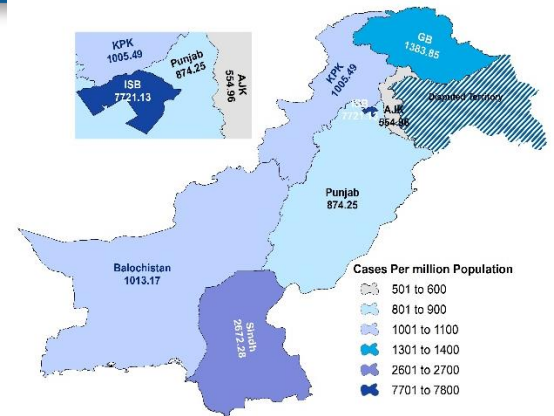

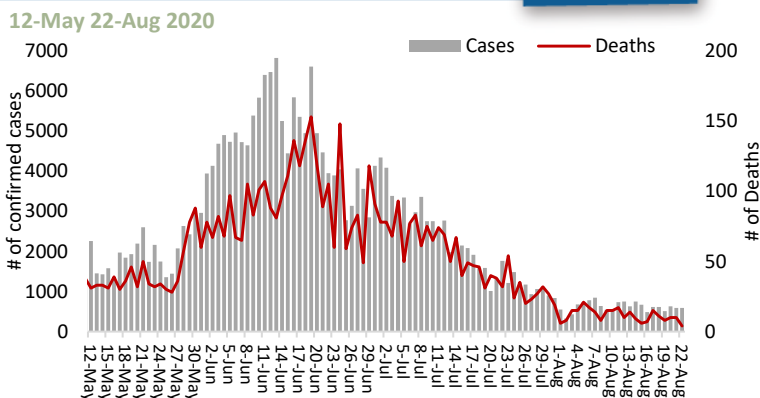
Executive Summary

Pakistan reported **591** new cases of COVID-19 on **22 August 2020**. The total number of cases notified since the beginning of the outbreak is **292,765** with **6,235** deaths (**CFR: 2.12%**). Out of the total **10,694** currently active cases, **1,173** cases are hospitalized, out of which **696 (59.33%)** are in critical condition. **9,521** COVID-19 positive cases are at designated isolation facilities or in-home isolation. A total of **275,836 (94.21%)** have recovered and discharged.

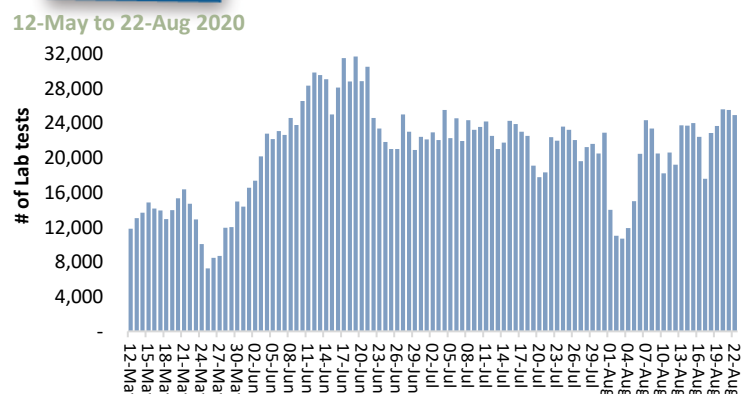
COVID-19 cases density/million Population

