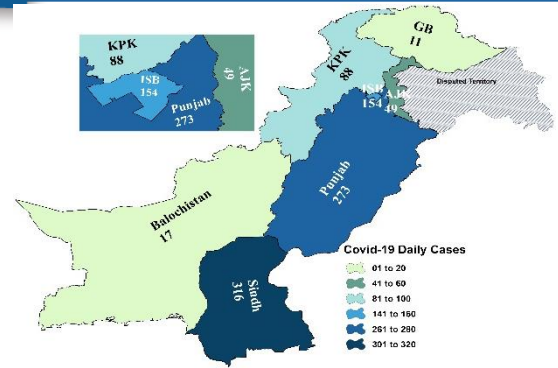

### Executive Summary

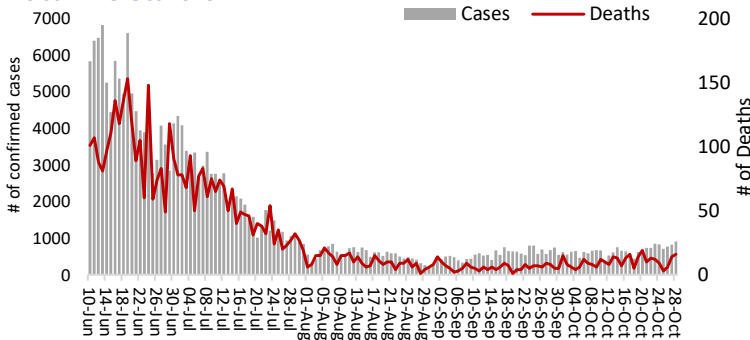
Pakistan reported **908** new cases of COVID-19 on **28 October 2020**. The total number of cases notified since the beginning of the outbreak is **331,108** with **6,775** deaths (**CFR: 2.05%**). Out of the total **11,695** currently active cases, **897** cases are hospitalized, out of which **624 (69.57%)** are in critical condition. **10,798** COVID-19 positive cases are at designated isolation facilities or in-home isolation. A total of **312,638 (94.42%)** have recovered and discharged.

### Daily Incidence by Province



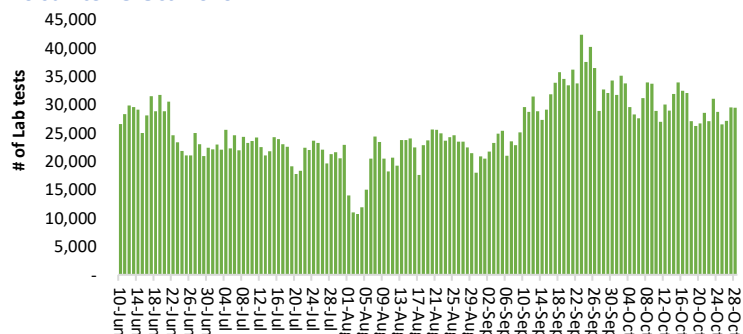
### Daily Incidence/Mortality

10-Jun - 28-Oct 2020

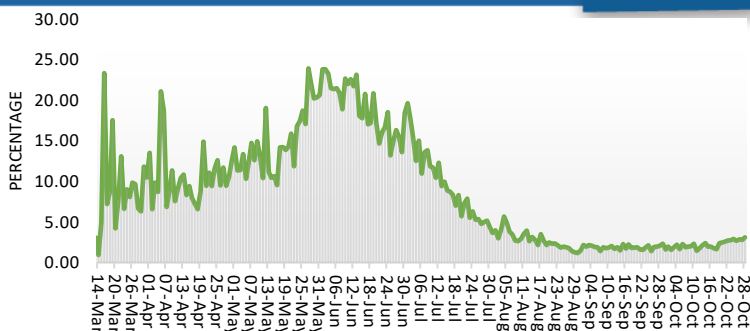


### Daily Lab Tests conducted

10-Jun to 28-Oct 2020

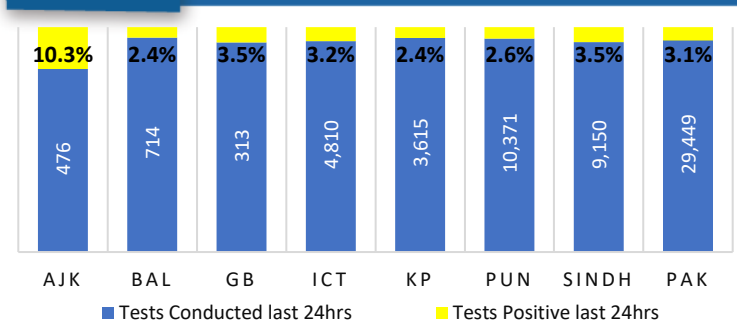


### Daily COVID-19 Positivity Rate

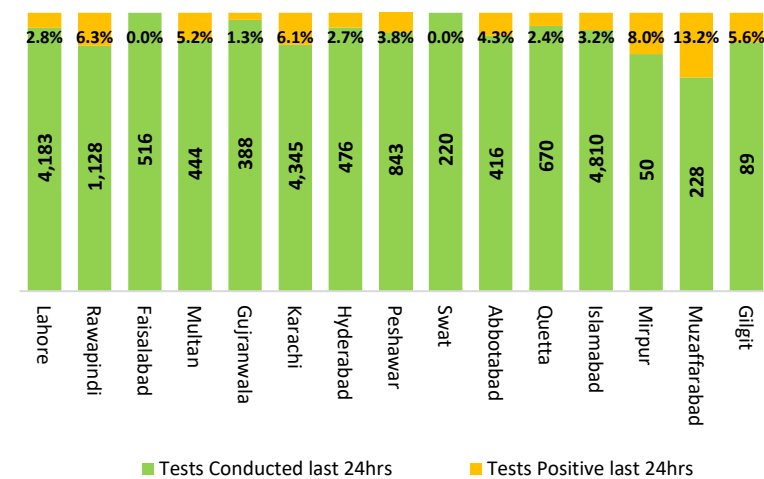
