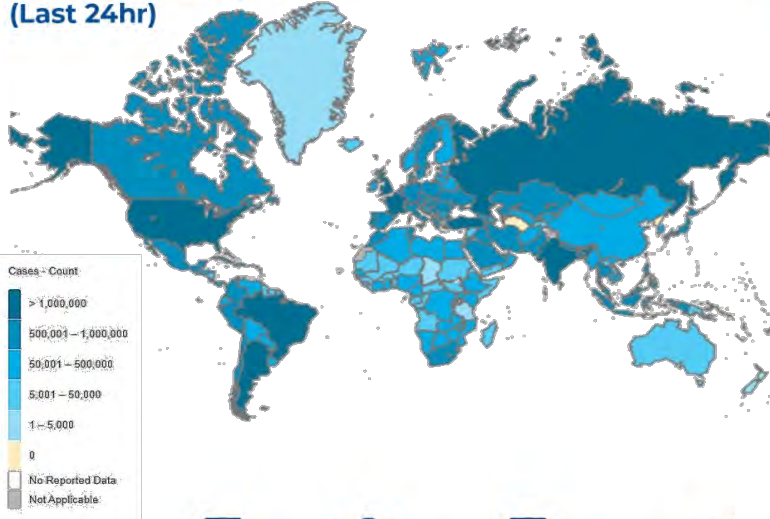

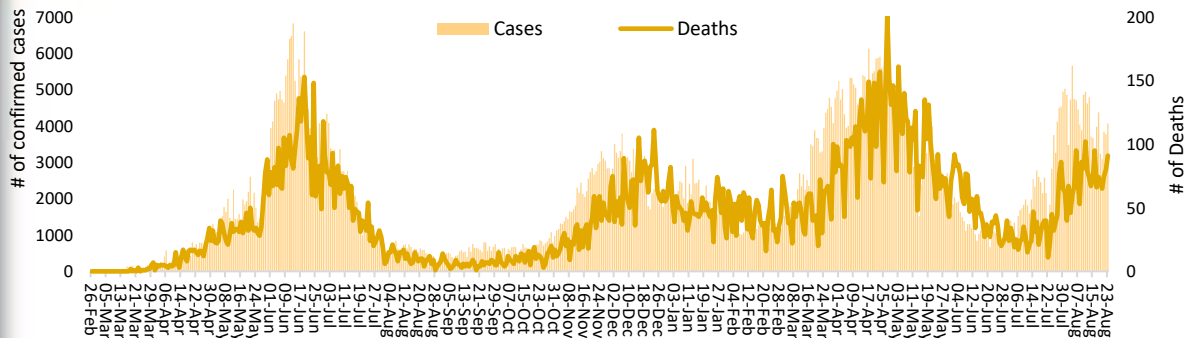

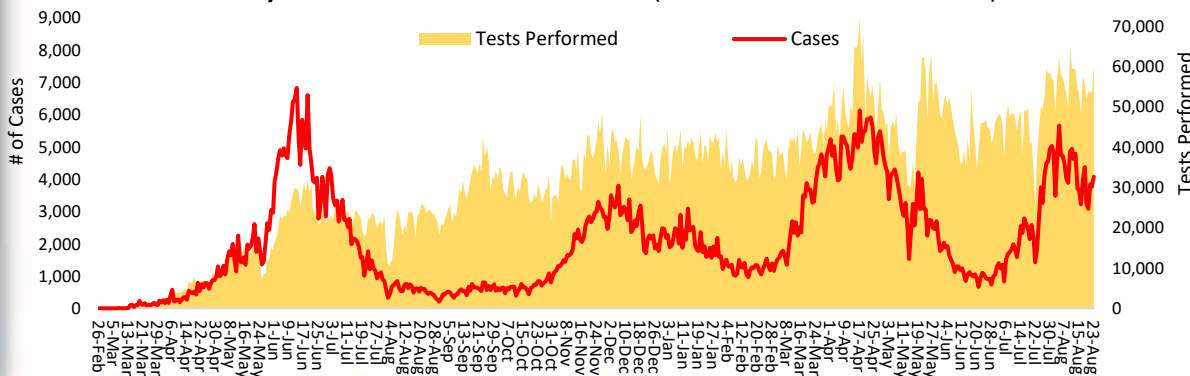

On 24th August 2021, UN Resident Coordinator in Pakistan, Mr Julien Harneis and the WHO Country Representative Pakistan Dr Palitha Mahipala, hosted a virtual town hall meeting of United Nations (UN) Pakistan staff at the WHO Country Office Islamabad.

During the meeting, Dr Palitha briefed the UN staff on the COVID 19 situation and response Globally, Regionally and in Pakistan, current challenges including emergence of Variants of Concern (VOC), vaccine inequity globally and vaccination certificates and its implication. The townhall meeting had question and answer session responded to by the WR and UN-RC.

The UN resident coordinator appreciated the technical role being played by WHO Pakistan. He implored all UN staff to get vaccination and continue practicing public health measures: correct wearing of mask, social distancing, and hand hygiene.
