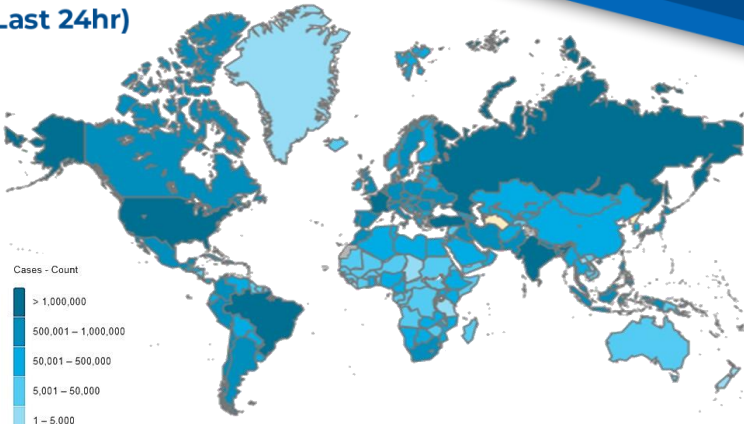


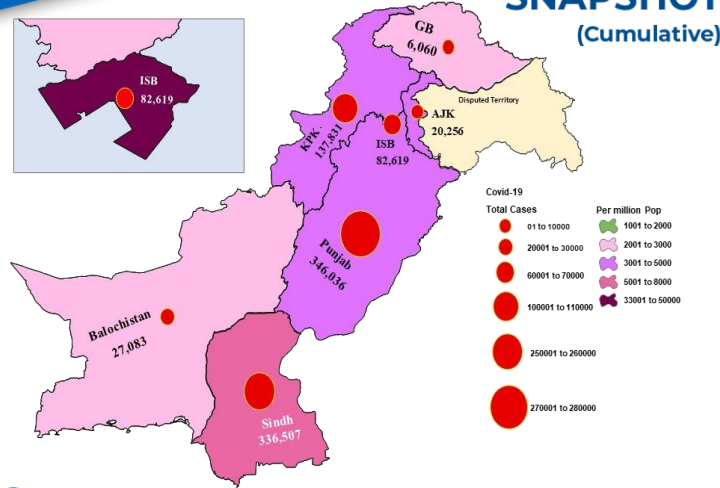

## PAKISTAN COVID-19 SNAPSHOT (Cumulative)

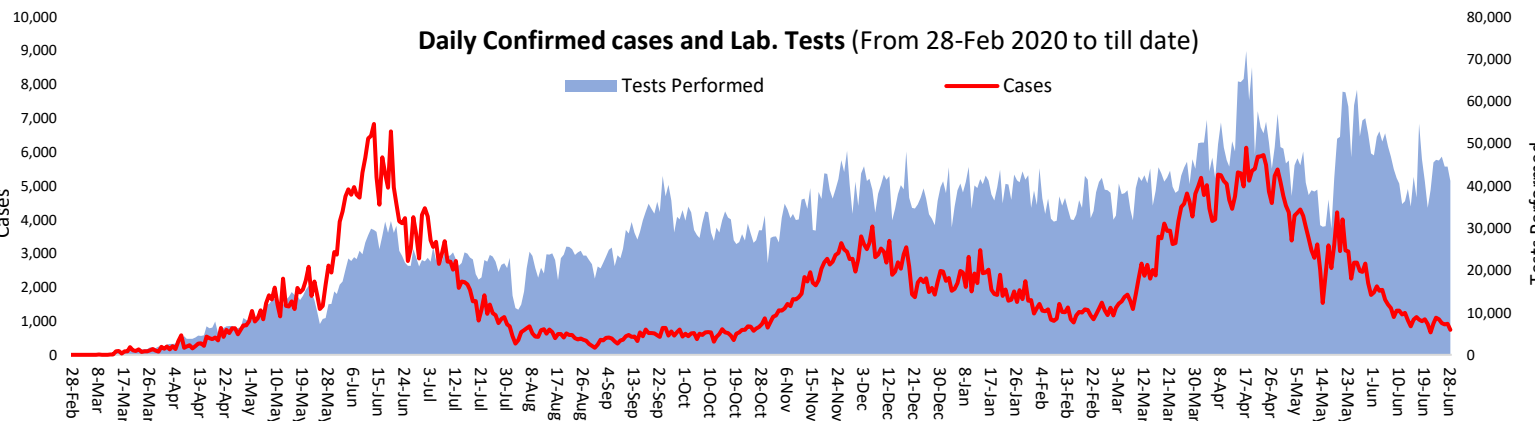
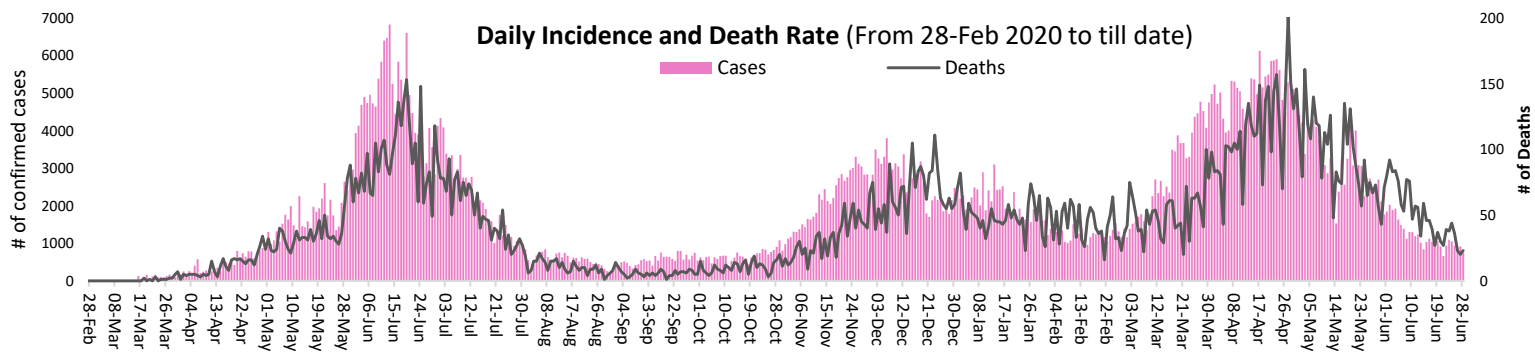

