

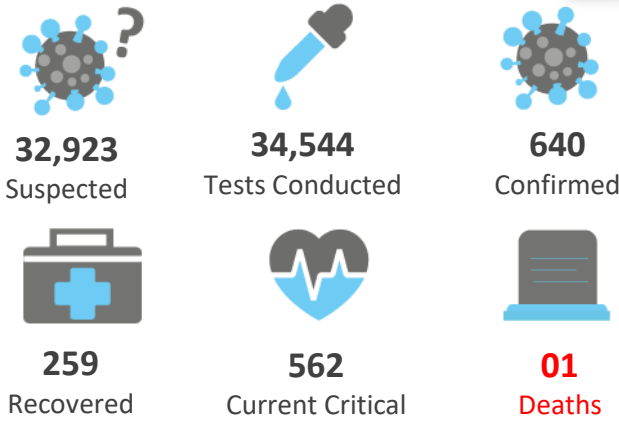

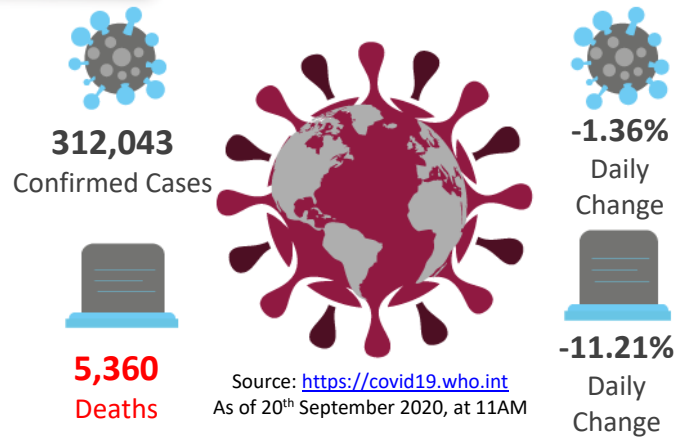

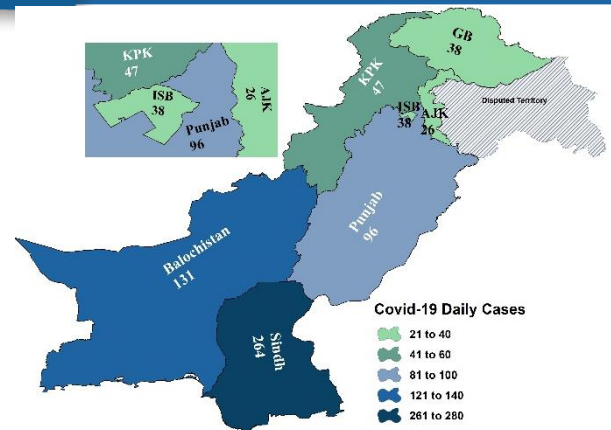
Daily COVID-19 Global Updates (Last 24hrs)



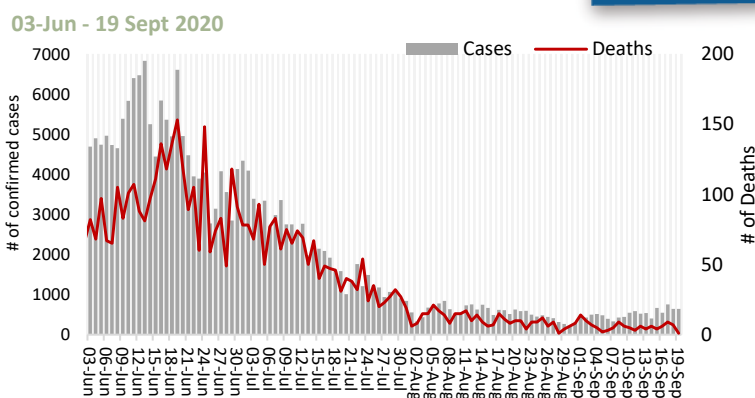
Executive Summary

Pakistan reported **640** new cases of COVID-19 on **19 September 2020**. The total number of cases notified since the beginning of the outbreak is **305,671** with **6,416** deaths (**CFR: 2.10%**). Out of the total **6,952** currently active cases, **837** cases are hospitalized, out of which **562 (67.14%)** are in critical condition. **6,115** COVID-19 positive cases are at designated isolation facilities or in-home isolation. A total of **292,303 (95.63%)** have recovered and discharged.

