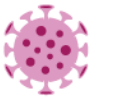

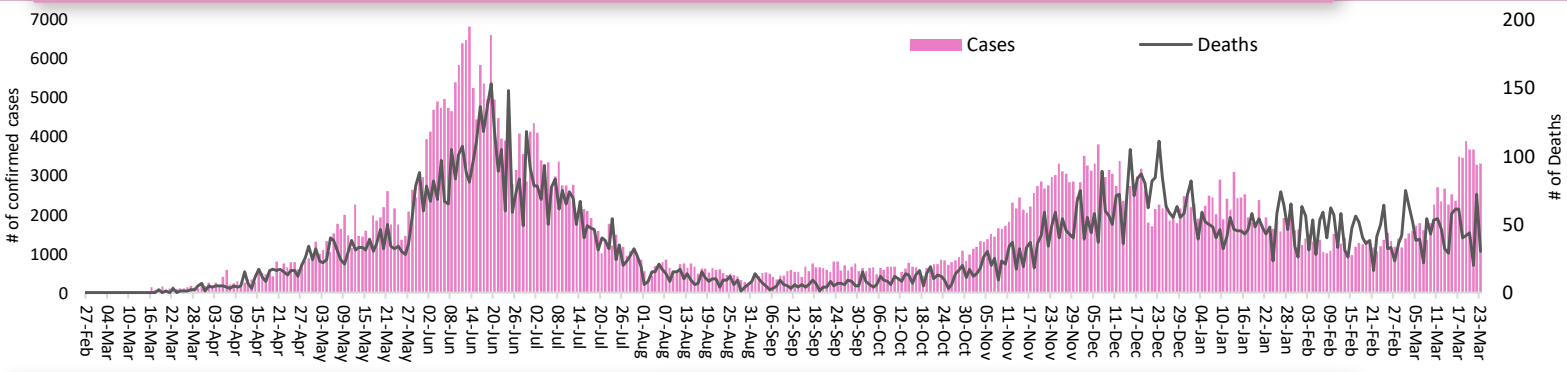

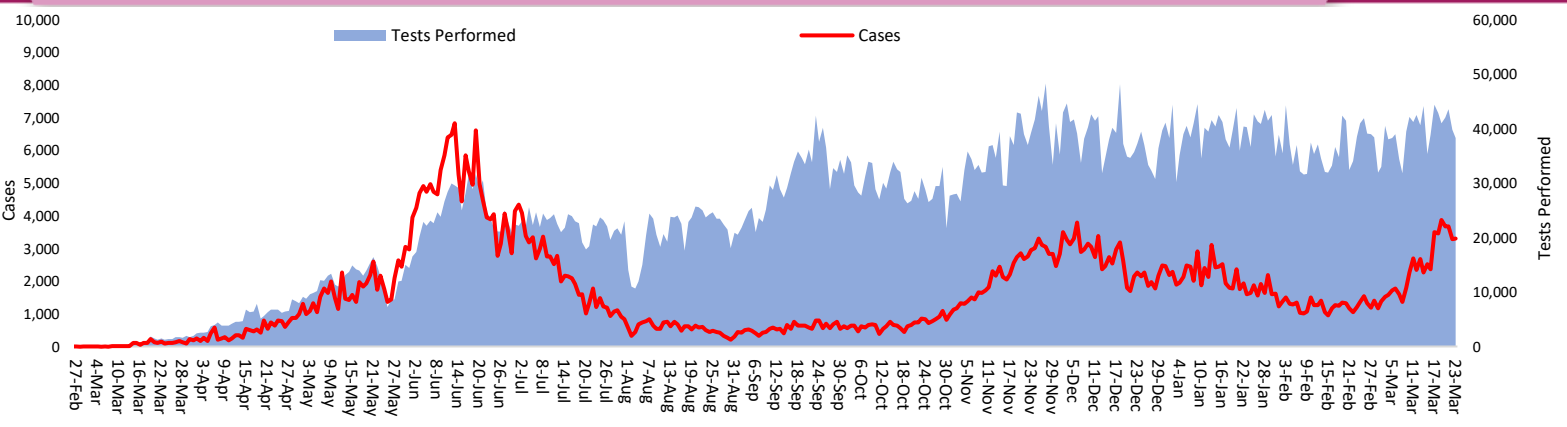

MEETING AND COORDINATION



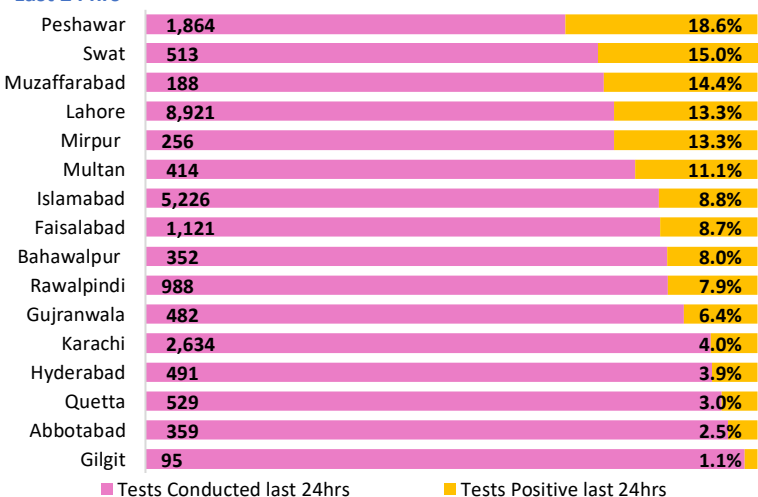
