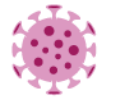

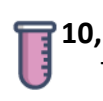

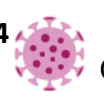

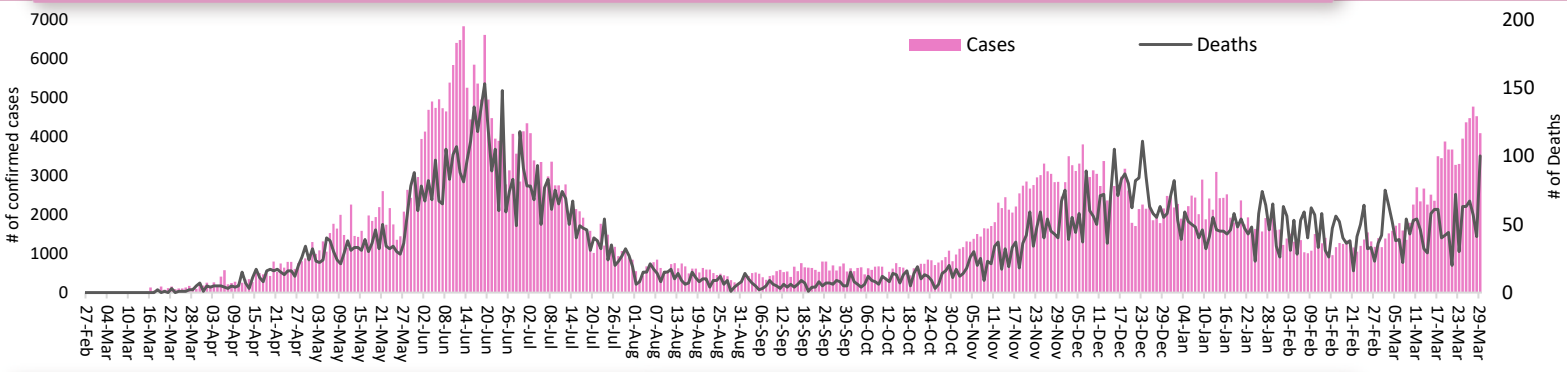

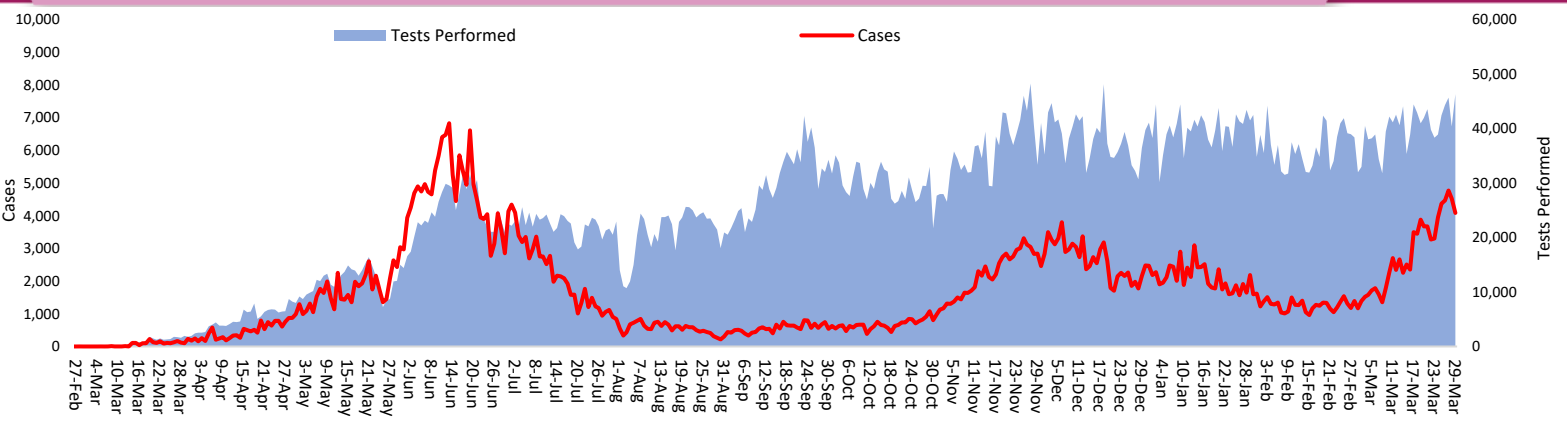

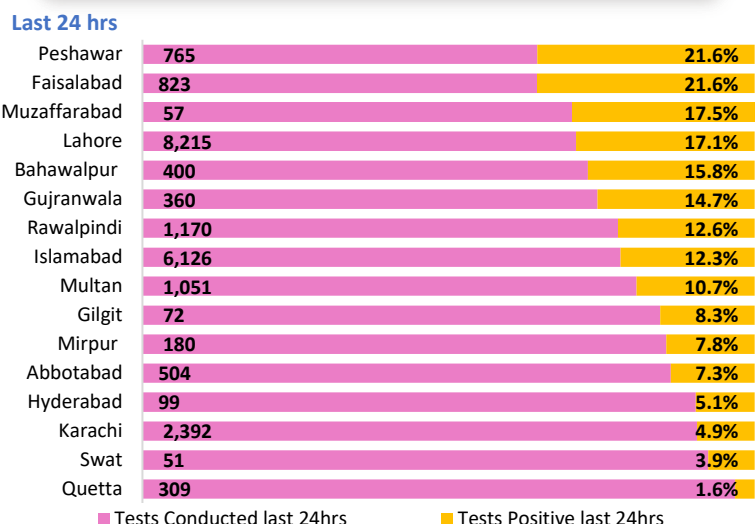
MEETING AND COORDINATION

On 30th March 2021, WHO Country Representative Pakistan Dr Palitha Mahipala along with Incident Manager, WHO Pakistan Dr Michael Lukwiya briefed the development partners on the current global and country COVID-19 situation and the response by the Pakistan government. This virtual meeting was organized by World Bank with all development partners. Key areas discussed included COVID-19 National deployment and vaccination plan, increase in positivity rate in the country, implementation of smart lockdowns, mask usage, social distancing, monitoring and tracking of COVID-19 variants of concern and WHO's support to increasing laboratory capacity by giving Rapid Antigen Testing kits. Dr. Palitha urged partners to continue supporting the government of Pakistan to respond to COVID-19 outbreak in the country.