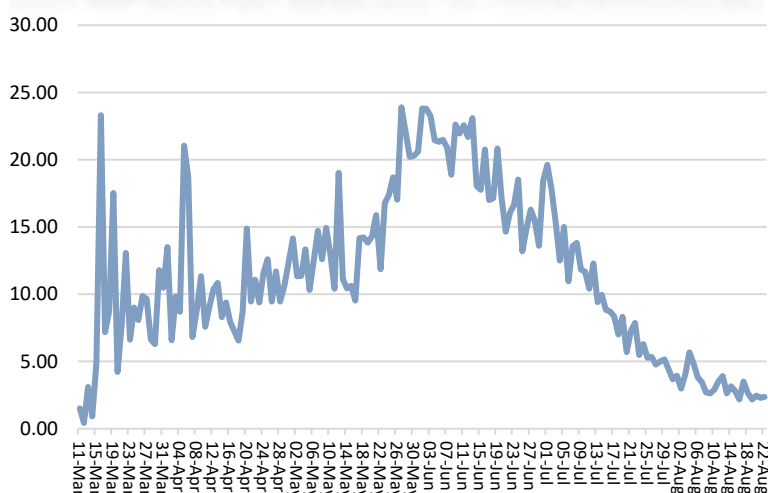


Meeting and Coordination

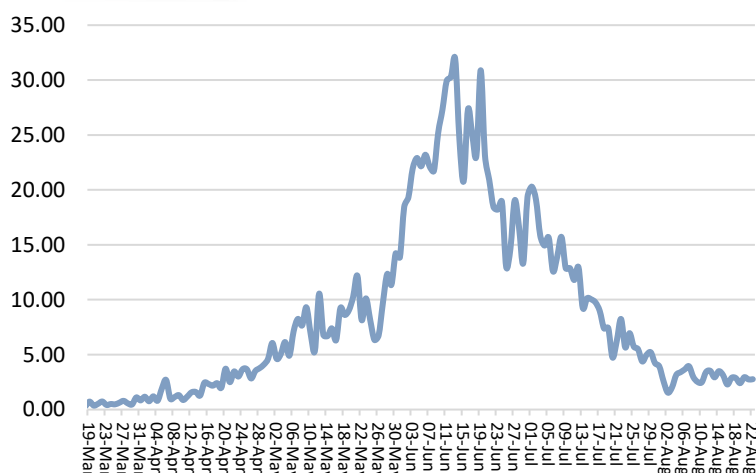
WHO country office Pakistan, in collaboration with EMRO, has been established a dedicated unit of Infection Prevention & Control at Pakistan Institute of Medical Sciences (PIMS) on 20th August 2020.

The aim of IPC unit is to ensure compliance with the Institutional IPC activities & consolidate all efforts in adopting, maintaining, and enforcing IPC for patient care. The IPC Unit has been allocated office in the Department of Pathology & has been equipped with dedicated full time, (01) doctor, five (5) nurses & one (1) administrative staff. The unit was briefed by EMRO IPC expert Dr Iman Heweidy on implementation of improve IPC plan.

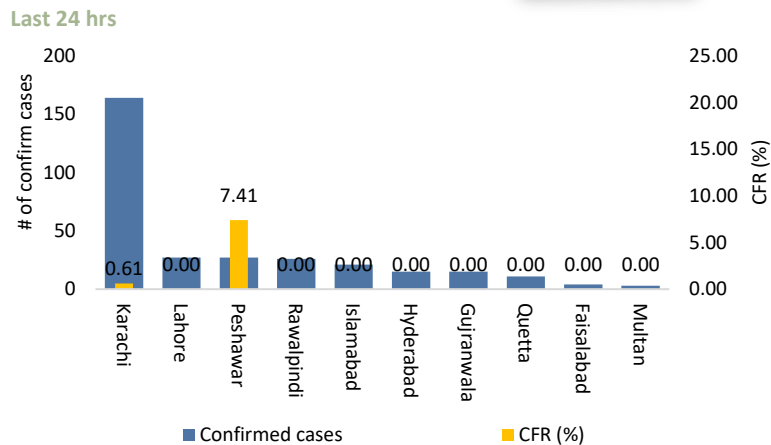

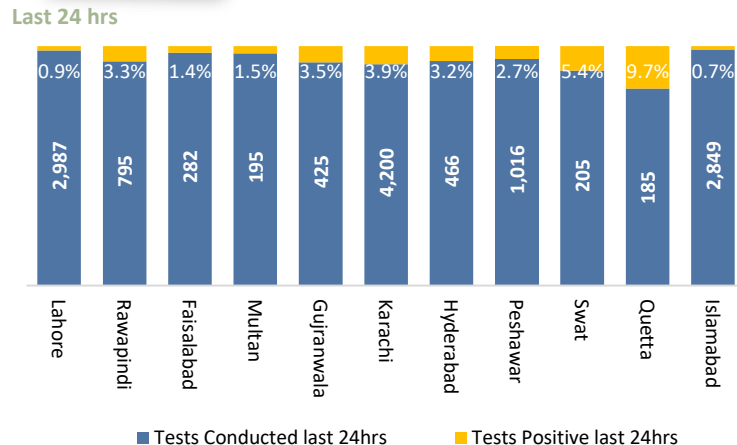

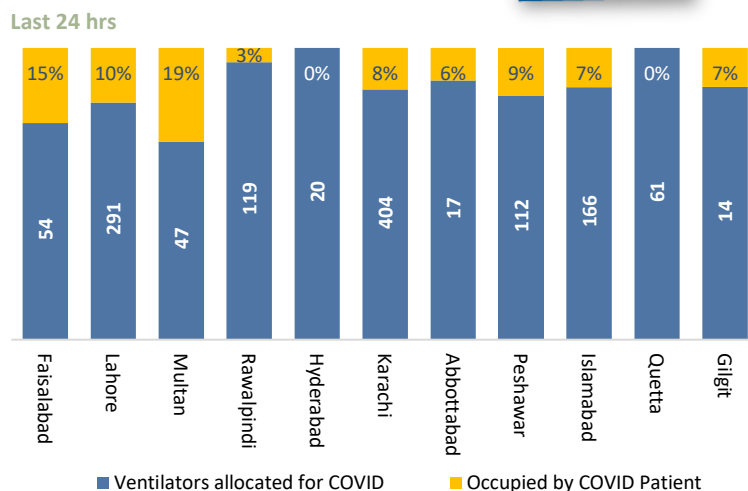
COVID-19 confirmed cases & CFR (%) by Districts
