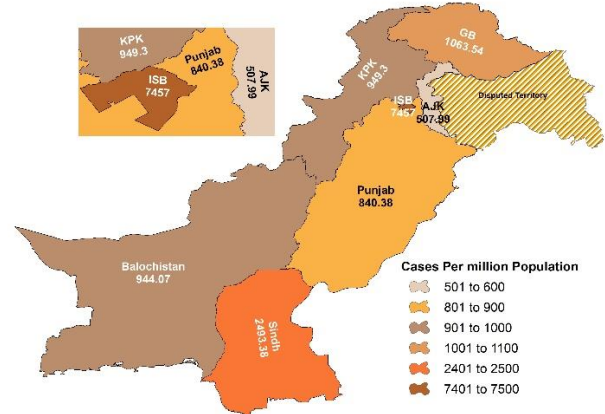

### COVID-19 case density/million Population

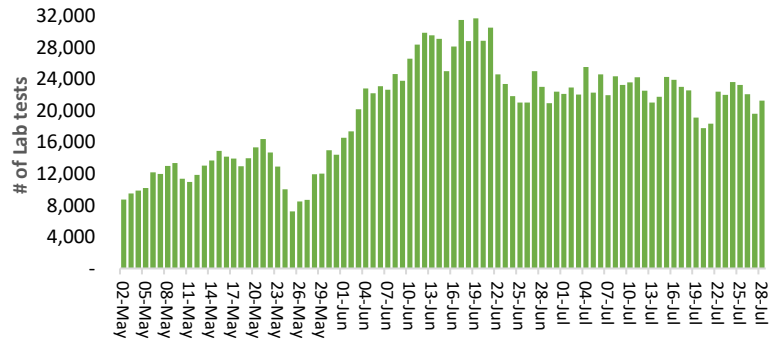


### Executive Summary

Pakistan reported **1,063** new cases of COVID-19 on **28 July 2020**. The total number of cases notified since the beginning of the outbreak is **276,288** with **5,892** deaths (**CFR: 2.13%**). Out of the total **25,213** currently active cases, **1,879** cases are hospitalized, out of which **1,179 (62.74%)** are in critical condition. **23,634** COVID-19 positive cases are at designated isolation facilities or in-home isolation. A total of **244,883 (88.63%)** have recovered and discharged.

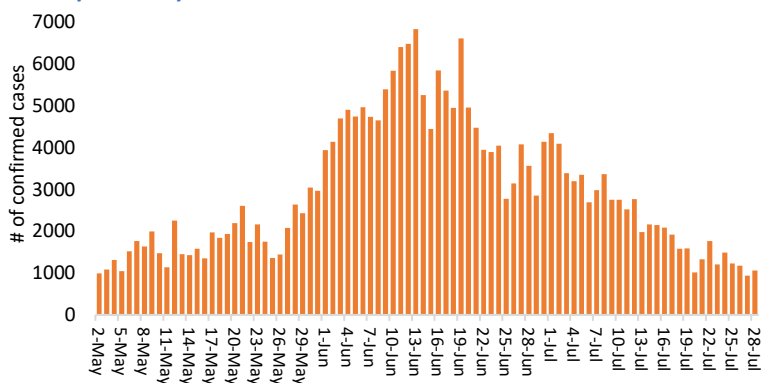
### Daily Lab tests conducted in Pakistan

01 May to 28 July 2020



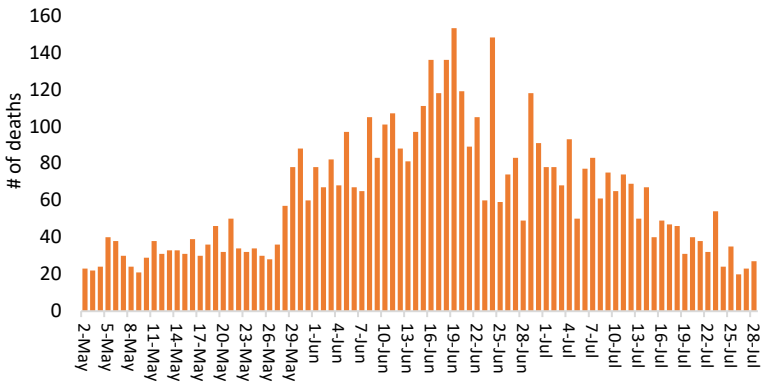
### Daily incidence of COVID-19 cases in Pakistan

