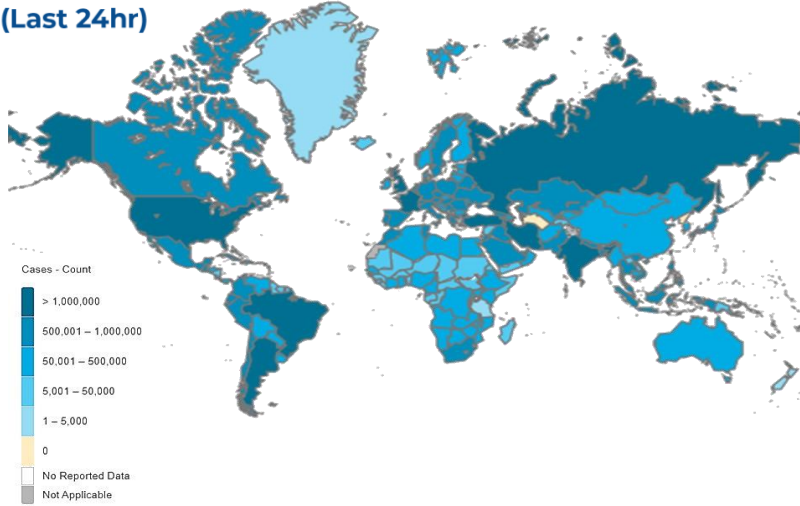

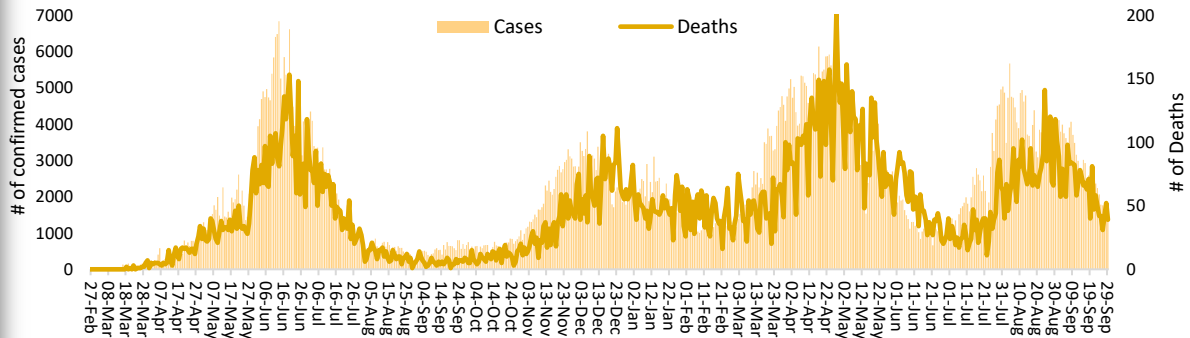

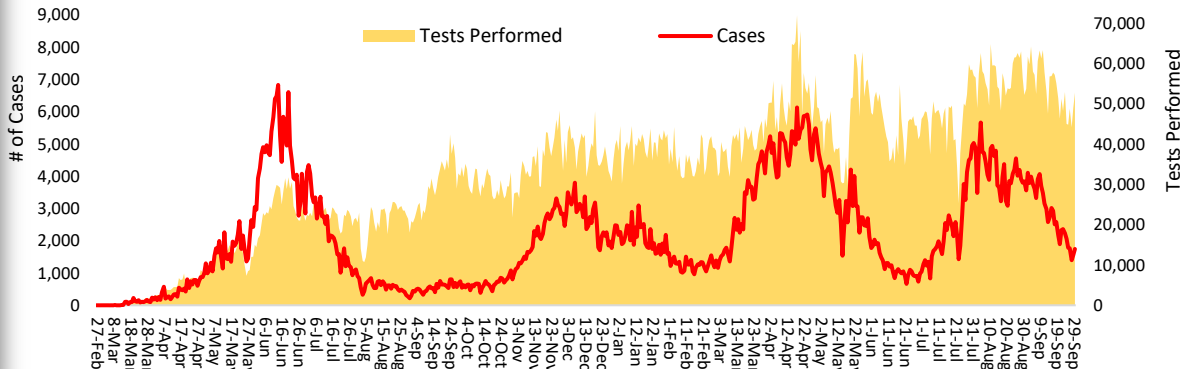

The Provincial Department of Health, Sindh, and World Health Organization Pakistan with funding from King Salman Humanitarian Aid and Relief Center (KSR) supported the strengthening of infection prevention and control system following the outbreak of HIV in Larkana in 2019. A dissemination meeting of the progress on implementation of the IPC was organized on 27th September 2021 and was graced by WHO Country Representative Pakistan, Dr Palitha Mahipala, Minister of Health and Population Welfare, Dr Azra Fazal Pechuho, Parliamentary Secretary of Health, Mr. Qasim Soomro, KSR Representative Pakistan Mr Hafeez Asadullah among others.
