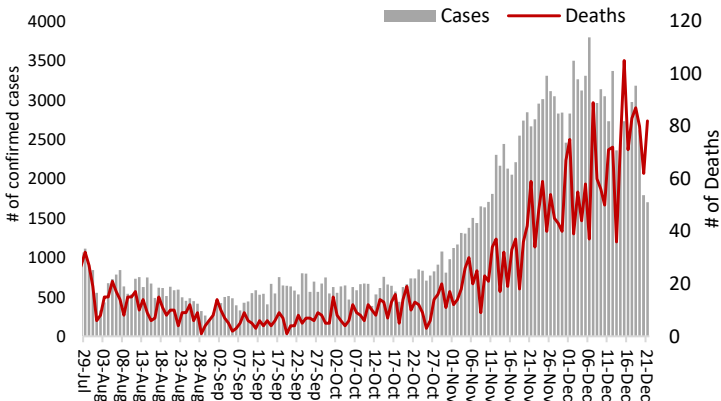

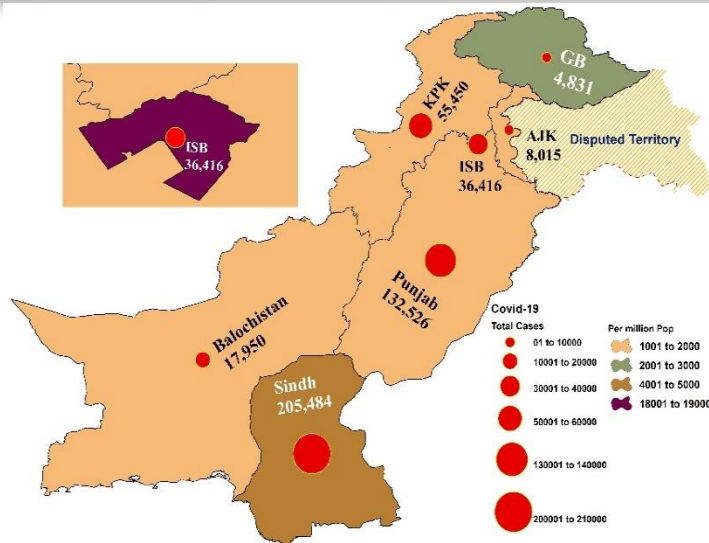


INCIDENCE & DEATHS BY DATE

29-Jul - 21-Dec 2020



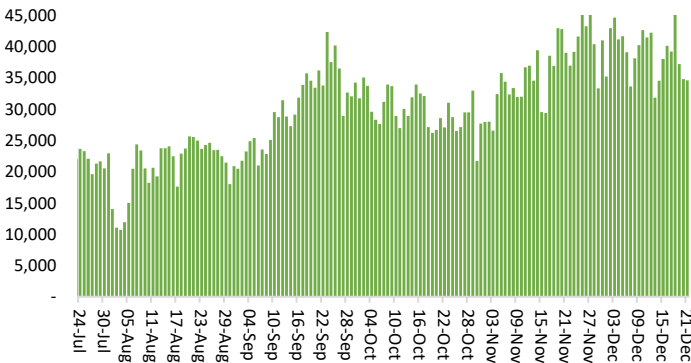
TOTAL CASES & CASES PER MILLION POP.



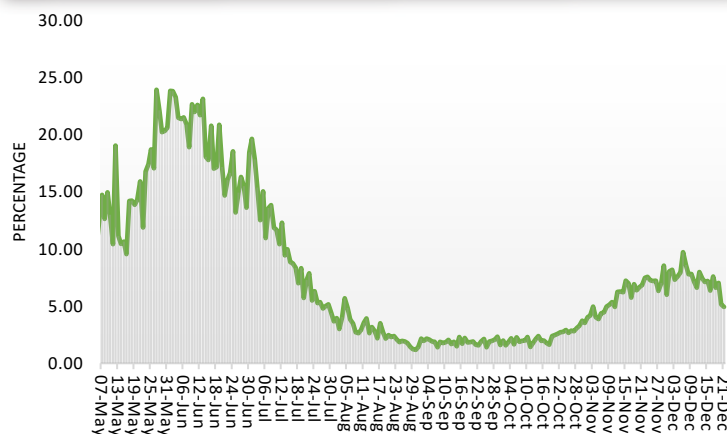
Pakistan reported **1,704** new cases of COVID-19 on **21 December 2020**. The total number of cases notified since the beginning of the outbreak is **460,672** with **9,473** deaths (**CFR: 2.06%**). Out of the total **40,261** currently active cases **2,917** cases are hospitalized.

MEETINGS & COORDINATION

On 21st December 2020, WHO Country Representative Pakistan, Dr Palitha Mahipala and WHO Sub Office Balochistan team met the Provincial Secretary Health Balochistan, Mr Noor-ul-Haq Baloch. During the meeting, COVID-19 Response activities and delivery of disability inclusive health care services were discussed.

After the meeting WR handed over 87 wheelchairs for 36 Hospitals across the province to enable safe transfer of patients and support mobility of people with disabilities in the hospitals. He also handed over 2,000 Glucantime Injections to the Secretary Health to support leishmaniasis treatment and control.

The Secretary Health appreciated WHO's technical and in-kind support for various programs. He also briefed WR on the Government's efforts to support people with disabilities through rights-based approach.
