

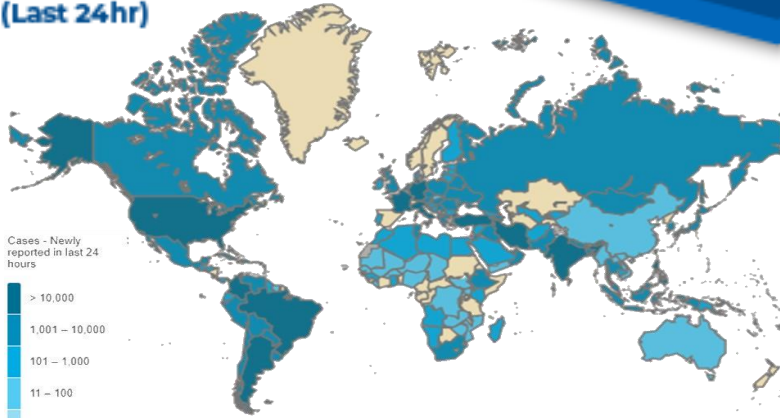

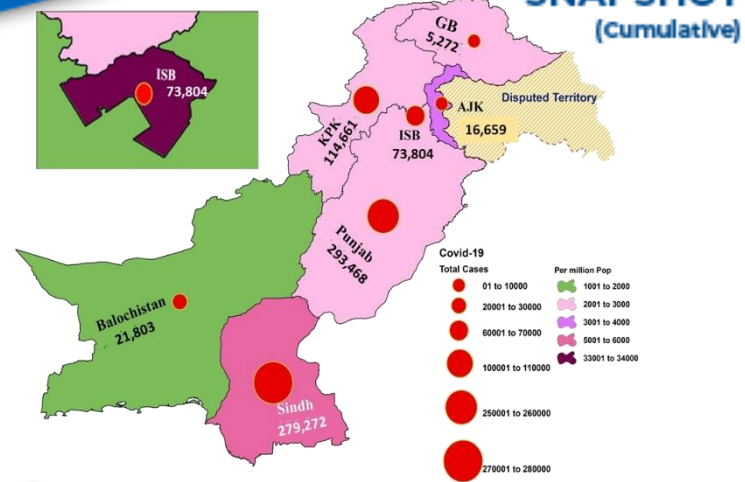

## PAKISTAN COVID-19 SNAPSHOT (Cumulative)

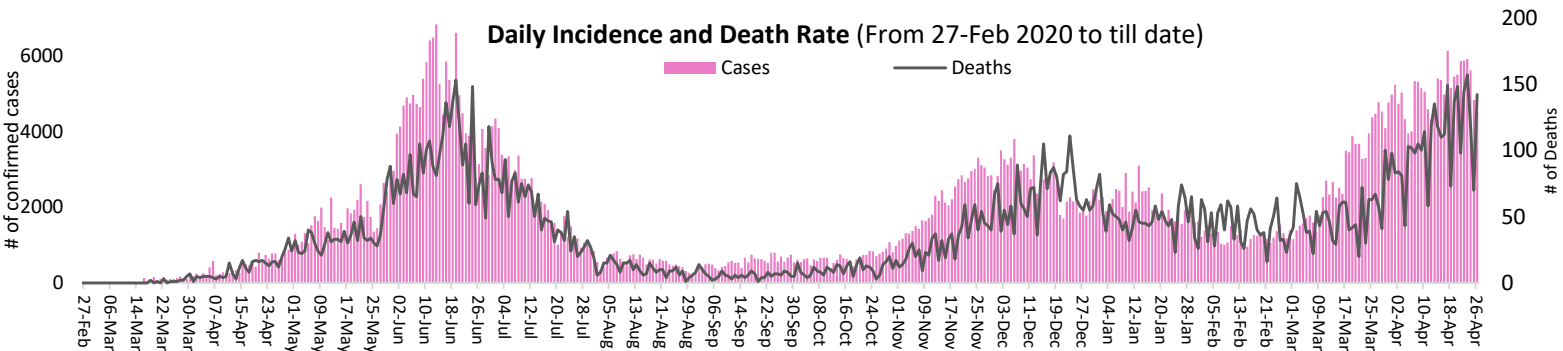

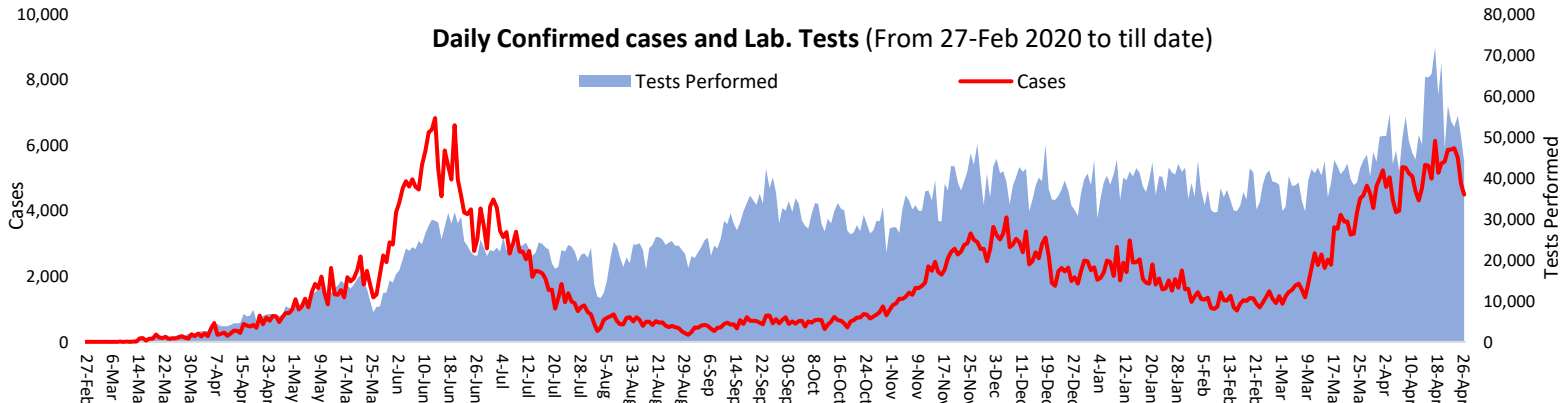

## Meeting and Coordination

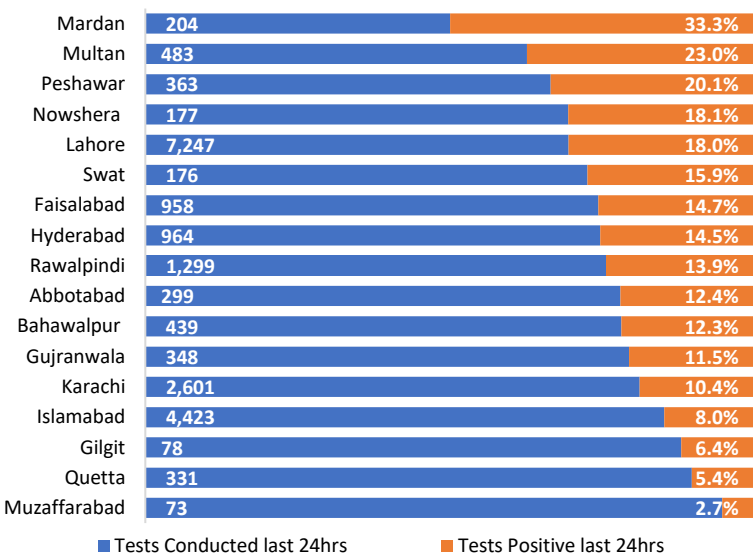


On the 26<sup>th</sup> April 2021, The WHO Country Representative Pakistan, Dr Palitha Mahipala participated in the National level commemoration of World Immunization Week 2021 (26<sup>th</sup> – 30<sup>th</sup> April 2021) that was organized by the Federal EPI program. The Honorable Special Assistant to Prime Minister on Health; H.E Dr. Faisal Sultan, graced the event virtually, the Director General Health, Dr Rana Mohammad Safdar and National Program Manager EPI Dr Akram Shah participated in the event.

Speaking on the occasion, Dr Palitha appreciated the Immunization Champions. He stated that every day, these champions around the world are doing their part to keep us safe through vaccines, working in some of the most challenging conditions and Pakistan's remotest corners. Dr Palitha also highlighted that WHO is supporting the expansion of infrastructure to enhance the immunization coverage all over Pakistan. Over 2,000 EPI centers have been upgraded, and surveillance capabilities strengthened.