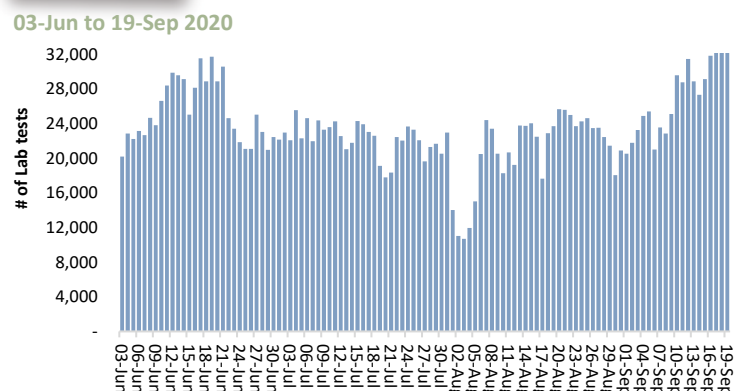
Daily Incidence by Province

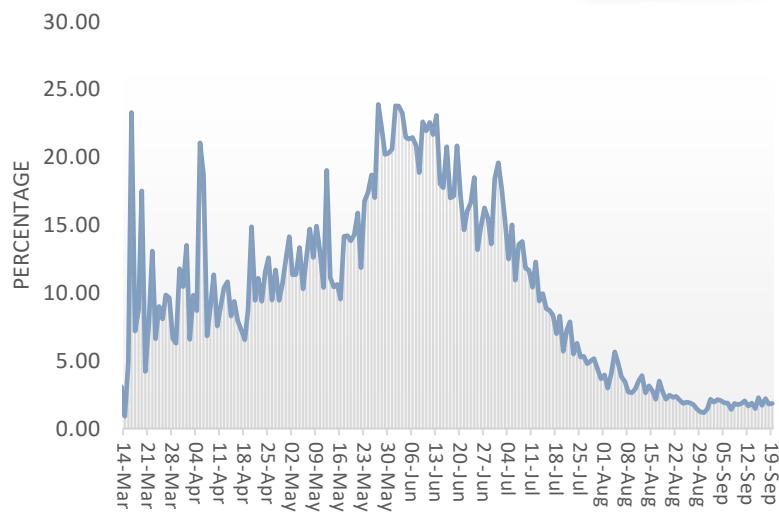

Maintaining Essential Health Services

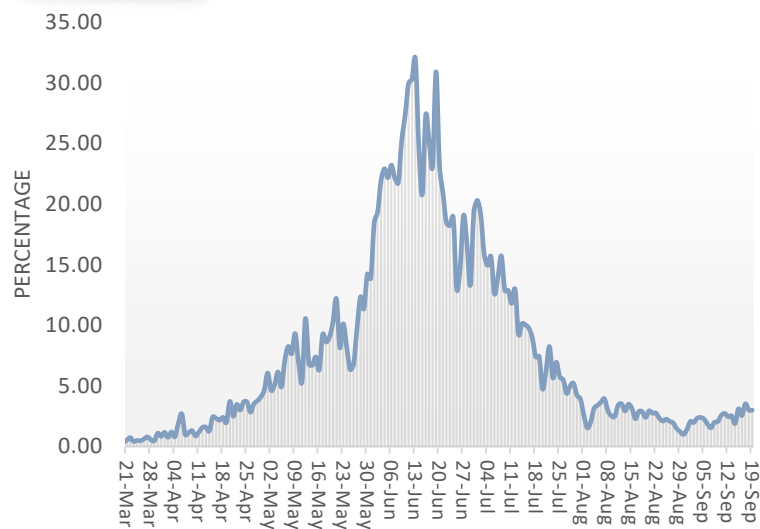

The planning meeting was attended by senior EPI officer, District Focal Person, District Superintendent vaccination, Taluka Superintendent Vaccination and Interactive Research and Development and Tameer-e-Khalaq Foundation (TKF). The plan highlighted supportive supervision, the list of defaulters and zero dose children.

