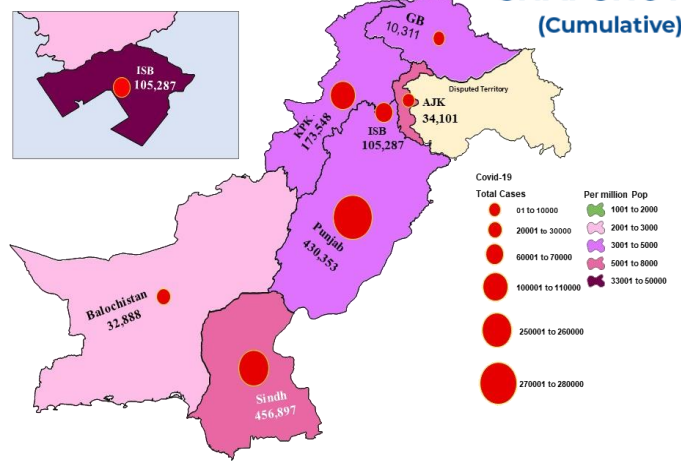

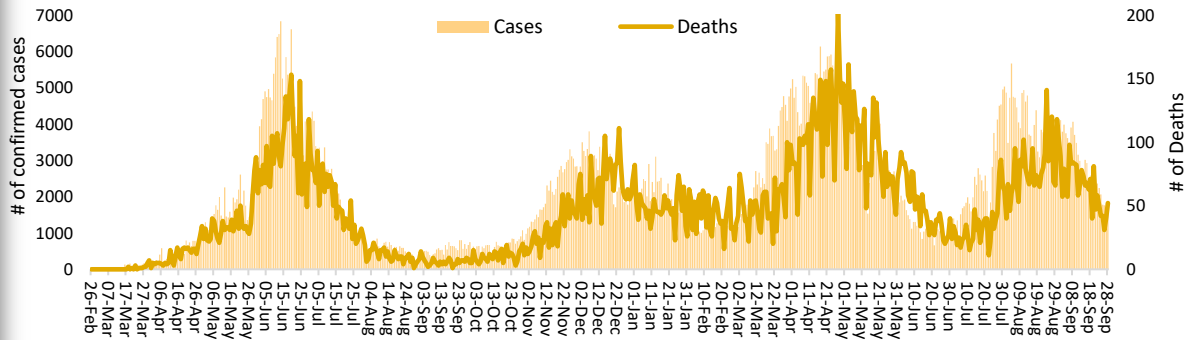

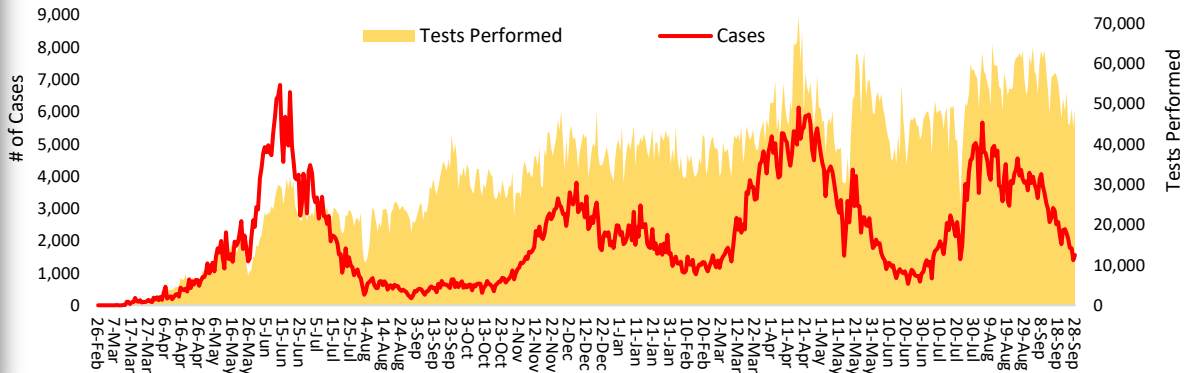

On 26th September 2021, WHO Country Representative Pakistan, Dr Palitha Mahipala visited Rawalpindi railway station. The purpose of the visit was to promote the “Wear mask, protect Pakistan” campaign that was launched at the WHO Country Office on 13th September 2021. This campaign is being promoted alongside other public health measures: social distancing, hand hygiene and cough etiquette in the prevention of spread of COVID 19. WR was accompanied by WHE Team Lead Dr Michael Lukwiya and other WHO Pakistan staff. At the station, Dr Palitha was received by the Divisional Superintendent, Pakistan Railway, Rawalpindi Division Mr Inam Ullah. The team distributed masks and IEC material to staff of railway station, passengers, and their kin. The WR later addressed people present including the press on the importance of wearing mask. The passengers and staff present at the railway station appreciated the WHO donation.
