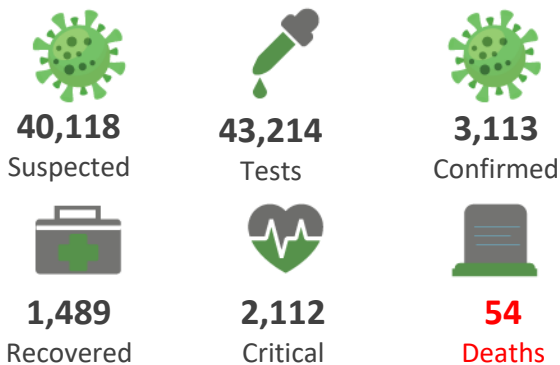


TOTAL CASES & CASES PER MILLION POP.



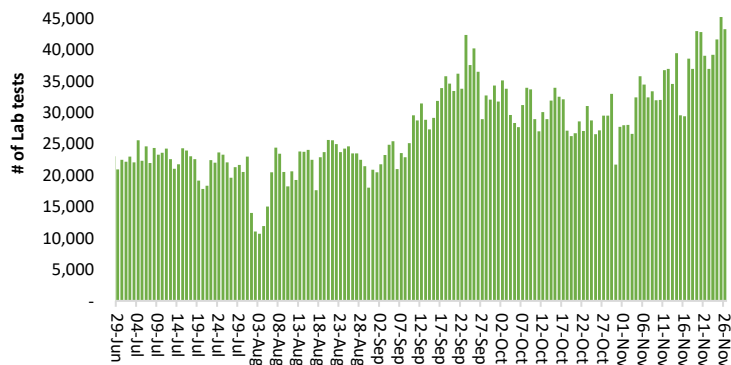
Pakistan reported **3,113** new cases of COVID-19 on **26 November 2020**. The total number of cases notified since the beginning of the outbreak is **389,311** with **7,897** deaths (**CFR: 2.03%**). Out of the total **45,533** currently active cases, **2,647** cases are hospitalized.

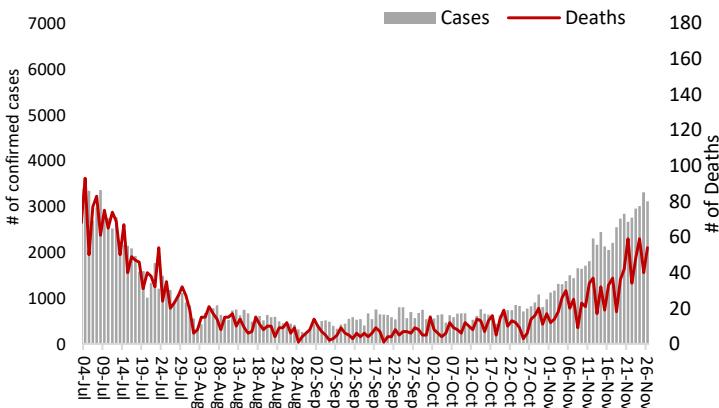

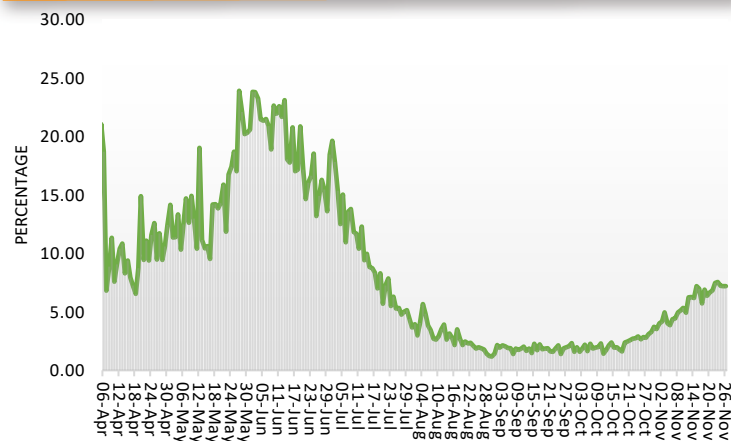


INCIDENCE & DEATHS BY DATE

MEETINGS & COORDINATION

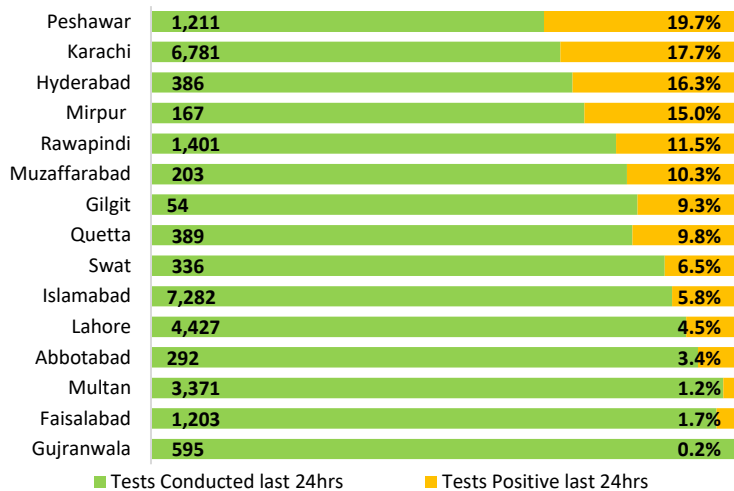