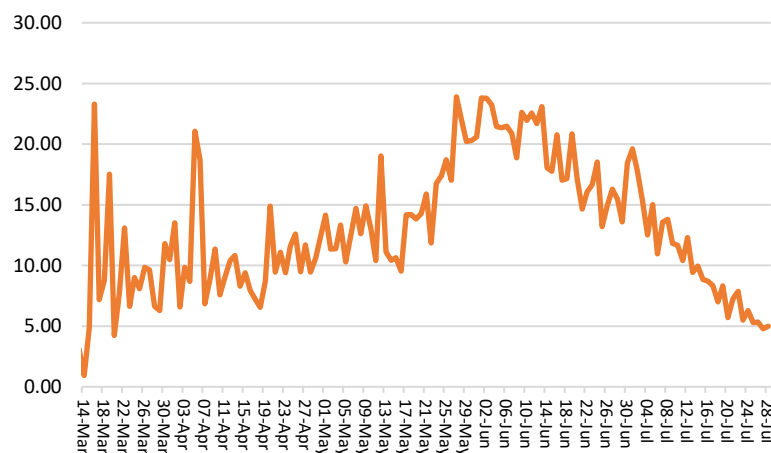

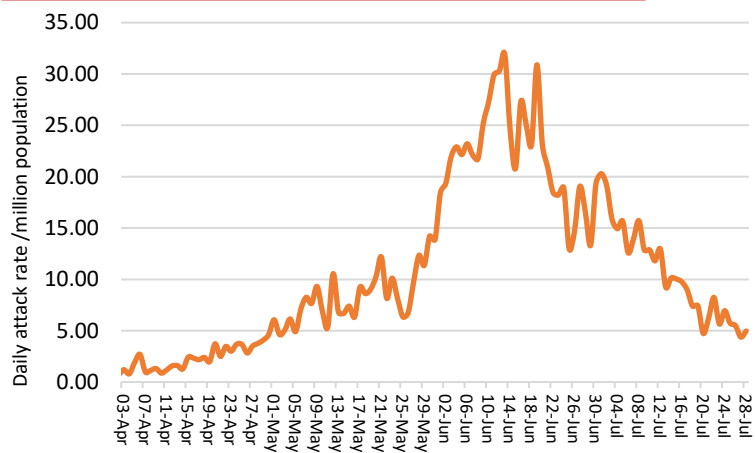
## Meeting & Coordination

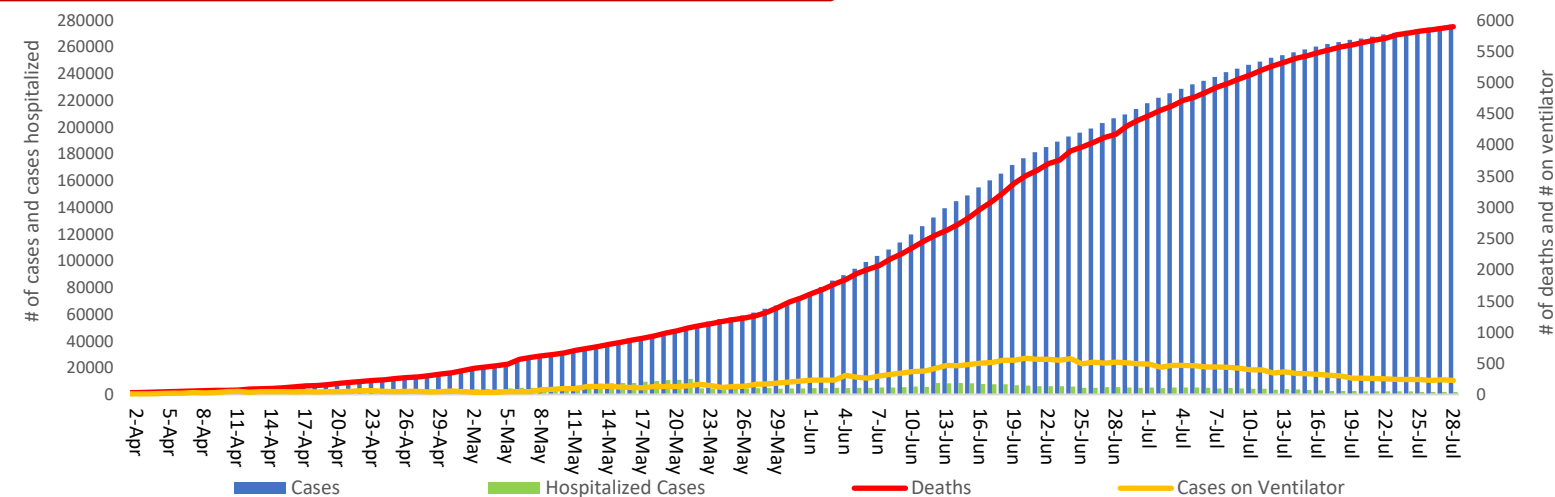
## Daily Positivity rate in Pakistan



## Daily Attack rate/million population



