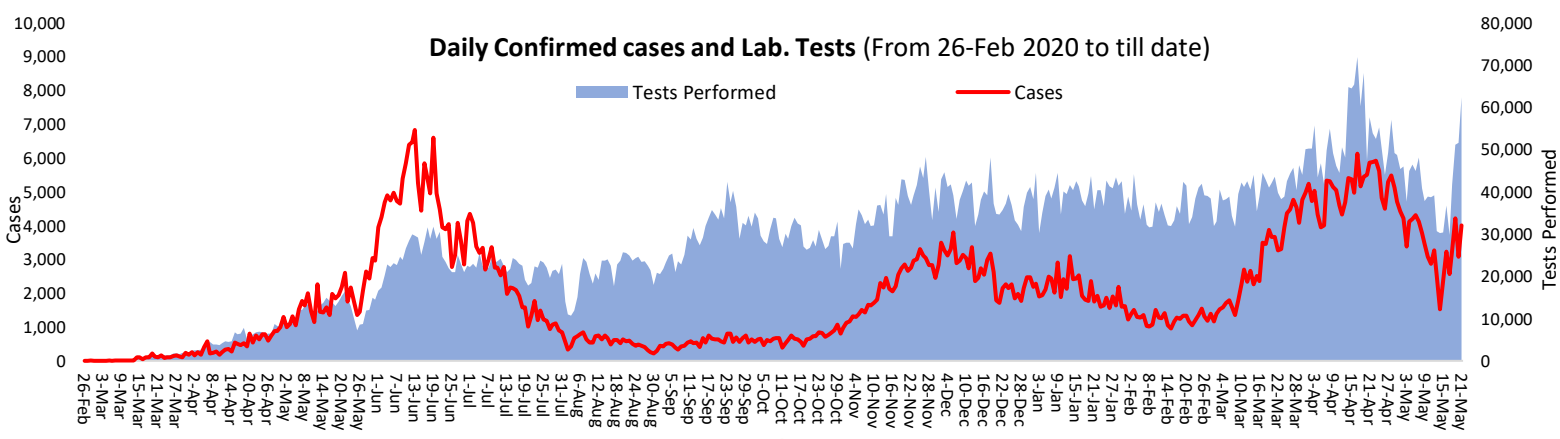

Meeting and Coordination



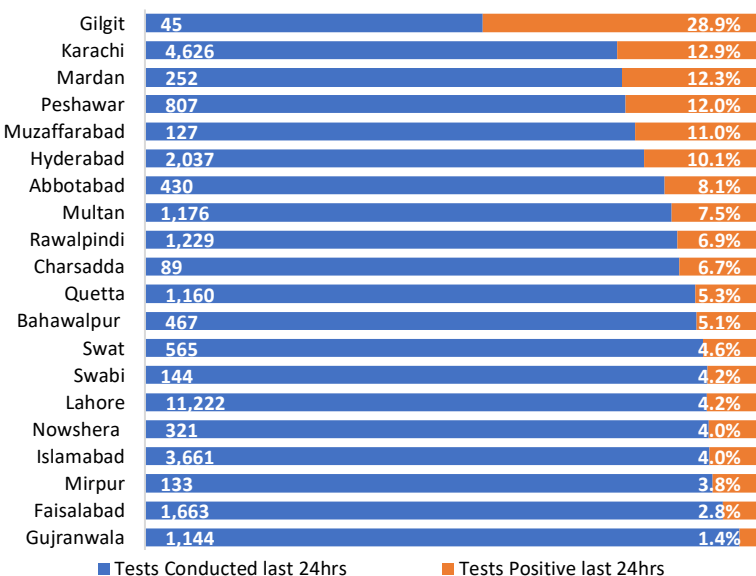
On the 21st May 2021, WHO Country Representative Pakistan, Dr Palitha Mahipala, accompanied by WHO EPI Team lead, Dr Osama Mere visited a COVID -19 vaccination facility in F-9 Park, Islamabad at the invitation of District Health Officer Islamabad, Dr Zaeem Zia.

The purpose of the visit was to assess the operational capacity of the vaccination facility in preparation for expansion of age bracket for those eligible for COVID 19 vaccination to 30 years of age and above.

Dr Palitha appreciated the government for planning to expand the capacity of the vaccination facility, as this will go a long way in improving the vaccination coverage in Islamabad and, make vaccination comfortable for everyone. He commended the staff for their dedication to service and pledged WHO support in strengthening services at the vaccination center.