## Meeting and Coordination



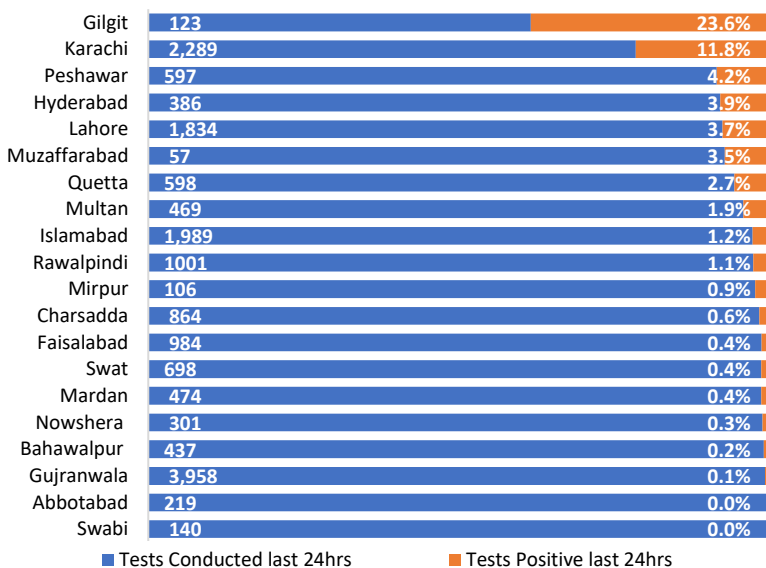
On 28th June 2021, WHO Country Representative Pakistan Dr. Palitha Mahipala launched and handed over equipment for telemedicine at Balochistan Institute of Psychiatry and Behavioral Sciences, Quetta. The ceremony was attended by among others, the Provincial Parliamentary Secretary for Health, Dr. Rubab Khan Buledi. This initiative targets the provinces of Balochistan and KP (South Waziristan) in the provision of Sexual and Gender Based Violence (SGBV) services using telemedicine. The WHO has so far refurbished and equipped 7 telemedicine clinics.

In his speech, Dr. Palitha expounded on the public health consequences of SGBV especially; the physical, sexual, reproductive, and psychological effects on the health and social well-being of victims. He applauded the will of the Balochistan leadership and health workers to combat the vice.

Dr. Rubaba Khan appreciated WHO Pakistan for supporting innovative approaches like tele-medicine to enhance services outreach in the sensitive domain of SGBV and COVID-19.