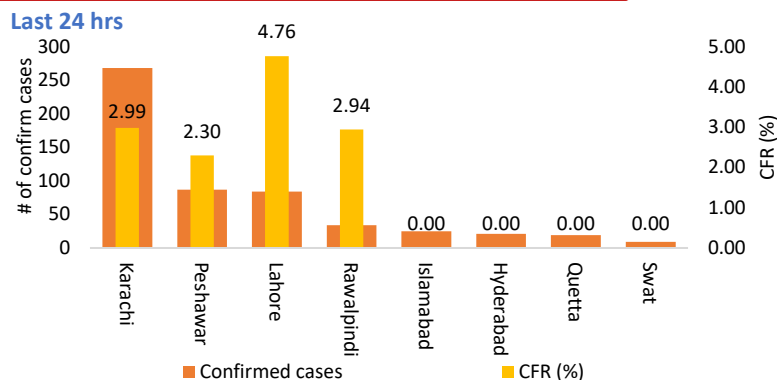
## Trends of COVID-19 cases, hospitalized, on ventilator & Deaths



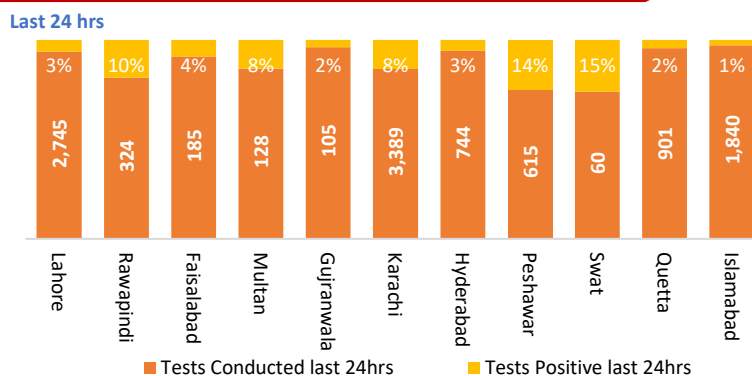

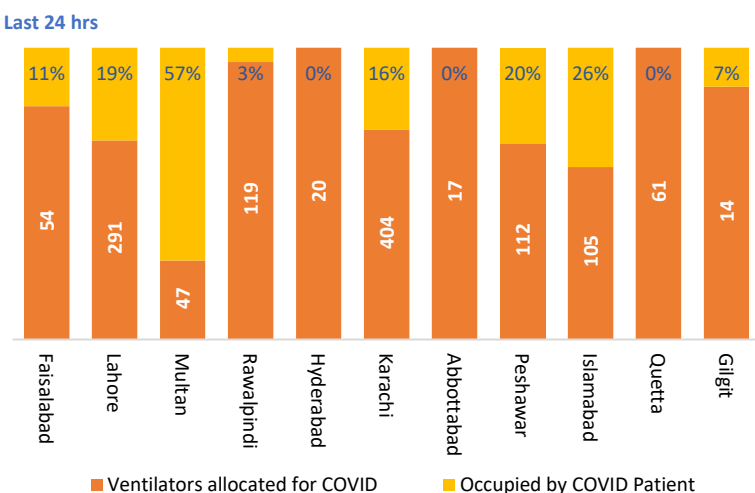
## COVID-19 confirmed cases & CFR (%) by districts
