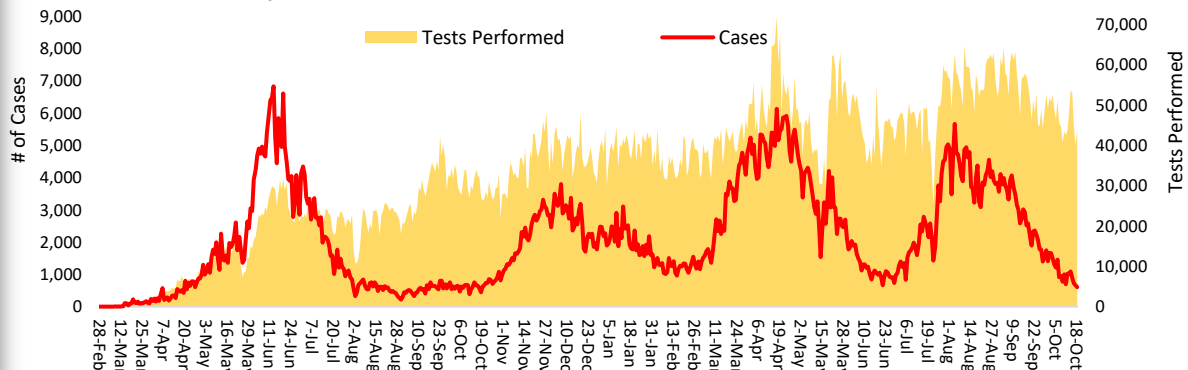

On 18th October 2021, WHO Country Representative Pakistan, Dr Palitha Mahipala paid a courtesy visit to the German Ambassador to Pakistan, Mr. Bernhard Stephan Schlagheck at the German Embassy, Islamabad. The objective of the courtesy visit was to discuss the current COVID-19 situation and response especially, the vaccination drive and genomic sequencing.

Dr Palitha briefed the ambassador on the status of COVID-19 vaccination, the joint work by WHO and partners and the need for further collaboration in supporting the government efforts to contain the COVID-19 Pandemic. The WR appreciated the support of Germany to the government of Pakistan through WHO, particularly to the COVAX facility in ensuring vaccine equity. The German Ambassador appreciated the technical and logistical support by WHO Pakistan to the government in the COVID 19 response.
