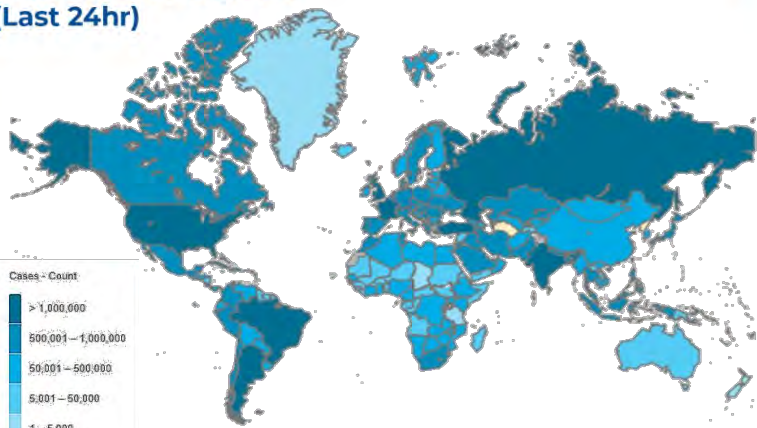

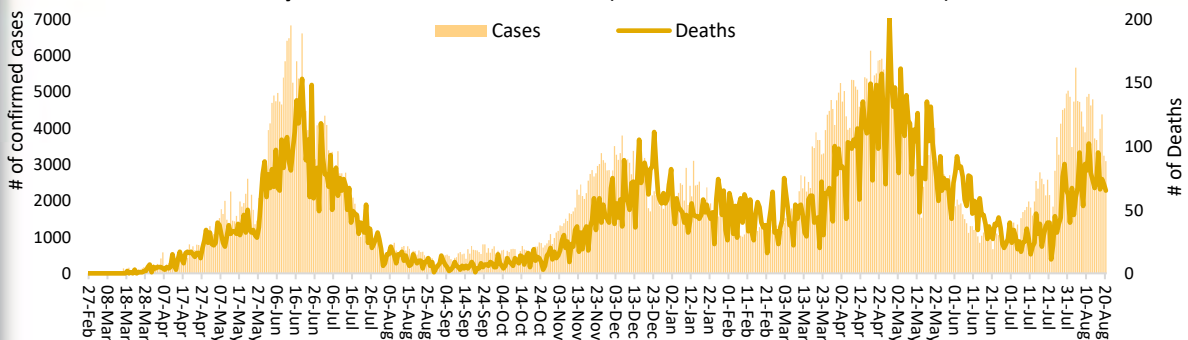

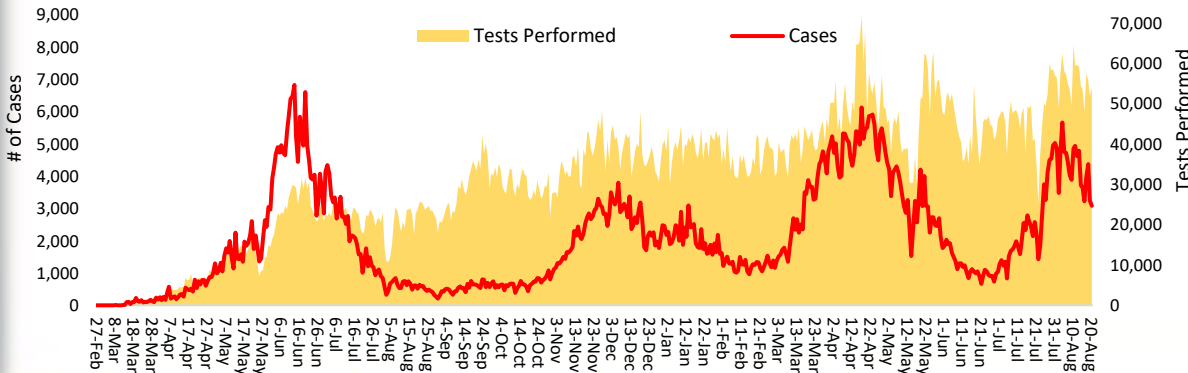

Meetings & Coordination



On 20th August 2021, WHO Country Representative Pakistan, Dr Palitha Mahipala chaired the weekly meeting between WHE team based in Islamabad and the 17 WHO Divisional Surveillance Officers (DSOs) deployed in high burden districts for COVID-19. The objective of the weekly meeting is to discuss COVID-19 cases and response. During the meeting, the DSOs gave briefs on the COVID-19 situation, trend analysis for SARI/ILI, contact tracing and the effects of COVID-19 on the health system.

Dr Palitha appreciated the commitment of surveillance officers. He emphasized on the need to enhance implementation of public Health measures; wearing mask, social distancing and hand hygiene and bolster the capacity of the health facilities to handle critical cases.
