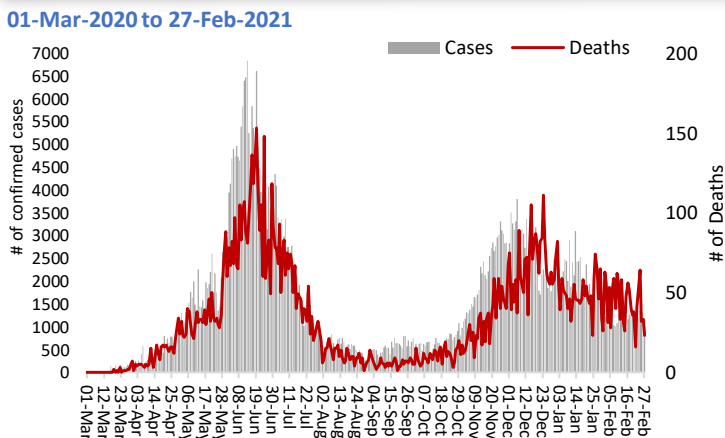

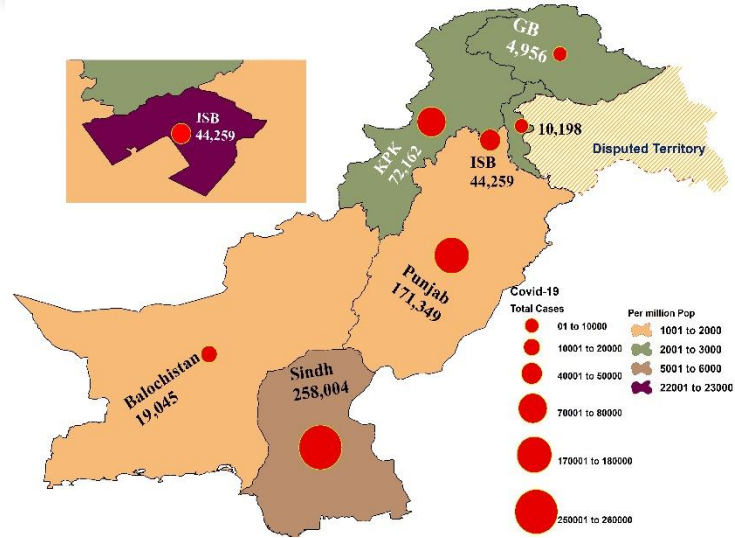

INCIDENCE & DEATHS BY DATE



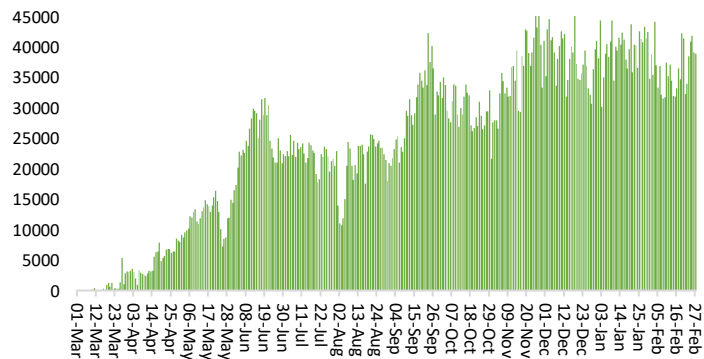
TOTAL CASES & CASES PER MILLION POP.



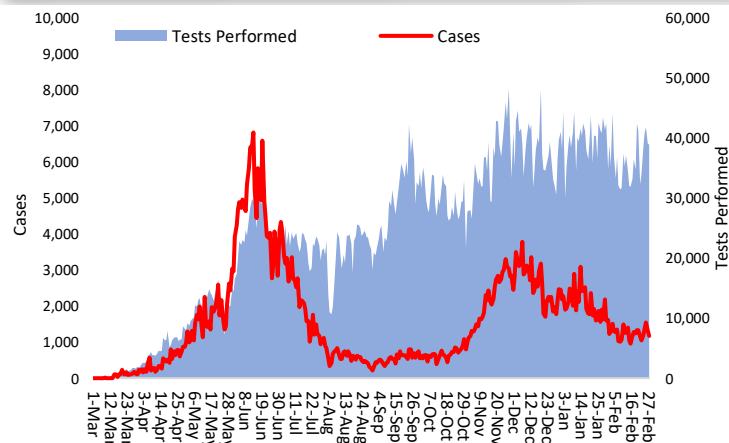
Pakistan reported **1,176** new cases of COVID-19 on **27th February 2021**. The total number of cases notified since the beginning of the outbreak is **579,973** with **12,860** deaths (**CFR: 2.22%**). Out of the total **21,836** currently active cases **1,994** cases are hospitalized.

MEETINGS & COORDINATION

World Health Organization Pakistan in collaboration with Field Epidemiology & Disease Surveillance Division, National Institute of Health Islamabad, and Provincial Health Department Balochistan conducted a three days training on Integrated Disease Surveillance and Response (IDSR) from 25-28 February 2021 Quetta. The objective of the training was to train health professionals of selected Health facilities on collecting and reporting weekly quality epidemiological data for priority communicable diseases and initiate timely response to outbreak alerts.

In the 1st batch 40 health professionals from 20 health facilities including 2 RHCs and 18 BHUs from Quetta district attended the training. Dr Ali Nasir Bugti, Director General Health Services, Balochistan graced the opening session of the training. In his opening remarks Dr Bugti appreciated the WHO Pakistan support for implementation of IDSR in the selected districts of Balochistan.
