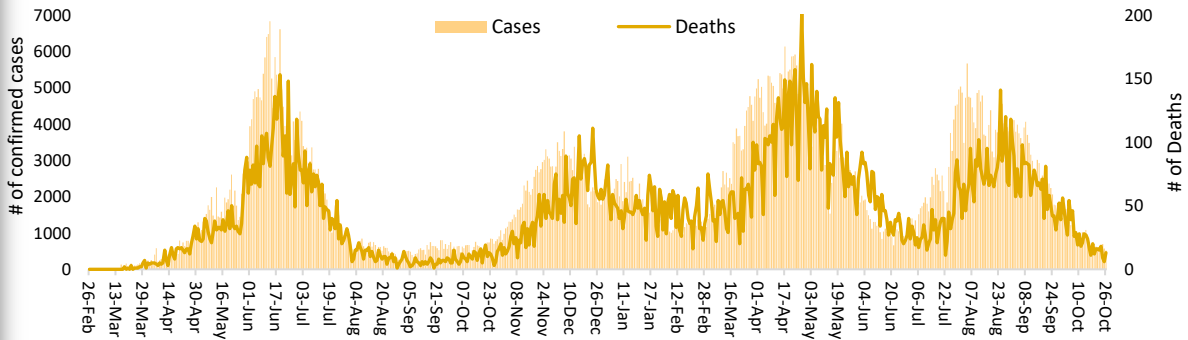

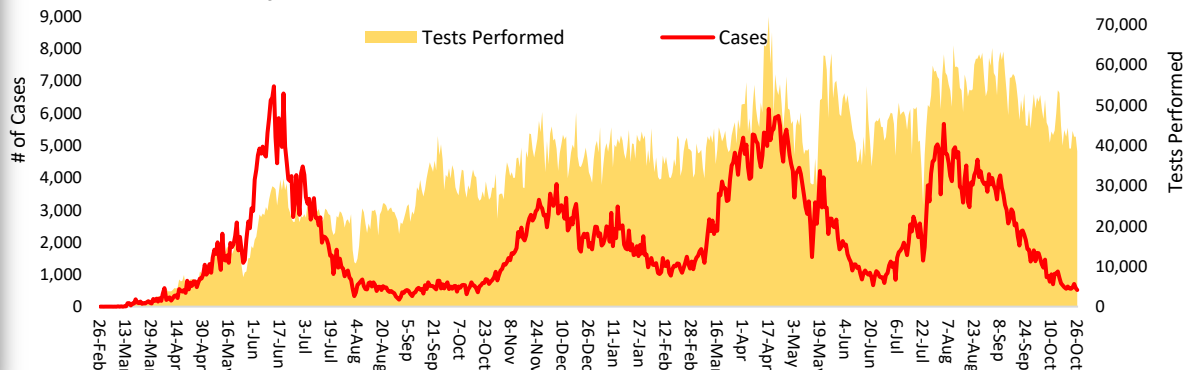

On 26th October 2021, Islamabad Traffic Police (ITP) in collaboration with World Health Organization Pakistan carried out the “Wear Mask, Protect Pakistan” campaign at Abpara Market Islamabad.
