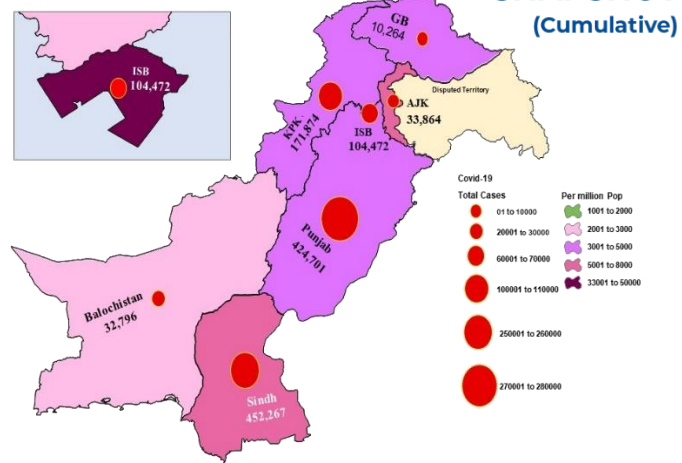

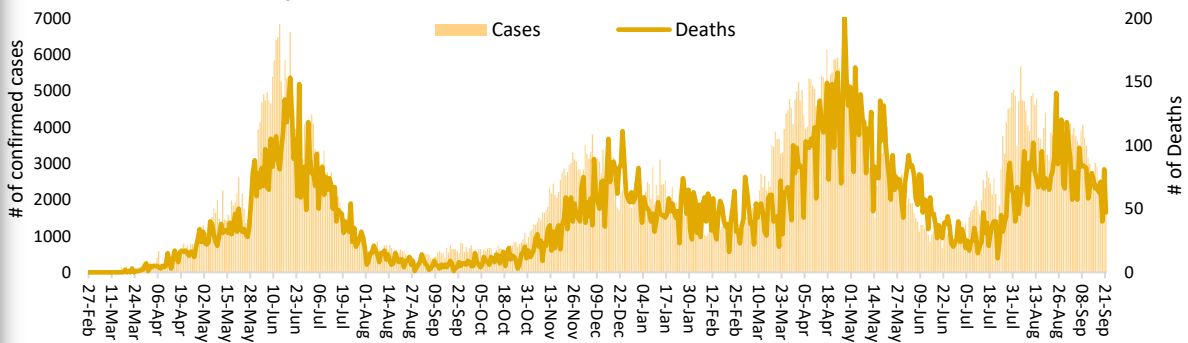

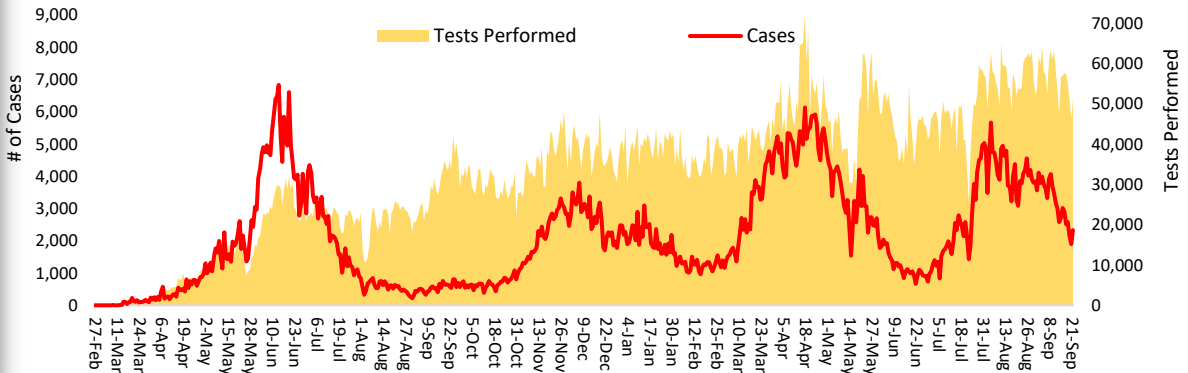

The Ministry of National Health Services Regulations and Coordination (MNHSR&C) in collaboration with the World Health Organization Pakistan launched the “Wear Mask, Protect Pakistan” for Islamabad Capital Territory at the District Health Office on 21st September 2021. This is a follow up of the national launch which took place at WHO Country Office in Islamabad on 13th September 2021. The function was graced by the Special Assistant to Prime Minister on Health, Dr Faisal Sultan, and WHO Country Representative Pakistan Dr Palitha Mahipala. During the same event, a mobile vaccination drive targeting refugees from Afghanistan was launched, and Dr Palitha handed over the IEC material: streamers, banners, and pamphlets to SPAM on Health Dr Faisal Sultan. Dr Sultan appreciated WHO's support to the Government in implementing public health measures and vaccination.
