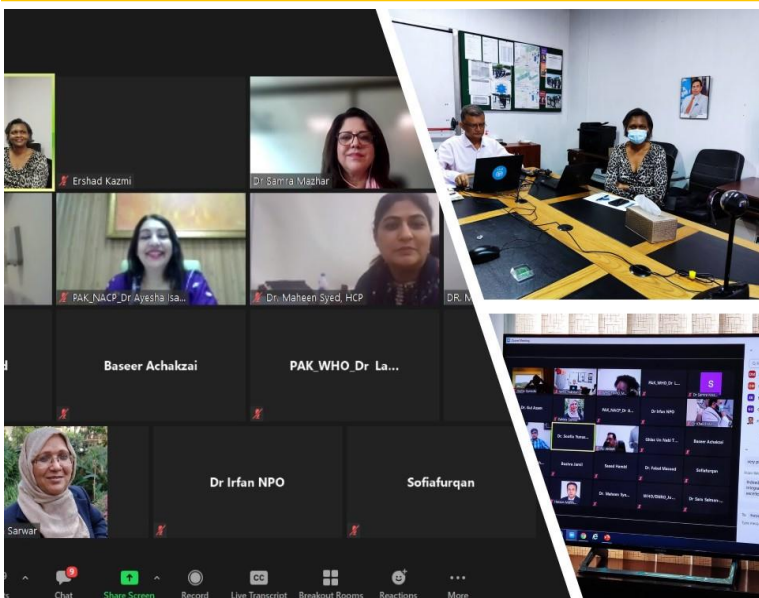

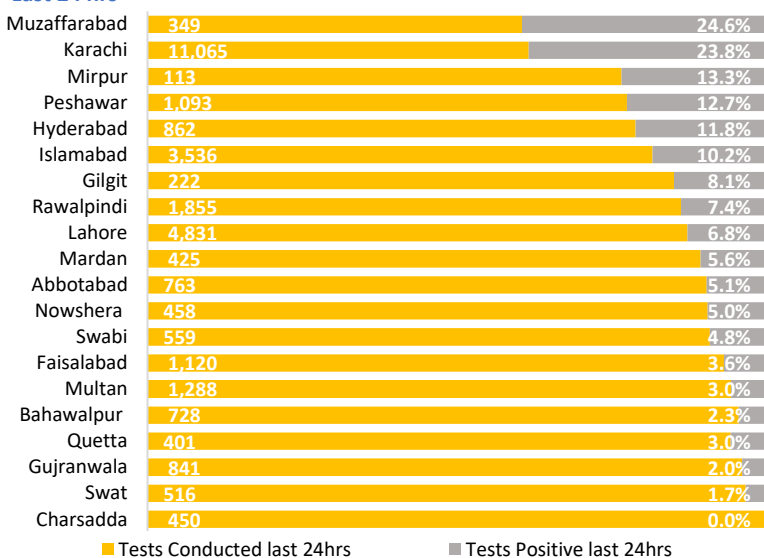
## Meetings & Coordination



On 29<sup>th</sup> July 2021, The Ministry of National Health Services, Regulations and Coordination (MO-NHSR&C) in collaboration with World Health Organization, Pakistan conducted a virtual commemoration of the World Hepatitis Day 2021. During the commemoration, a roadmap for elimination of Hepatitis B in line with the Global WHO Hepatitis B elimination target of 2030 was adapted. Specifically, the Mother-to-Child Transmission (EMTCT) of Hepatitis B Virus (HBV). The meeting was attended by National Program Managers and Provincial stakeholders, including Dr Osama Mere on behalf of the WHO Country Representative Pakistan, Regional Advisor HIV/Hepatitis/STI WHO/EMRO, Ms Joumana Hermez, Deputy Director Programs, MO-NHSR&C, Dr. Samra Mazhar. Dr Osama stressed the need for scaling up interventions to prevent MTCT of HBV and universal immunization of newborns against hepatitis B. The Deputy Director Programs MoNHSR&C reiterated government commitment to eliminate HBV.
