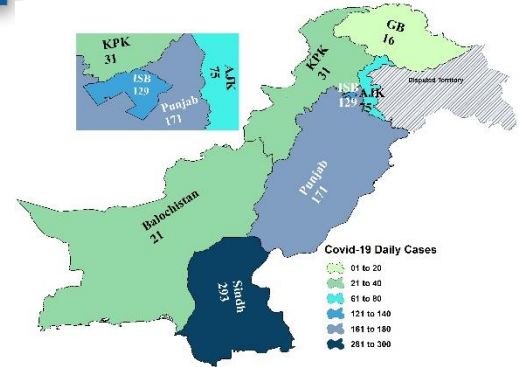

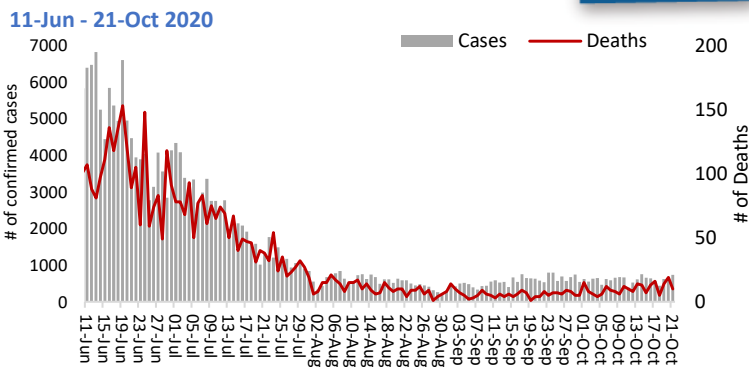
Executive Summary

Pakistan reported **736** new cases of COVID-19 on **21 October 2020**. The total number of cases notified since the beginning of the outbreak is **325,480** with **6,702** deaths (**CFR: 2.06%**). Out of the total **9,642** currently active cases, **856** cases are hospitalized, out of which **591 (69.04%)** are in critical condition. **8,786** COVID-19 positive cases are at designated isolation facilities or in-home isolation. A total of **309,136 (94.98%)** have recovered and discharged.

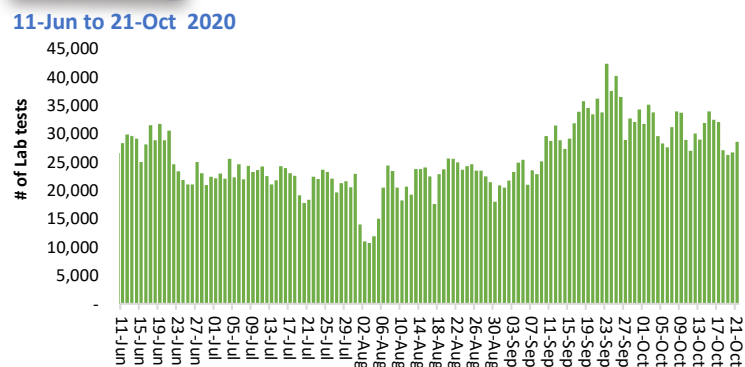
Daily Incidence by Province



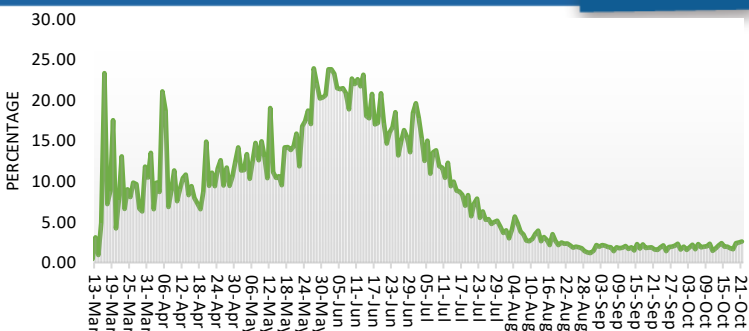
Daily Incidence/Mortality



Daily Lab Tests conducted

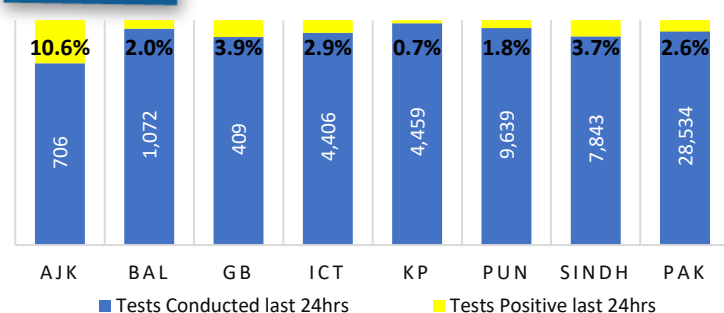


Daily COVID-19 Positivity Rate

(Last 24hrs)

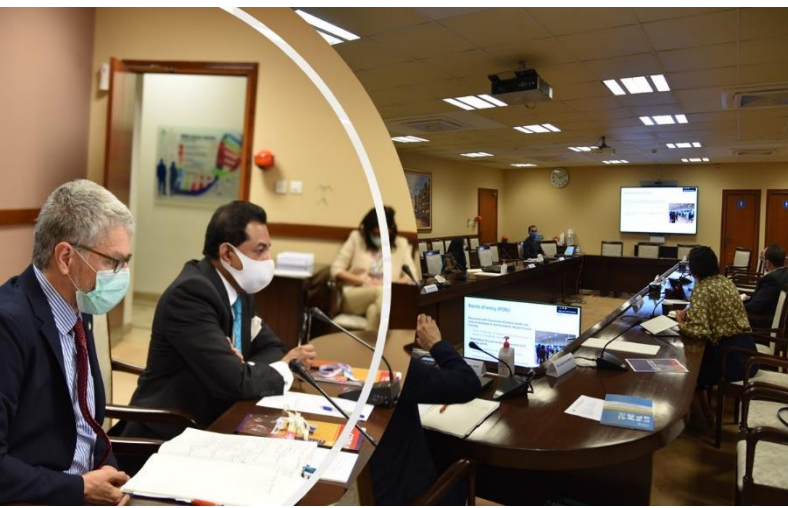

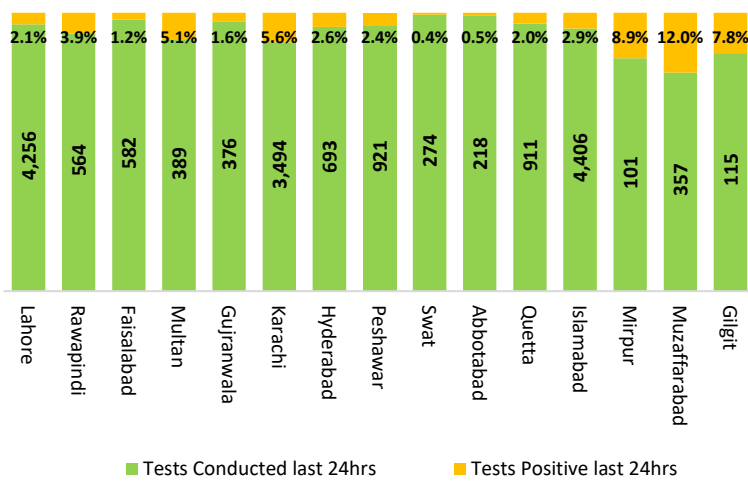
