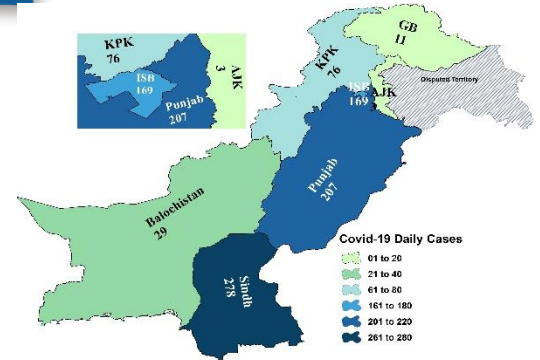

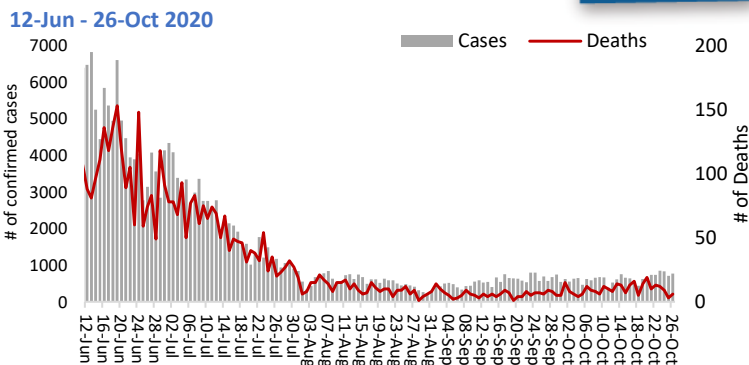
### Executive Summary

Pakistan reported **773** new cases of COVID-19 on **26 October 2020**. The total number of cases notified since the beginning of the outbreak is **329,375** with **6,745** deaths (**CFR: 2.05%**). Out of the total **11,190** currently active cases, **853** cases are hospitalized, out of which **576 (67.53%)** are in critical condition. **10,337** COVID-19 positive cases are at designated isolation facilities or in-home isolation. A total of **311,440 (94.55%)** have recovered and discharged.

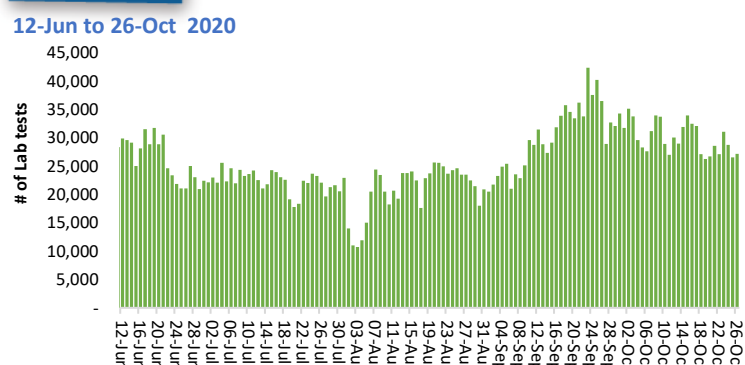
### Daily Incidence by Province



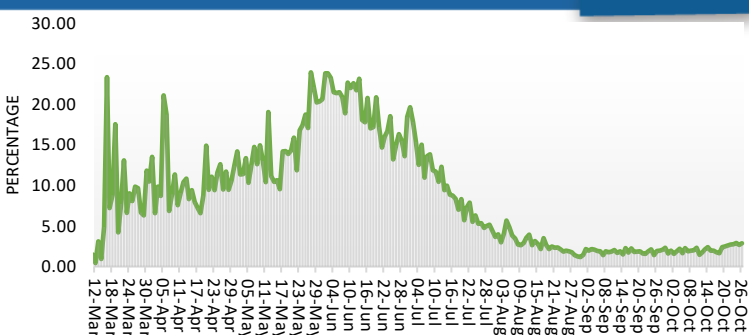
### Daily Incidence/Mortality



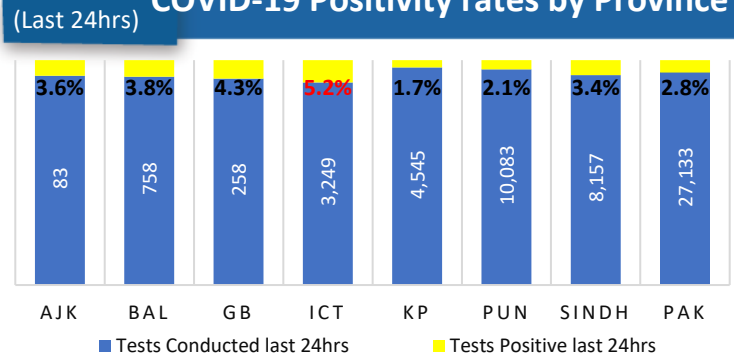
### Daily Lab Tests conducted

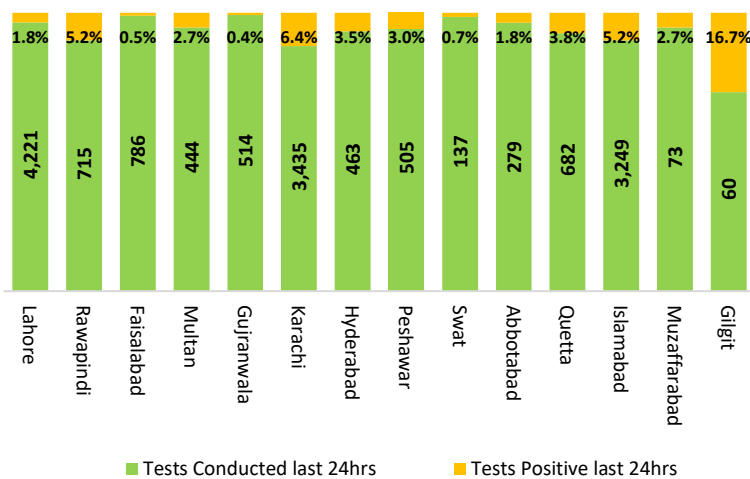