Daily COVID-19 Positivity Rate



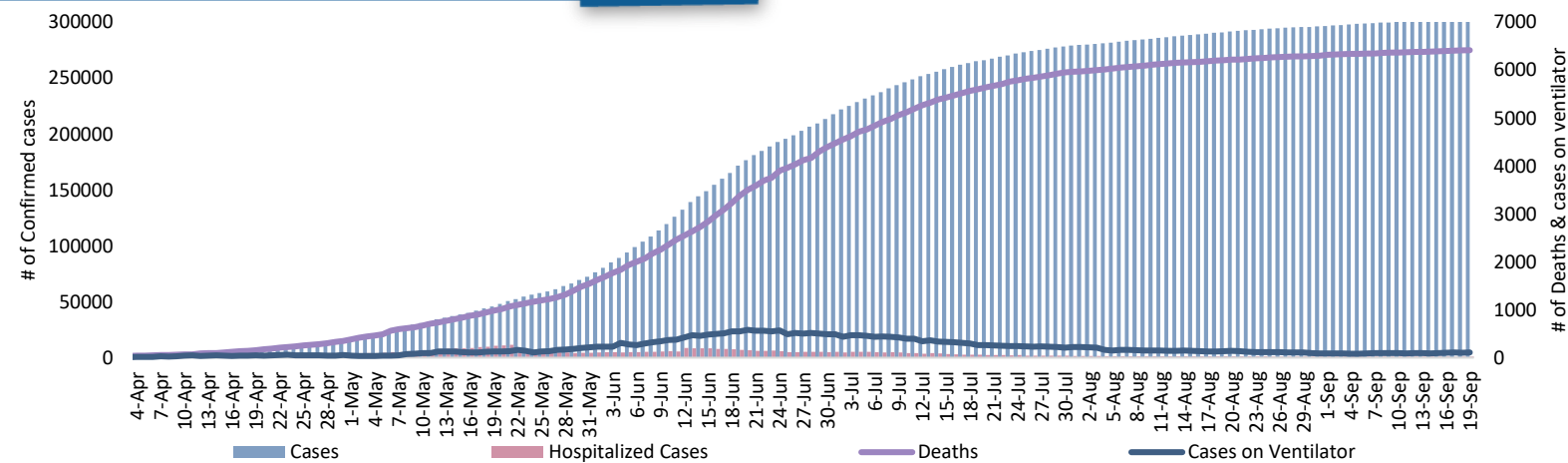
Daily COVID-19 Attack rate

Hospitalized, on Ventilators & Deaths



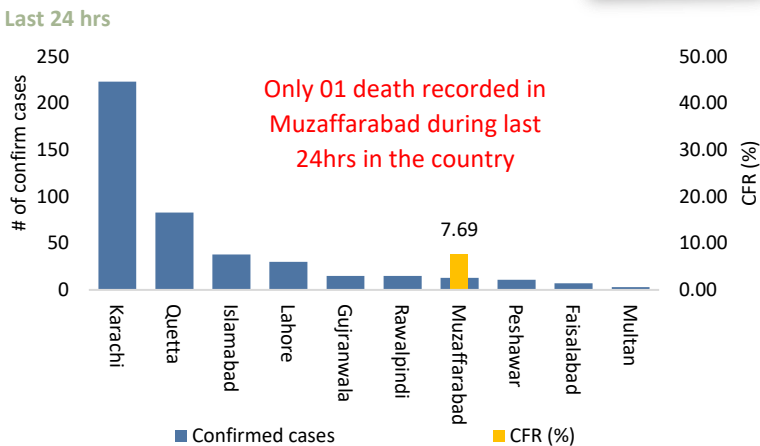

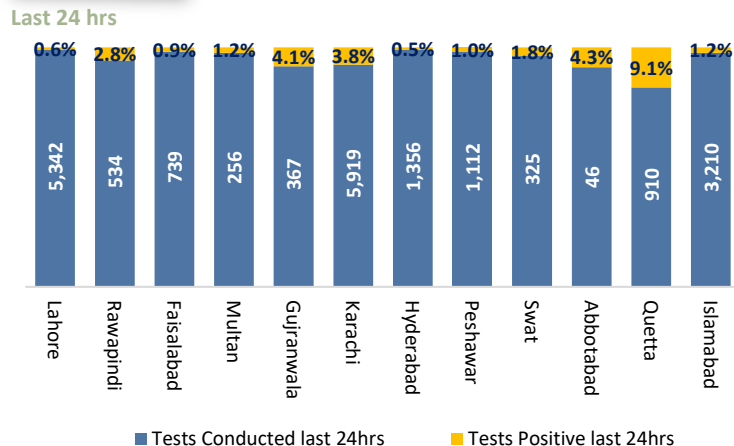
COVID-19 Confirmed cases & CFR

by Major Cities / Districts



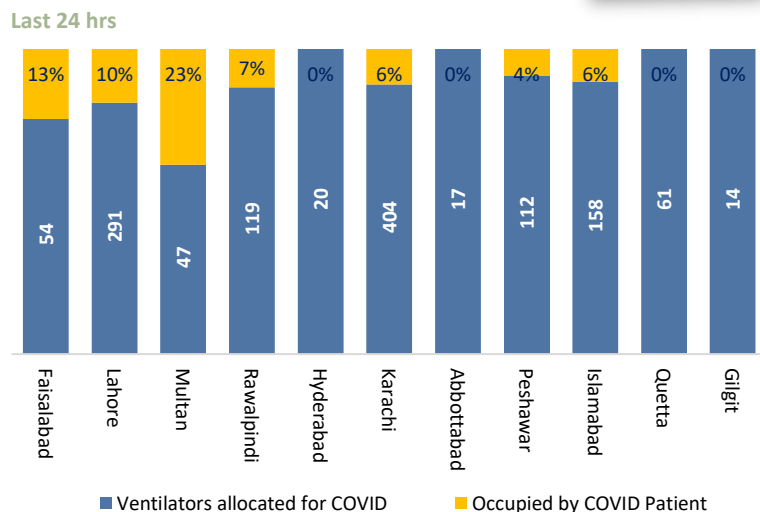
COVID-19 Positivity rates
