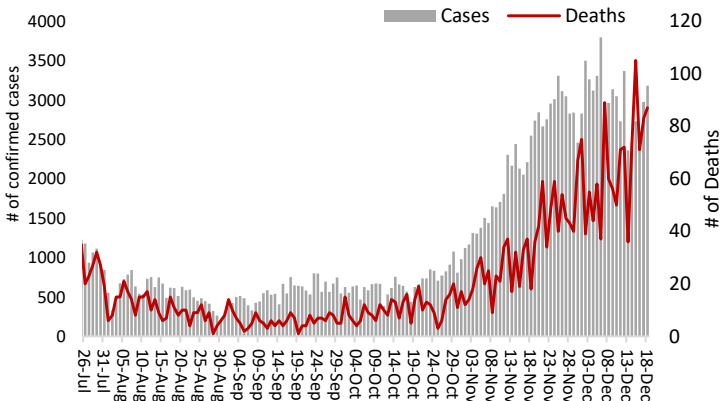

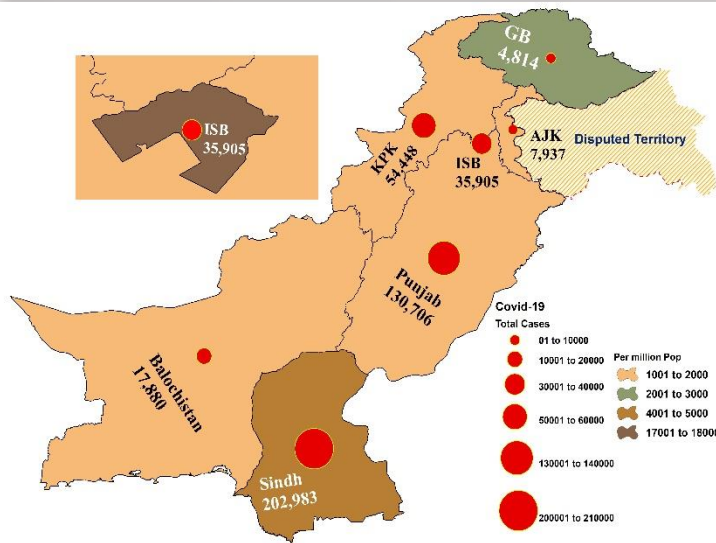


INCIDENCE & DEATHS BY DATE

26-Jul - 18-Dec 2020



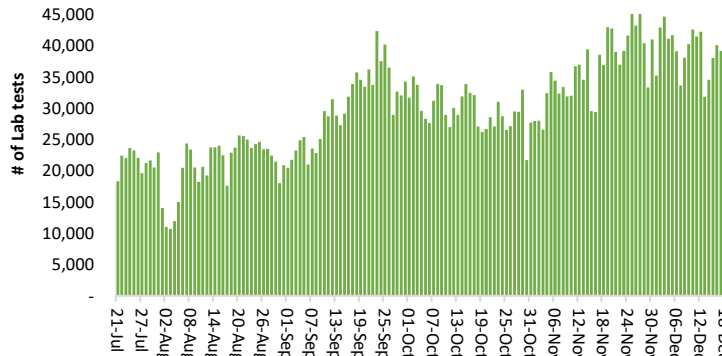
TOTAL CASES & CASES PER MILLION POP.



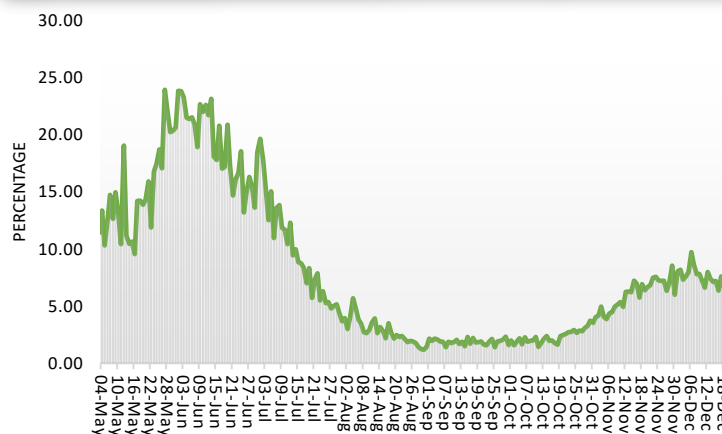
Pakistan reported **3,179** new cases of COVID-19 on **18 December 2020**. The total number of cases notified since the beginning of the outbreak is **454,673** with **9,250** deaths (**CFR: 2.03%**). Out of the total **40,936** currently active cases **2,999** cases are hospitalized.

MEETINGS & COORDINATION

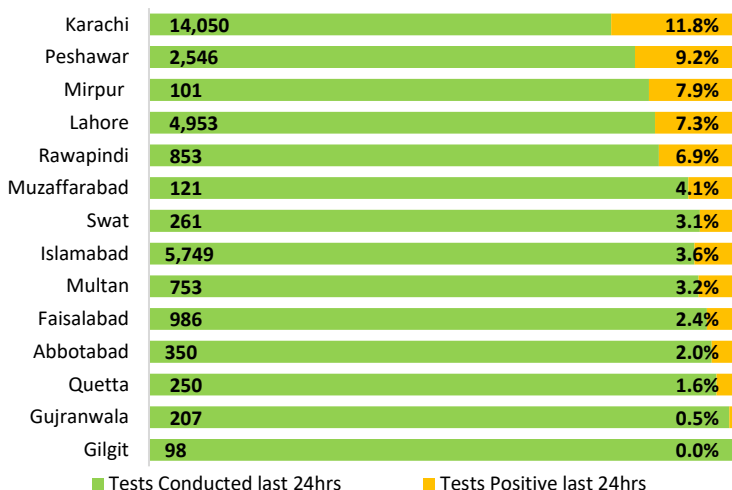
