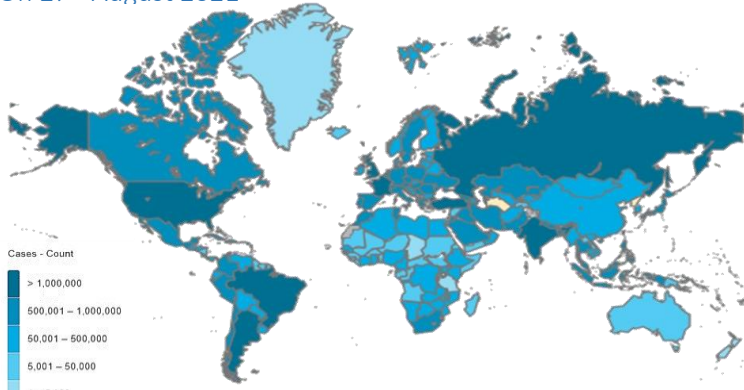

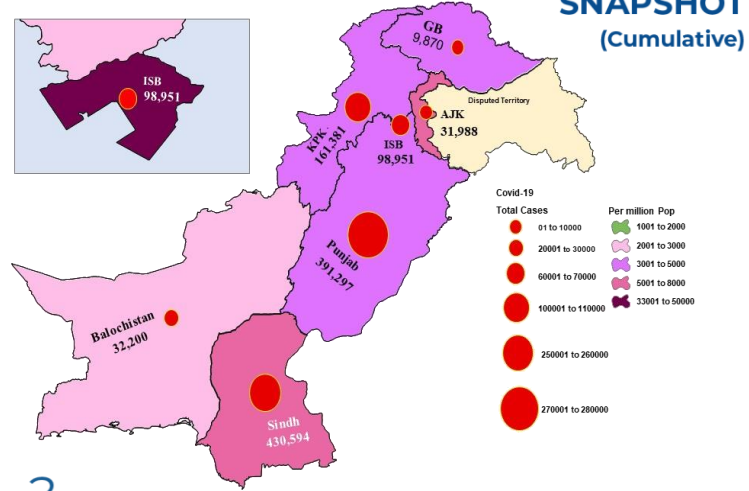

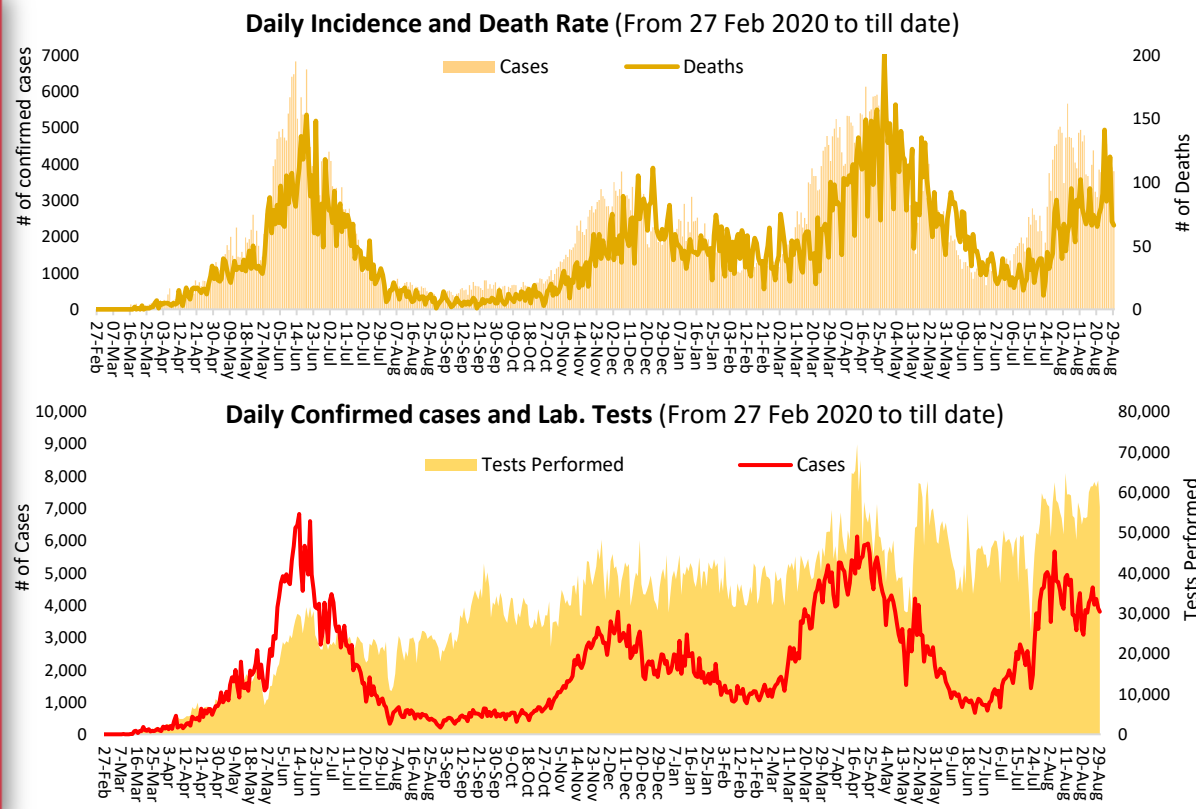

On 27th August 2021, WHO Country Representative Pakistan, Dr Palitha Mahipala had a meeting with the District Health Team (DHT), Islamabad Capital Territory at WHO Country Office Islamabad. The DHT was led by District Health Officer, Dr Zaeem Zia. The purpose of the meeting was to discuss the current COVID-19 situation in Islamabad and the response especially, vaccination drive and the continuity of essential health services.

Dr. Palitha advised on the need for strict public health measures, enhancing detection of cases and contact tracing given the prevailing SARS CoV2 variants of concern (VoC). The WR highlighted on WHO support to the COVID 19 response. Dr Zaeem appreciated WHO technical support to the ongoing response. The two officials committed to enhancing collaboration and coordination for improved health services delivery in ICT.
